This is a good time to be strong. I haven't spent much time on the news mainly because we read a review from Yahowah saying that we ought not be focused on it during this period because it's going to be distracting, disorientating, and so negative. I do, however, think we need to at least do an upper-level review from time to time.

Kirk, you received a notification this morning on your telephone screaming at you, did you not? And it wasn't even something that you had a choice to answer, was it?

KIRK: No, it was a shock. It came right through the cell phone. I had no idea it was coming or ever heard anything like that.

YADA: So, you had a cell phone blast. What was the message?

KIRK: The message was: The COVID is running rampant. Stay home. Don't go out of your house. Wear a mask, etc. etc., all the party line. So ____ and I decided to go out for a long walk, and we did. So there, Comrade Newsom.

YADA: Yes, Comrade Newsom. So far today 34,000 Californians tested positive for COVID. In Texas 13,000 tested positive, Illinois and Florida each reported 11,000 positive cases, New York had 10,000 positive cases, and Ohio reported almost 12,000 positive cases. That is so far today. The interesting thing, speaking of the great State of Texas, is three close friends of our closest friend here on the Island were all in line to get a COVID test in Texas about a month ago. They paid their money, signed up and waited in line for two hours before saying this is ridiculous and finally just gave up. They weren't willing to stand in line among sick people for another two hours and they left. Guess what. All three of them got emails from the testing facility and the Health Department saying they had tested positive for COVID. None of the three took the test. None of the three took the test and yet they were all COVID positive. There is a serious issue.

One of our closest friends on the Island wanted to travel. To travel you must take a COVID test. He was feeling fine and had zero symptoms. He went to be tested and was told he had a positive test. So, he couldn't travel and had to self-quarantine even though he didn't have any symptoms.

My closest friend on the Island is an assistant and must every day several times a day walk through her office to get to his office. She lost the ability to taste, which is one of the first tell-tale signs. She had symptoms and she tested positive. He had been within inches of her, not wearing a mask, she's not wearing a mask, in their office working on everything imaginable in business. She's touching everything he touches and eight days after she tested positive, he and his entire staff had to be tested, and they were all negative. So, there's something fishy going on here.

Speaking of COVID, there are two things I want to share. States like California are going through the most rigid and Draconian lockdowns of the process. It's like okay, California has been in lockdown mode since April, and their response to the failure of the lockdown mode is to lock down more. In this case it is now illegal for you to have a friend visit your home. You can not go to an extended-family members home to celebrate a holiday and you can't have them at your home. It's only your own family members. If you have a non-essential busines, you are essentially shut down. If you have an essential business, only a third of your workers can show up. Isn't that amazing? Who made these people dictators?

The Pfizer vaccine was rolled out en mass a couple days ago starting in Britain. Anaphylactic shock is becoming a real problem. That would normally be part of any vaccine that one in one hundred thousand would have that kind of very serious and potentially deadly reaction to the vaccine, and in this case, it is much more frequent. But then no one has ever done a mass rollout of a vaccine, so it's certainly possible. In Britain, the first to do a national rollout of the vaccine, there are some alarming negatives.

I want to talk a little about the election. There were some surprising things about this election. Do you know that Trump received thirteen percent more African American votes than any other Republican candidate ever? He received ten percent more African American votes than he did in his previous election, and at that time he received three percent more than any Republican previously. So, the very people that you would think to be the most anti-Trump were increasingly supporting Trump.

It was also interesting to read that men overwhelmingly want less government while women overwhelmingly want more. Hispanics were evenly divided in this election which is uncommon. They are normally very Democratic. Caucasians overwhelmingly wanted small government, voting for the conservative. The biggest gap of all spells disaster. While we in the Covenant are called to be anti-political (I do not vote, and I recommend that if you are part of the Covenant or thinking about becoming part of the Covenant that you don't vote because God has expressly asked us to walk away from our country) it doesn't alter our responsibility for exposing things that we think are troubling so that people *don't* rely on their country. There is an irreversible and devastating statistic. And again, while we are not to be political, since God is anti-government and anti-politics, the conservative approach (forget about party for a moment) that wants less government is much more consistent with Yahowah's approach than a liberal who wants more government. From a practical point of view the people who are voting for more government control and programs are at the extreme of what Yahowah dislikes. Those who say they want less government, and less government intrusion, are at least associated with the direction that God wants us to go.

Over ninety percent of voters between the ages of eighteen and twenty-nine vote for the most liberal candidate. Ninety percent is the single most skewed demographic in American politics. It's obvious they have been overwhelmingly indoctrinated by social media which is exceedingly liberal, and they have not had enough exposure outside of the indoctrination of academia to understand the economic realities between large and small government. Ninety to ten; I thought that was interesting.

There is a suit now in the state of Texas. I think there are several states that have sided with Texas and about one hundred fifty-some odd congressmen and senators that have sided with this suit. Texas has brought suit against the states that at the last minute changed their voting procedures to facilitate massive additional amounts of write-in ballots which are much harder to validate and thus much more susceptible to voter fraud. The state of Texas is suing because it realizes the legislators in those states who would not have allowed it are Republican, but the legislators were not asked to vote on it. It was a procedural choice, and the government workers are overwhelmingly liberal. Government employees put this together without the approval of the legislature, and that is why Texas is suing. I don't know if they will prevail. If they don't it will be because Texas doesn't have a standing in what happens in these swing states, but their argument is valid.

What's most interesting, of course, is that you're hearing constantly now that Trump is claiming there was voter fraud without any evidence. I told that to Leah two nights ago. I said, "I'm not reading any articles that indicate that there was a massive amount of voter fraud." She said, "Let me check into that for you." She listened to eight hours of what is about twenty hours of congressional testimonies from people under oath who swore to what they had seen. It's as reliable evidence as you can have. Of the twenty hours of testimony, it was one proof after another of massive voter fraud and the witnessing of massive voter fraud. So, when the media says there's no proof it it's like the overall liberal position now on evidence. When evidence doesn't suit their fact, they just deny the evidence exists. There were overwhelming amounts of voter fraud. And that's disappointing because what now? If we ignore it then the con artists have prevailed. If we deal with it then we put the country into what will be anarchy. It is an exceedingly difficult position that we find ourselves in and there are no good answers. For Americans, this is an exceedingly sad day.

Speaking of sad, Turkey has decided to purchase and deploy a Russian air defense system, and yet it's a NATO nation. And when the US said, "We're going to sanction you because we told you not to do this." (They are a joke being part of NATO anyway). They're killing the Kurds who are the only decent thing in that whole region and Erdoğan is saying, "You're disrespecting Turkey to impose any sanctions against it so that Turkey can play with the Russians and the Americans, and nobody can tell Turkey what to do. If you can't reason with Turkey, why is it in the NATO alliance? And why is Erdoğan so belligerent? He's even gone so far to say France should replace their president because their president has tried to protect the French people from Islamic terrorists. He says that someone that would do that needs to be replaced and he said he hopes the French do away with him because he's a horrible leader. So, the Muslims are authorized, according to Erdoğan, to murder as many non-Muslims as they want. "We will continue to kill you and you will like it. We don't want to hear anyone complaining that we're killing you."

