AS J.B. SAYS "Lock it up!"

YAHWAH יְהוָה

NASB LEXICON STATES THAT (S-3068) spelled in Hebrew YAD, HEY, WAW, HEY is pronounced YAHWEH. POOR BUT CLOSE. THAT IS DUE TO THE SHAWA SYSTEM OF VOWEL POINTING BY RABBINICALS — which means emptiness, vanity, deceit, deception, false, false visions, LIES, worthlessness (S-7723) SHAW ^{with WAW} ^{SHIN} pronounced "SHAWA". INVENTED BY MASORETIC SCRIBES IN 10TH CENTURY CE. THEY CLAIMED IT WAS NECESSARY BECAUSE HEBREW HAS NO VOWELS. COPPLY ENOUGH, MOSTHE WAS ABLE TO READ THE TORAH TO 2 MILLION PEOPLE WITH NO VOWELS.