It looks like Israel is headed for another election. Gantz has decided he doesn't want to be a part of the Netanyahu coalition, so it means another election. On the positive side score another one for the Trumpster. I don't know if it's Trump or his son-in-law, but someone has figured it out and it appears that economics is the driver, but Morocco has now joined those other countries in normalizing relationships with Israel. In addition to Morocco the Saudi Arabians are working with

the Israelis on opposing Iran and its development of nuclear weapons as well as now allowing Israel to overfly its air space. So, we are in a most interesting time ... yeah, "my enemy is my friend." Of course, the only reason Iran is in power is two-fold: Jimmy Kattah did the insane and decided he would oppose the Shah Ayatollah, and that ruined a lot of peoples' lives. Then after we did that, we showed no willingness to constrain the nuclear program of Iran. We then freed all their assets in an agreement that they had no intention of upholding which now enabled them to do whatever they wanted to do. It's a combination that is horrible. Ultimately, Iran was empowered because: 1. The United States belligerently decided we would oppose China and Russia. Obama was great at it - let's demean and sanction both Russia and China and then in sanctioning inappropriately Iran, Iran had no other choice but to use those two as its trading partners which created an axis of evil, if you will, in the Middle East and now everything is China, Russia and Iran in opposition to everyone else and it has made the region stunningly unstable and is the reason for the Syrian civil war. So, a lot of universal foolishness.

___ chapter the first words Yahowah says here in *Howsha'* / Salvation / Hosea 2:2 where we pick up the story of man and says:

"Quarrel and contend (ryb – choose to oppose and be contentious, actually bringing charges (qal imperative)) against your mother (ba 'em 'atem), because (ky) she (hy') is not a woman of Mine (lo' 'ishah 'any). And (wa) I ('anoky) am not an Individual of her's (lo' 'iysh hy').

God is in *Howsha'* saying that you are not my children, you are not my bride. I do not recognize you. There is no part of you that is appropriate. It takes a lot to get God to give up on you.

I spent some time (getting into)? details on translations like adding translations about what happened with 'Abraham and Sarah when they went to Egypt. Most people don't want to touch that. He had a half lie where he said that she was my sister. We will get to that passage before too long because I just finished translating it for Volume Three of Yada Yahowah. I will tell you it's repulsive what 'Abraham did. He was enriched because he turned his wife over to be effectively a concubine in Pharaoh's house. He was enriched by his plan to have his wife hauled off to be a sex slave in Pharaoh's house. If that won't turn your stomach, I don't know what does. And yet God didn't give up on him. He still formed the Covenant with him. Yahowah gave Chawah to 'Adam. He never said a negative thing about Chawah, and yet she named her two sons Able which means "waste of breath" and Cain which means "my opportunity to rebel." They are horrible names. It's all the way through the story of us humans. Even those of us who God forms a relationship with and uses in the most powerful ways, we've really got a bad streak. So, it's the same thing here. It takes a lot for God to get to the point where He says, "I'm just giving up on you." It's hard to imagine someone doing something worse than Abram did, and God didn't give up on him. It underscores the fact that being good is not what He's looking for. He's looking for us to be right. Abram got his act together in the end and was right but between here and there it was not a pretty picture.

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Let her choose to turn away from her continual (*wa suwr* – she should choose to abolish, getting rid of, and forsake (hifil imperfect jussive)) **whoring through her illicit relationships with false**

deities (*zanuwnym hy* ' – her religious prostitution) **within her presence** (*min paneh hy* ' – from all appearances) **as well as** (*wa*) **her marks of her unfaithfulness** (*na'aphuwphym hy* ' – signs of her adultery through the ornaments worn by harlots) **from between her breasts** (*min bayn sad hy* ' – from making this connection on her chest)." (*Howsha*' / Salvation / Hosea 2:2)

God is calling Yisra'el a whore because she has nothing but illicit relationships with false deities. I don't recognize you. I don't know you. I don't like you and I don't respect you and I most certainly don't love you. When He said this, it's amazing that God would go the better part of two thousand seven hundred years with the relationship between Him and His people severed. He wouldn't intervene when the Babylonians, the Assyrians, the Greeks abused them or when the Romans abused them three times. He didn't intervene when the Byzantines or Muslims abused them multiple times, or when they were abused by the Nazis. He doesn't know them. He went so far as to say, "Because your religion and lifestyle are so disgusting, I'm going to blind you because the worst thing that could possibly happen is for you to get some of this stuff right and your half truths where you're pretending to ... me is really going to screw things up." It's horrible for Jews to celebrate Passover with their Seder and screw everything up by having everything on the plate but lamb. That's disgusting. What if they actually understood Passover, were celebrating it not because of Egypt but because it is the doorway to life, that they spoke of it that way and they understood the sacrifice of the Lamb, that they understood the purpose of the unyeasted bread and the bitter herbs? And what if they referred to God not as ha Shem or Adonai, but as Yahowah? How much more difficult would it be to overcome that and say Yahowah is God's name but don't follow anything these Jews do because all they do is get that right and nothing more? It would be a disaster. It would be unconscionable how much more difficult it would be. So, here in Howsha' is the divorce. You're not my children, you're not my bride, not my people. I don't know you anymore. I want nothing to do with you; you are revolting.

In Orthodox Judaism, particularly the Haredi movement which is the fastest growing movement within the Jewish people, they wear their little beaver hats with the little curly ques coming down on the sides and black mourning clothes. The women have shaved heads so they must wear wigs. They play religion all day. They do not work. All they do is strive to keep their children and wives from turning against their control and spend all day being religious. I look at them and I want to puke. They dress the Towrah up like it's a whore in this little dress, and of course, they study the Talmud. They are disgusting. That's my view of them. They turn my stomach when I see them. That's Yahowah's view also; those are not my people. I don't know them, I don't like them, they are whores. Some people say that's anti-Semitic. No, I'm speaking out against the religion of Judaism. Judaism is repulsive and God hates it. This is a condemnation of Judaism, folks. That's what God said through the prophet *Howsha'*. So, if you don't want to condemn Judaism then you're in opposition to God. And if you do condemn it, you're not being anti-Semitic. I'm not condemning the race. I'm condemning the religion and they are very separate things.

In this passage, Yahowah is affirming that He views illicit religious relationships with false deities as being equivalent to being a whore and committing adultery. That is the way we should be interpreting the Statement on the Second Tablet that speaks of not committing adultery. God is speaking about religious infidelity. Of all the choices we humans make, this is the one Yahowah despises the most. God damn religion. Yahowah hates religion.

Speaking of that I wrote in the chatroom (I haven't mentioned it audibly). We are publishing at Amazon the second book of the *Yada Yahowah* series, *The Story of Man*. The first book, *In the*

Beginning, we published about three to four weeks ago. This volume contains a lot of insights, and like the first Volume, contains one hundred percent new translations and the insights are about eighty percent new. So, there's a lot of new material here. The first volume is In the Beginning, the second is The Story of Man. I'm on the last chapter of my edits of the third volume, In the Covenant. Then I will likely turn my attention to what are two (perhaps three) volumes on The Miqra'ey, which will be a long process. I'll probably have three or four months in it because I have not done those translations in probably fifteen years and we have come a long way since they were written. Hopefully by redoing everything we'll come up with a lot of fresh insights. The Story of Man contains a lot of them.

Explaining the spiritual message underlying His Instructions, Yahowah tells us that our infidelity affects our children, separating them from God. This same message is reinforced at the conclusion of the Second Statement Yahowah etched on stone. It says, "Fathers corrupt their children to the third and fourth generation."

"And therefore (wa 'eth), I will have no concern or compassion (lo' racham – I will not show affection, mercy, nor love) for her children (ben hy') because (ky) they are the children (hem beny) of whores prostituting themselves through illicit relationships with false gods (zanuwnym – of religious idolatry)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 2:4)

This is the God of 'Abraham, Yitschq, Ya'aqob, Yisra'el, and the Towrah, Prophets and Psalms. This is Yahowah and He is saying of Yisra'el:

"And therefore (wa 'eth), I will have no concern or compassion (lo' racham – I will not show affection, mercy, nor love) for her children (ben hy') because (ky) they are the children (hem beny) of whores prostituting themselves through illicit relationships with false gods (zanuwnym – of religious idolatry)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 2:4)

I think even today God would say this of every orthodox religious Jew. Is it possible that there are some reformed Jews that are somewhat religious and are beginning to question their religion and want to leave it? I hope so. But of religious Jews He's saying exactly the same thing. That's quite a statement. And ultimately the reconciliation of Yahowah and ethnic (not religious) Jews is something God that has promised and will (mend)? It will happen. It's already happening. Over the next thirteen years we're going to see a lot of it. Hopefully, it goes beyond thousands and tens of thousands to hundreds of thousands; I would love it to be millions. It is true today that about seventy-plus percent of Jews are secular, and there's always hope for a secular Jew. But God's view of religious Jews is, "They are not my children." And that's never going to change. The only hope that any of us have is to leave religion because while we are religious, we look disgusting to God.

Upsetting God to this degree was a very poor life choice. And yet it became so commonplace in Yisra'el, (and it is still) that with only a handful of rightminded souls through whom He could counsel His people, (a handful of them) Yahowah was left with no other option but to condemn the nation for their propensity to chase after false gods. This "time out" for bad behavior would endure through the centuries to this day.

We had a friend over for dinner tonight and her brother whom I've also met (he's a highly successful businessman) said, "Craig, he's a different cat. Even when it's in his interest to go along, make a compromise, he won't ever do it. He will take the high ground and stand for what he thinks is right even when it's against his own interest. Why does he do that?" This woman,

whom I also like and think of as a very bright person responded, "Well, you need to be appreciative of somebody that will." What would the world be like if there was no one willing to take a stand for right? You're going to take a hit. You are not going to be popular and you are going to have lots of enemies. In my case I have ten thousand death threats. You will guarantee that you will be unpopular and that you'll have horrible things said about you in the media if you are willing to take a stand. But it's the right thing to do. It's what Yahowah does. One of the reasons Yahowah is not popular is because He takes a stand against these things. Right is right; wrong is wrong. Dowd took a stand against them and look at the hit he took. Moseh did and got whacked for it. But we need to do it. That's what God is encouraging us to do.

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It should have been as obvious as the noses on their faces. But should anyone be as misguided as Yisra'el appears to have been before the Northern Kingdom's demise in 2700 BCE, God is condemning religion, not sexuality, when He says they are a bunch of whores. *This has nothing to do with sexuality*. He's condemning religion. This seductive Harlot's intention was to lure the nation away from Yahowah. She, the Whore of Babylon remains successful.

"For surely (ky) their mother ('em hem) was unfaithful and wantonly committed religious adultery (zanah – was an idolatrous harlot and a solicitous whore).

She who conceived them (harah hem – she who gave birth to them) **should have been embarrassed and ashamed for this mistake in judgment** (bowsh – should be humiliated and disgraced because what they did was shameful and wrong)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 2:5)

But yet, if you talk to a rabbi, they are the most arrogant people on the planet. Talk to an Orthodox religious Jew and they just *ooze* arrogance. They should be ashamed, humiliated, and embarrassed but they're not.

All one has to do is look at the statuary and religious relics which decorated every civilization. Gods and goddesses were modeled after what, Kirk, JB.

KIRK and JB: Mankind.

YADA: Yes, men. If you look at any of the statuary in Greece where they have all the gods, Mt. Olympus, the Parthenon. All the gods look like men and women, don't they? The same thing is true in Rome. All the gods were chiseled in the image of man. At least the Babylonians made their gods winged lions, donkeys, horses, bulls, or that sort of thing. In Egypt they claimed the Pharaoh was a god. Even in Egypt the images of the various gods are drawn as caricatures of man. We are so arrogant that we have made ourselves gods. The gods of religion. Look at the god of Christianity. He was nailed to a stick. God is a man in Christianity. We turned God into a man. We wanted a god that was like us, right? We created one, didn't we? We should be embarrassed. This is not Judaism but what could be more embarrassing than parading around, tattooing and building great shrines to a torture stick and then carving an edifice of your god on that stick so that he is tortured forever? Gee, what a nice thing to do. What I think I want you do, is celebrate me as your god and I want you to torture me and then to prolong that memory so that you are going to torture me on a stick, then make your religion torture me on a stick. What would be better than being tortured other than being tortured and being commemorated for all time being tortured?

KIRK: Don't you think in *Howsha*' 2:2 as a secondary meaning where He says what she's hanging between her breasts could be a reference to crosses everybody wears in Christianity? I know He's

talking to Yahuwdym. Is there anything comparable?

YADA: He's talking to Jews. Of course, Jews created Christianity. Paul created Christianity; he was a Jew. It was a Jew that created Islam; Mohammad was Jewish. Hitler was a Jewish Nazi. It could be but I think that God has a lot to say about Paul, from the Plague of Death to the Father of Lies, The Son of Evil. He has a lot of things to say about Pauline Christianity, all of which are bad. But in *Howsha*' God is talking to Yisra'el.

Gods and goddesses are modeled after men. In Judaism Yahowah's name is never mentioned. They pay very little attention to His Towrah; they prefer the Talmud which was composed from the words of men. In Judaism the adoration is for rabbis. It's the same thing. Look at the gods and goddesses modeled after men and women with a special devotion shown to phallic symbols and vaginas – from the Ankh (drawn to represent as a vagina) and Jesus Fish (drawn to represent a vagina) to the Star of David (7 phalli and a vagina). Look up when these things came into being.

Now, when I'm talking about condemning Orthodox Judaism, they want you to believe that their nation goes back to the time of Moses. That is not true. There was no Judaism at the time of Moses. All the practices of Orthodox Judaism were first invented and observed during the eighteenth century in Europe. The father of Orthodox Judaism is called (I think) The Lord of the Words. He's actually Ba'al and called The Lord of (I'll come up with it later). It's an eighteenth-century European phenomenon that has been brought into Israel and the New York area and where there are Orthodox Jews, they are all practicing a religion that is the most recent of the Jewish religions. It has no history going back past the eighteenth century. It's also in the Star of David. If you look it up, you will see that it was designed to be a phallic symbol. A phallic symbol and vagina with six phalli surrounding a vagina. This is man's history. The objects of devotion and worship in every religion are the things that are animalistic. Humans as God. Of all people, *Yahuwdym* | Jews should have known better, but such was not the case. Yisra'el would become the womb of religion. God is not amused.

Whores give birth to bastards. Lost in their devotion to Judaism, Christianity, Islam, and Socialist Secular Humanism, they remain estranged from the only true God. It is a miscarriage on a national scale, the abortion of a people.

Maybe I'm in a rut right now, but I made a commitment early on to go where the words lead and I don't know how you read this where God is calling His people whores and saying I don't even know you anymore, you should be ashamed, but you're not. What's wrong with you? I don't know how you read that and not become judgmental against Judaism and expose it, condemn it, and despise it. I don't know who can read how 'Abraham profited from what he did to his wife and not be upset by it. We haven't given God much to work with. It's extraordinarily sad. It's been a long time since the Chosen People haven't been chosen. God said, "So much for you." I'm not sure that God had a single person He could speak credibly through for the better part of two thousand-plus years. By the time we get to Mal'aky in 450 to 500 BCE to maybe twenty, thirty years ago who was God speaking to and who was speaking for Yahowah?

KIRK: Well, you had the Dead Sea Scrolls starting to show up

YADA: But not a lot of people translated then. Look how much different this is than what we've been told.

Yahowah can resolve many things, but religion is not among them. We must expunge it from our lives before God will have anything to do with us. There has never been, nor will there ever be, a

rabbi, pope, cardinal, bishop, priest, pastor, imam, or nun in heaven. The very people who claim to point the way to Heaven will never see it.

While this is the most rational alternative, it is followed by a scathing indictment...

"Listen to (shama' – choose to hear (qal imperative – under the auspices of freewill actually choose to genuinely listen, interpreting what you hear about the relationship literally)) the word (dabar – the message and accounts, the statements and declarations, the communications and speech) of Yahowah (Yahowah – written as directed by His towrah – teaching regarding His hayah – existence), Children of Yisra'el (beny Yisra'el – Descendants of those who both Contend and Struggle with God and those who Engage and Endure with God).

Shama' dabar Yahowah beny Yisra'el. That's what we should be doing. Religious Jews don't listen to Yahowah. They spend all day bobbing their head up and down reciting memorized prayers which God never hears.

"Listen to (shama' – choose to hear (qal imperative – under the auspices of freewill actually choose to genuinely listen, interpreting what you hear about the relationship literally)) the word (dabar – the message and accounts, the statements and declarations, the communications and speech) of Yahowah (Yahowah – written as directed by His towrah – teaching regarding His hayah – existence), Children of Yisra'el (beny Yisra'el – Descendants of those who both Contend and Struggle with God and those who Engage and Endure with God).

When I was a Christian long ago, I would be asked by a lot of people to lead the congregation in prayer. I realized the same thing that every pastor who has ever done it realizes; I wasn't speaking to God. I was speaking to be heard by the congregation.

Surely (ky - truthfully), clearly, and without exception), with regard to (la - concerning) the approach of) Yahowah ($(\frac{y}{2})^{\frac{y}{2}})^{\frac{y}{2}}$ – a transliteration of YaHoWaH as instructed in His towrah – teaching regarding His hayah – existence) there is a contentious conflict which needs to be resolved through rational discourse (ryb - there) is a quarrelsome dispute, expressed difference, and opposition, including a serious grievance), especially concerning ('eth – with regard to) living in the Land $(yashab\ ha\ 'erets$ – inhabiting the Land).

God's advice is:

"Listen to (*shama*' – choose to hear (qal imperative – under the auspices of freewill actually choose to genuinely listen, interpreting what you hear about the relationship literally)) **the word** (*dabar* – the message and accounts, the statements and declarations, the communications and speech) **of Yahowah** (*Yahowah* – written as directed by His *towrah* – teaching regarding His *hayah* – existence), **Children of Yisra'el** (*beny Yisra'el* – Descendants of those who both Contend and Struggle with God and those who Engage and Endure with God).

And then He says:

Surely (ky - truthfully), clearly, and without exception), with regard to (la - concerning) the approach of) Yahowah ((27)25 - 1) - 1 a transliteration of YaHoWaH as instructed in His towrah - 1 teaching regarding His hayah - 1 existence) there is a contentious conflict which needs to be resolved through rational discourse (ryb - 1) there is a quarrelsome dispute, expressed difference, and opposition, including a serious grievance), especially concerning ('eth - 1 with regard to) living in the Land $(yashab \ ha \ 'erets - 1)$ inhabiting the Land).

Who in Yisra'el is using Yahowah's name? Who in Yisra'el is explaining that we are Yahuwdym,

we're the Beloved of Yah? Dowd | David was the Messiah, the Son of God, the King of Kings. Yahowah is returning and is going to reestablish the Covenant. We need to disassociate from religion and politics. We need to stop relying on ourselves and start relying on God. Who is saying that in the Land? No one.

This is because (ky – indeed) there is absolutely no honesty nor integrity, no trustworthiness nor reliability ('ayn 'emeth – loyalty and dependability are nonexistent without any accurate testimony or credible instruction).

None. Can you imagine being the recipient of this? God is saying, "You are absolutely, totally, and completely worthless. No integrity, no honesty, no trustworthiness or reliability." If a person isn't any of these things, what good are they?

There is no sense of devotion, desire, nor duty (*wa 'ayn chesed* – there is a complete lack of affection and love, there is no mercy nor compassion, there is no commitment to the relationship whatsoever, and there is no goodness, either).

So, beyond the fact that all the cerebral things are wrong even, the heart is wrong and the entire being is infected.

When it comes to God (wa 'elohym) there is a complete lack of understanding ('ayn da'ath – there is no awareness, information, knowledge, discernment, nor comprehension, nothing but irrational ignorance) throughout the Land (ba ha 'erets)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 4:1)

God is saying that circa 700 BCE there wasn't a single person that understood who He was or what He was offering. There was no devotion, desire, honesty, or integrity and the Land was in continuous conflict. It's worse now than it was then. Look at Israel. Netanyahu is only Prime Minister because he cow-tows to the religious right who are completely wrong. That's the problem; they are parasites. Orthodox Judaism is a malignancy. That's not my opinion; that's Yahowah's conclusion. Israel is a blend of Social Secular Humanism (to the point it's Communism), extreme religious orthodoxy, and Islam. What a mess. It's worse now than it was at the time of ____.

The Children of Yisra'el, God's Chosen People, chose not to listen. Rather than serving as Yahowah's prophets and people, they became contentious and quarrelsome. The first family was in shatters, torn up and broken. The grievances arose because Jews chose religion over the relationship God had offered.

Most all of us have a fractured family and most families are fractured on multiple levels including fractures between parents and children. Most of us had parents who were deeply flawed. Most people's relationship with their parents are not good. Most of us have highly contentious relationships with our spouses. Most of us end up having contentious problems with one or more of our children and siblings. On the four immediate levels of family most families are broken on one or more of those levels (many on all four). It's important for us to realize that contentiousness is in our nature. The single most important family relationship that is fractured is between the Children of Yisra'el and Yahowah, between mankind and our Heavenly Father.

Yahowah said that when it came to Him, Israel had become ignorant and irrational, showing a complete lack of understanding. Lacking integrity, they could no longer be trusted. Their religious testimony was not the least bit credible. They had become renegades and scoundrels with no sense of duty nor desire to change. If you are a Jew, by listening to a rabbi, you are putting your soul in peril.

I just translated the passage where Yahowah says that He finds the Jewish religious celebrations to be an abomination; that they are absolutely appalling. If you think about it a moment, in the celebration of Passover you've got everything there except the lamb. There's a lamb bone, but that's it. You have to push the lamb aside so you can make room for all the rabbinical accouterments. Instead of celebrating Shabuw'ah they prefer instead to observe Purim. They have replaced the celebration of Taruw'ah with Rosh Hashanah. They have no clue about Yowm Kippurym. Rather than celebrating the reconciliation of its relationship, which is uplifting, nurturing, wholesome, and good ... they must humble their souls, which is the opposite of what Yahowah intended. Yahowah says I think their religious celebrations are disgusting.

Look what He even said about their Shabat. Their Shabat He finds appalling. The Shabat is a day to celebrate the relationship, celebrate the Promise of Seven. It's not a day to be a mushroom and do what Orthodox Judaism does, which is to make it the most tortured day of the week because of hundreds of rules that must be followed: You can't push the elevator button. You can't answer the phone. Can't turn on a light or turn it off. Can't cook a meal on the stove ...

JB: They have a work around so they can still do all that. If I start the fire the night before and leave it go all night, and now I can cook on it because I didn't start the fire. My neighbor came over and turned on the lights for me.

YADA: It's so hypocritical and disgusting. They turn the Shabat into the most torturous day of the week where they do everything *but* celebrate their relationship with Yah. They've become renegades and scoundrels.

"There are oaths uttered which are spiritually harmful ('alah – swearing things which are not true about God has become commonplace, counterproductive, and contrary to the truth, bringing about the lamentable curse of Allah) along with cringeworthy lies and debilitating deceptions (kachash – disappointing denials, false accusations, feigned compliance, and false claims).

Then there is disloyalty in the relationship (wa na'aph – religious fornication by worshiping false gods which is idolatrous adultery) whereby they breech the agreement in destructive, divisive, and damning ways (paras – they break our contract, breeching the covenant by urging an increase in the widespread rebellion).

Bloodshed becomes a violent plague of bloodletting (*wa dam ba dam naga'* – blood, death, and bloodguilt afflict and destroys everyone)." (*Howsha'* / Salvation / Hosea 4:2)

Wow! Come on, God, tell us what You really think. God, have you ever heard of political correctness? God, if you were on Facebook, they would censor You and freeze Your account. If you were a politician, you would be kicked out of office. God, you can't say these things in today's world. Oh yeah?

Speaking of the religion of Judaism which is spiritually harmful along with cringeworthy lies and debilitating deceptions. There is killing along with thievery. The entire rabbinical I'm going to charge you for this and that, no matter what it is, I'll come up with schemes for robbing the people.

Then there is disloyalty in the relationship (wa na'aph – religious fornication by worshiping false gods which is idolatrous adultery) whereby they breech the agreement in destructive, divisive, and damning ways (paras – they break our contract, breeching the covenant by urging an increase in the widespread rebellion).

How many religious Jews today have a goal to accept the conditions of the Covenant so they can

receive the benefits of being part of Yahowah's family?

Bloodshed becomes a violent plague of bloodletting (*wa dam ba dam naga'* – blood, death, and bloodguilt afflict and destroys everyone)." (*Howsha'* / Salvation / Hosea 4:2)

For those who have not yet read Prophet of Doom, you are likely unaware that rabbis in Yathrib are largely responsible for the curse that became Islam. Had they not cited Babylonian Talmud stories to Muhammad, charged him for them, and then mocked him when he convoluted them to serve his perverted interests, the Qur'an would have been the size of a pamphlet, lost all credibility, and Allah's little helper would have had no reason to annihilate Jews. But they did, and Yahowah is not pleased. They quite literally brought the curse of Allah on themselves and upon future generations of Jews because rabbis sold Muhammad Talmud stories which he integrated into his Our'an.

The same is true with Christianity, whereby a self-proclaimed rabbi turned on his own people and created the most deadly and demeaning religion Jews would ever encounter. Born as Sha'uwl, and known as Paul, the failed rabbi created the world's most popular religion, and with it, the worst treatment Jews would ever endure.

Jews have been their own worst enemy. So much of what they have written and said about God has been untrue that their lamentable claims have become as commonplace as they have been counterproductive. Through Judaism, Jews have been universally dishonest about and disloyal to Yahowah. Rabbinical lies have been cringeworthy, their deceptions debilitating, and their feigned compliance damning. All the while, they have robbed their own under deliberately false pretenses.

It is so obvious and yet they are in complete denial. It was so obvious that Yahowsha' was the Passover Lamb and they of all people should have known it and recognized him. And when somebody said, "Oh, no he's the Messiah," you're saying, "What in the world are you, Goy to talk about him being the Messiah?" Him being the Messiah would require that he be anointed. Who anointed him? If he's the Messiah, why didn't he claim to be the Messiah because he's not saying it. And oh, by the way, the Messiah is Dowd. Go read the text and book he's reciting from. Dowd is the Messiah. Yahowah anointed him. You want to call this guy "a Son of God"? Wait a minute. No. The Son of God is Dowd. Who are you kidding? The answer is no. The Son of God is Dowd. The Messiah is Dowd. You want a king? That's Dowd. The Second Coming nonsense? Have you not read the front of the Book? It's Dowd that's returning. What are you doing? When you read Yasha'yah or Dowd's Twenty-second or Eighty-eighth Psalm, this fellow you call Jesus (whose name is Yahowsha'), he's the Passover Lamb. That's a big job. Appreciate it. He's opening the Doorway to Life. But not a single Jew said it. Not one. You would have had no religion of Christianity if the Jews had simply known and said the truth. Instead, because they lied and because of their deception, a religion emerged that was wholly anti-Semitic. They condemned Jews for killing God. Come on, folks. He came to die; he was the Passover Lamb. Jews have been their own worst enemy. So much of what they have said and written about God has been untrue.

To say that God hates Judaism would be the understatement of the millennia. Rabbis have earned and deserve this rebuke. But they are not alone.

There was too much killing between Jews and among their enemies from the fall of *Yisra'el* | Israel in 721 BCE to the demise of *Yahuwdah* | Judah in 133 CE, but since that time Jews have been murdered by Gentiles, especially Christians and Muslims, at a rate that exceeds anything witnessed

in human history. But the bloodshed? Jews brought it on themselves. Yes, Rome was disgusting, but to rebel against Rome took a lot more than what the Jews had to offer, and the Jews were so disunited. Rome came against the Jews the first time because two brothers, both with Greek names, and a mother who also had a Greek name were fighting among themselves as to who would become King and who would become Chief Priest. There was more money to be had by becoming King but there was more power and prestige being the Chief Priest. There was such vicious fighting between the brothers over their quest for power that they each visited different Gentile countries asking them to induce war against their brother. Rome finally said it didn't care about Yisra'el and that it was only there because it cared about Egypt and Yisra'el is en route to Egypt and we can't have foreign armies in the middle of our pathway to Egypt. So that was the first Roman assault on Judah.

The second was when the Jews divided and decided they would lash out at Rome. Were they right, was Jesus the person's name who was imposing the Temple tax, robbing the treasury and doing disgusting things? But the way the Jews responded and then when the first Christians came in, and the way they obliterated them. You can get by with that stuff if you're trusting and relying upon Yahowah. Look at Hezekiah. Right? They didn't and they invited the slaughter. They were hauled off as slaves.

And then the worst was Rabbi Akiba and his veneration of his false Messiah – Bar Kokhba. He created the Diaspora. During the time Jews lost because there was too much infighting among the Jews; they were in three warring camps and killing each other. So much blood shed. It had become a plague of bloodshed. The Holocaust would never have occurred if it weren't for Rabbi Akiba.

Had Jews, Christians, Muslims, and Secular Humanists not been so hostile to the Covenant, so universally destructive, divisive, and damning in their approach to God, bloodshed would not have become a plague.

I have grown to hate religion and despise what it does to a people, their nation, and the world. But my animosity toward this plague and its perpetrators is but navel lint compared to the Almighty. And yet, in a world of cowards, I am among the few, if not the only individual, who takes rabbis to task for what they have said about Yahowah. It would take a Gentile because Jews still have not been willing to stand up for God, and they won't stand up to the rabbis even to this day.

There's a reason that God chose to reveal Himself to this generation through a lowly Gentile. Because, Jews, there are none of you willing to stand up, to take a stand. Just take the time to learn the truth and have the courage to say it.

Therefore, Yahowah asks....

"So how is it ('ak – and yet) not a single individual ('iysh' al – no one, not a single man) has chosen to oppose this, who has been determined to contentiously contend against it (ryb – has been willing to bring reasoned and factual arguments in opposition to this hostility (qal imperfect jussive – has decided to literally and consistently, on an ongoing basis, actually complain)?

How is it that out of all these people, at least 15 million Jews today, how is it not a single individual has chosen to oppose this; who has been determined to contend against it? Look at the Jews in America. Who are the men that are speaking out against the rabbis? A handful that has come to know Yahowah through our programs, translations, and testimony, but besides that is there anyone in Israel that is a voice against the rabbis? So, God says, "How is it there's not a single one of you?" How did we get this job? Why did Yahowah choose to reveal Himself through us? His

testimony to translate has been here for thousands of years; it's available to anybody. Take it seriously. Why would it take Gentiles to do this? Because not a single individual was chosen to oppose the religiosity and the politics. And there is none who choose to dispute their claims by arguing against them, rebuking them. Not a single individual. Everybody just goes along.

For (wa) your people ('am 'atah – your kin and nation) are as contentious and insulting as the priests (ka ryb kohen – are as quarrelsome and accusatory as the clerics, as taunting and averse as those performing the religious rites)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 4:4)

God is not humored by this. He's just flabbergasted that you could go so long and then so many of you would be allergic to the truth, be opposed to Him, that you would put up with this religious nonsense.

I understand that for a long time Yiddish is the language and that Hebrew was the unspoken language, and it is true that there haven't been good tools until fairly recently to be able to translate. There's no excuse now and very little time left. Wake up. God wants to reconcile His relationship with Yisra'el and Yahuwdah. He is promised to do so. Be among them. God deserves it and you'd benefit from it.

Yahowah does not often answer rhetorical questions but this time He did. The reason that there has not been a Jew willing to prove that the rabbis have continually lied about Him is because the people have become as contentious as their religious leaders.

This of course begs a question: Are Jews averse to Yahowah, because of rabbinical influence, or have the rabbis become influential by feeding off Jewish animosity towards God? If it wasn't for the overall animosity of the Jewish people towards God rabbis would not be empowered. But the rabbis have done their best to equate Rabbinic Judaism with the ethnicity of being a Jew and tried to control people.

Yahowah intended for the *Shaphat* | Judges to interpret His Towrah to help His people live harmoniously under its guidance. He intended for the *Kohen* | Priests to interpret His Miqra'ey to help His people capitalize on the benefits. These were not paid positions and God did not want those assigned to either role to reach around or past His Towrah. He did not want anyone taking away from it or adding to it as Jews, Christians, and Muslims have done to their detriment, especially the chief priests and rabbis.

Let's be clear, in fact unequivocal. Yahowah's scathing indictment of His people is leveled at their propensity to be religious. He is condemning Orthodox Judaism. If you are an Orthodox Jew, even a Christian, Muslim, or Secular Humanist, the best you can hope for is to be judged a victim rather than perpetrator of these plagues, such that your soul fades into oblivion upon your demise — as chaff blown away by the wind. But should your devotion to your religion, your politics, your sense of patriotism, your military support, your affinity for conspiracy theories, or desire to advance the debilitating myths of Socialist Secular Humanism (as now 90% of Americans under the age of 29) are doing, then the sentence of eternal incarceration in She'owl for having misled others is what you're going to endure. Choose wisely. God is not Politically Correct, religious, political, tolerant, multicultural, or amused.

If you look at Biden and his transitional team, he keeps on saying, and proves it, that his primary goal with his cabinet is to be multicultural to be diverse. There is no point where God says His goal is to be diverse. He has one name, one Towrah, one Covenant, one people, one land, one language. He wants us to be one with Him. So, I'm sorry, but Biden is as far as and as estranged

from God as is possible.

"Therefore (wa), you have stumbled and fallen (kashal – you are staggering, weak, and wounded, and you will be overthrown for a time (qal perfect)) this day (ha yowm – at this time). And the one who claims to speak for God (wa naby' – the prophet proclaiming the message of a deity, those attempting to convey and interpret the message of the gods and predict the future) has also (gam – in addition) faltered and stumbled (kashal – staggered and fallen, has wavered and failed (qal perfect)) with you ('im 'atah – in association with you) during the darkness (laylah – at night, without the light).

So therefore (wa – accordingly), I will make a parable of your destructive attempt to be like (damah – there will be no interaction and total silence because I see you as comparable to) your mother ('em 'atah – the one to whom you were conceived, born, nurtured, and raised, as well as the intersection of two different paths along your point of departure)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 4:5)

He's stumbled and fallen, especially the one who claims to speak for God there in the darkness.

So therefore (*wa* – accordingly), **I will make a parable of your destructive attempt to be like** (*damah* – there will be no interaction and total silence because I see you as comparable to) **your mother** (*'em 'atah* – the one to whom you were conceived, born, nurtured, and raised, as well as the intersection of two different paths along your point of departure)." (*Howsha'* / Salvation / Hosea 4:5)

This is a scathing indictment against the very people who would claim this testimony as being the inspired word of God; about the very people that this indictment is against are the ones who claim that their God inspired it. And that being the case, you had better wake up.

Yahowah uses *naby'* | prophet as He does *kohen* | priest, in the sense that there are good and bad versions of each. In a way, it is similar to His use of 'el and 'elohym, in that there is the One true God and lots of imposters.

When man is right with Yahowah, he is on his feet, looking up and reaching up, observant and responsive, active and engaged in the relationship. When man is wrong with God, he is on his knees, head bowed, hands clasp, eyes and mind shut, rendered comatose/unresponsive by religion. We can soar with Yahowah through space and time or we can stumble and fall with our fellow man. Those are the choices before us.

More than any other reason, mankind has stumbled and fallen because those who claim to speak for God have wavered, and in the process, they have failed the people. And none more so than Orthodox rabbis. When considering those Yahowah is admonishing, there are many who deserve this indictment. The plague of death who conceived the Christian religion, *Sha'uwl* | Paul, a failed rabbi and renegade Jew, became a prime example in 50 CE when he falsely claimed to have been chosen to speak for the Messiah. Rabbi Akiba, who connived his way into power, and whose endorsement of a false Messiah in 133 CE led to the Diaspora, and who became the father of Judaism, is also among the worst of the worst. He is an exemplar of this condemnation. Another Jew in 622 CE, claiming initially to be the Messiah, Muhammad, became known as a prophet and messenger of a different sort of god – one modeled after Satan. His religion grew among 'Arabs, meaning "darkness" in Hebrew, which is intriguing considering Yahowah's reference to *naby* 'and *laylah* meaning "night; darkness." A prophet of darkness.

Most English translations render the concluding verb, damah, as "I will destroy" your mother. But

that has not happened, it is a non sequitur, and as such, it would not have been appropriate, and it is not the primary meaning of the word. The problem here is that the people had been corrupted by their religious leaders, and they were now being nurtured and raised in a toxic environment, making the allusion to one's "mother" a metaphor. Therefore, Yahowah is revealing that His people had "damah – become a parable as a result of their destructive attempt to resemble" the way they were raised. As a result, "damah – there would be no interaction and total silence because God had begun to see them as comparable to" "em – the intersection of their point of departure." What was their point of departure? Religious whoredom; prostituting themselves to false gods and, of course, in Howsha' God makes it exceedingly clear as to the false god that they are prostituting themselves to. He calls it Lord, the very word that they replaced Yahowah's name throughout their Tanakh is Adonai, the Lord. The Lord is Satan. Sad, huh?

What follows is among the most salient statements in the whole of the Towrah and Prophets. And in this context, it is as germane to the current status of God's people as anything ever written about them.

As a result, through the prophet *Howsha'* / Salvation, Yahowah said something gut-wrenching...

"My people ('am 'any – My nation, kin, and family, those with whom I have associated) are ineffective and silenced in this way, serving as a metaphor for self-inflicted destruction, perishing because of what they have done to themselves (damah – they have ceased to be effective and are a similitude for what it is like to be cut off, they are a parable for a ruinous state, separated and no longer engaged in the mission, their imagination and thinking have caused themselves to be wiped out (nifal perfect – the people have done this to themselves)) as a result of (min – from, out of, and because of) a lack of knowledge and corrupted information (bely ha da'ath – ignorance and a complete failure to understand, a dearth of wisdom and a deficiency in perceptiveness and awareness, being without discernment or comprehension by negating that which is knowable and reasonable, nullifying what is true).

Indeed, because (*ky* – it is certain that) **you have avoided and rejected** ('*atah ma'as* – you have limited your association with and diminished the importance of, you have spurned and shown an aversion to, you have refused to accept, disdained, and sometimes despised, even loathed (qal perfect – literally during your finite time)) **this knowledge which leads to understanding** (*ha da'at* – the acquisition of valid information, being perceptive, rational, and reasonable, showing discernment and good judgement, appropriately acknowledging or comprehending the relationship), **I will also avoid and reject you** (*wa ma'as 'atah* – it follows that I will actually diminish My association with you as our relationship dissolves and becomes less vital, I will become adverse to you and refuse to accept you, showing an aversion to you (qal imperfect – actually with ongoing implications over time)) **from approaching Me or serving as priests** (*min kahan la 'any* – from functioning on My behalf, from being associated with My Teachings, ministering during the Miqra'ey, or performing any role regarding Me).

And since you have overlooked and forgotten (wa shakach – because you have not been mindful of the significance, have responded inappropriately to, and since you have ceased to care about, even ignored (qal imperfect – have actually made a habit of failing to regard)) the *Towrah* | Guidance (*Towrah* – Instructions, Teaching, and Directions) of your God ('elohym 'atah), I will overlook and cease to care about (shakach 'any – I will not remember, be mindful of, or respond to (qal imperfect)) your children also (ben 'atah gam – your descendants and offspring as well)." (Howsha' / Salvation / Hosea 4:6)

So, what you have here are Jews falling in love with the Mishnah, the Zohar, and the Talmud and they pay no attention to the Towrah. You had a Jew creative religion where he besmirched, condemned and assaulted the Towrah and then came up with his books as part of a new testament. God said, "No. You've overlooked and forgotten My Towrah; I'm going to forget your children and your children's children and your children's children. If you forget and reject the Towrah teaching guidance of Yahowah, He will forget you because when we forget it our children forget it. That was the whole idea of circumcision on the eighth day that we circumcised our sons. It says you circumcised every male (beriyth kar)? It helps them remember and it helps us remember to raise our children so that they grow up knowing, understanding, and making the right decision regarding the Covenant. Then we're doing what we should be doing. But if we ignore the Towrah we're ignoring the Covenant because it's only presented in the Towrah. If we're ignoring the Towrah we're ignoring the purpose of the seven Mow'ed Migra'ey because they're only presented in the Towrah. If we ignore the Towrah were ignoring the importance of Yahowah's name. We're ignoring God's request for us to walk away from religion and politics to become part of His family. If we ignore the Towrah then there's nothing that God can do for us. Nothing. He can't save you apart from the Towrah. He can't protect you apart from the Towrah. He can't even listen to you apart from the Towrah. He can't do a thing for you other than say "I have nothing to do with... So, all He can say is look at my Towrah. For all these centuries God said there was no one. Stop it already. Stop being in rebellion. Stop giving credence to the most disgusting people on the planet - the rabbis and the super religious. What have they gotten you besides misery? What have they gotten themselves besides misery? Why do you think they're wearing black mourning coats all the time? Why do you think they have to threaten their children and their spouses to keep them in this misery? Stop it already. Stop listening to them and listen to Yahowah. That's His advice. Listen to Yahowah. Do you want to start listening to Yahowah? Start reading the Towrah. Those initial stories are marvelous! God's explanation of creation giving that credibility. His relationship with Adam and then Chawah in the Garden. Every word is a treasure. The explanation of Noach and how he listened to Yahowah and did what Yahowah said. And then at the end Yahowah said, "This is my Covenant. This is how I protect those who are willing to listen to Me." And then He gives the sign which is His bow of light. And over and over again He would say listen to Me. And when He freed them from Egypt's crucibles of oppression and spoke to them, what did they say? Oh, my you're scaring us to death. Please speak to us through Moses. Don't speak to us directly. Just stop it already. Listen to Yahowah. He's smart. He's funny. He's protective. He is loving and uplifting. He doesn't want to be worshipped. He doesn't want you to bow down. He doesn't want your money. He's not asking for faith or asking you to believe Him. Just take the time to listen to Him and hear what He has to say. He's enlightening, uplifting, liberating and enriching. It's so much better. You lose nothing by giving up the religion and you gain everything by being part of the relationship. Start celebrating His name. It's Yahowah. Embrace the Covenant, read the Towrah, celebrate the Migra'ey as they were intended. Capitalize on what God is offering. It has been 2,700 years. Enough already!

I will pick this up at this time next week. I'm sorry to be so condemning of Judaism. I know that's hard for people to hear but when we started this, we made ... We're going to go where the words lead. This is what God is saying, there is no other way to interpret this. As you said, that's an accurate translation. It is an accurate translation and there is not a variety of ways to interpret these words. This is straightforward as they come.

KIRK: I check them all the time. You just can't go any other way.

JB: Whenever God is being condemning, the words He uses are pretty straight forward. There's not a lot of complicated words with dual meaning. When He's condemning, He is cut and dried.

YADA: Yes. Now, there are times where those who are His prophets are speaking for Him and you try to translate some things and there's some things that are tough to translate. The language doesn't flow perfectly. We've lost a lot of meaning along the way. But you're right, JB. When God is going to expose his ... for being religious the concepts are not difficult to understand. They were exceedingly straightforward and easy to comprehend, albeit painful. How'd you like to be the Creator of the universe and do all these things for your people, offer them everything and they spit on your face? And you're still there and say, "You know, I'm willing to overlook it." If He can overlook what 'Abraham did He can overlook what you and your people have done. Just stop and He will look the other way. Actually, He will envelop you in a garment of light. If just stop and reach out to Him He'll look you right in the eye and see nothing but beauty. It's worth it. He's trustworthy.

So, we'll pick this back up but as I say it's impossible to see this any other way. It's not like Howsha' stands alone and there's only one book condemning religion and the rest are somehow different because you can read the Towrah and what it says, you can read the Prophets and what they say, and no matter what you're reading this is what God is saying. Look at the prophetic book of Yasha'yah. It starts out in the first like 15 chapters, and the entire message is condemning religion and politics. The same is true in Yirma'yah. It's a consistent message. So, it ought not be that difficult to understand. It's time we encourage people to take the unpopular stand of speaking out against religion, politics, and militarism; to walk away and disassociate from it.

We're in really a mess between the world's response to coronavirus, the amount of fraud that appears to be in the elections today, the degradation of reason amongst youth, the rise of Jihadi Islam and anti-Semitism around the world, the huge increase in conspiracies and those who are adhering to them, and the total destruction of the western economies based upon the Draconian move of leftist governments. We're in a were in a real tough time. And yet you can live even in the middle of all this totally joyfully. I can tell you when I read, I get angry and frustrated for God.

My life is extraordinary happy and fulfilling. I was sitting here this morning and I felt a call to expand the story of Noach. In all this time, I've never grasped God's statement regarding His bow and what the colors of that bow signified and how the colors tie in with each of the Mow'ed Miqra'ey. Then in the midst of it I felt compelled to follow Dowd's example. Remember in the 119th Psalm Dowd wrote eight stanzas to each letter in the Hebrew alphabet in alphabetic order to explain how we should observe the Towrah? He emphasizes on the Aleph with aleph-filled words. And each letter after is filled with words containing its own letter. So, I associated each color of the rainbow with each of the seven Mow'ed Migra'ey.

I said, all right. The first is Pesach. I looked at every single Hebrew word that started with the pey that was associated with Pesach and then we got to Matsah. I went through the entire Hebrew lexicon and listed all the ___many marvelous words start with it and that are essential to our understanding of this day. I've always referred to Matsah as the threshold where we clean our feet when we walk into God and we've been given immortality through the Doorway of Life on Pesach and yet we still have to be cleansed as we're walking into God's home before were adopted into His family. Do you know that the only word in Hebrew for threshold is a mem word? Isn't that amazing? ... it's so much fun to go through.

You know, Jackie is so enormously important and valuable to us in preparing these books for

publication. She had already turned in the book and here I have ____ pages and she's such a sweetheart. She didn't complain. She says (they are the truth)? I really liked it. I gave her the opportunity to cut it out and she wouldn't take out a single word of it.

It was really interesting to go through that because everything had been done for Adam, then I pulled out all the "a" words and it'll be published shortly. So, I encourage everybody to buy a copy of the *Story of Man*, and that's how it ends in the last chapter. So, the whole thing from beginning to end has new translations and insights. There are lots of things in it. I definitely take 'Abraham to task for what he did when going into Egypt. As a matter of fact, as I was doing it Leah said, "Lay off. You keep saying that 'Abraham wasn't the sharpest tool in the shed. This is the father of the Covenant. You need to lay off this." I said, "I'll tell you what I'm going to do. I'm going to finish the translation and I'm going to say this is what God revealed. These are the words He chose. When we're done, we're going to look at it and say what can you make of this other than... it is what He said. So, there are lots of things in there that are very controversial.

One of my favorite editor's was reading and said, "Why are you so hostile towards Chawah?" Well, because of the names she chose to give to her two boys. And you say, what am I to make of this? It's not pretty, so what are you going to do? Are you going to try to figure out what would have caused this animosity? Because it's bad. But she was saying why do you have all this animosity? She chose these really horrible names. You've got a deal with it. And if you're going to say, well she chose these horrible names. One is and your way to rebel and push back against God. The other name is waste of breath. Able is the one with a waste of breath and the murderer is her way of rebelling. You see that and what are you going to do, just ignore it? I think ... we're super judgmental and right is right and wrong is wrong and we just don't ignore it. If it's there we're going to deal with it. We don't have all the answers, but you're never going to increase your understanding if you at least don't consider the possibilities. It's a big picture out there and like Jackie wrote me talking about it being so bad what 'Abraham did. Maybe the answer is the same as God gives us that all these people were highly flawed, yet they were the best that God could find to work with. They were at least willing and open to listen to Him and do the right thing, so that means that there's hope for the likes of me, you know with all my flaws. I can't measure up to the devotion of Moseh. Once Moseh got it he was spectacular. Dabarym/Deuteronomy, that's all him and man I can't measure up to that level of devotion. You read Dowd's Psalms, his soaring intellect, his physical ability. That's his gift. I'm glad that's his gift. But if we compare ourselves to the worst, Dowd's firstborn rapes his daughter and he doesn't take a stand against that and so his third-born kills the firstborn son because of what he did to his sister. And he doesn't really deal with that such that the same third-born then leads a coup against him, and then when the man who led a coup against a united Yisra'el and against God's anointing of Dowd as Messiah is killed for this coup Dowd cries like a baby. God gave Dowd three choices that you have in dealing with this problem and he picked the absolute worst. And you go, "Oh, come on. Even I could have done better than that. What's wrong with you?" It's God's way of saying you don't have to be perfect. I'm not looking for perfect. I'm looking for open, responsive, reasonable. Just listen to what I have to say and then respond in an intelligent way. I'm not asking for a lot.

KIRK" You said it a long time ago and that was so clear, but people, even us, said well.... But Yahowah wants you to be right and He'll take care of the rest.

YADA: Just be right. And what did Yahowah was say about 'Abraham? "I credited his understanding with him being right. If God thinks you're right everything else is good. Dowd was right. I'm so glad there's a Dowd because it means the rest of us ____because he's going to get the

chance to herd these cats. That's a job I wouldn't want to have. I am ready to retire. We'll go off and be the bleacher bums. But other than Dowd's job all the rest of is really cool.

One of my favorite things is the veneration of Yasha'yah. After no one listening to him in his lifetime he now gets to see that it's his words, when properly shared and interpreted, are the Catalyst in bringing His people home more than any other, and that's very pleasing to me. And ultimately that God gets to celebrate His love for His most beloved, His Chosen One, His Son in Dowd. That's also really pleasing, and it's thrilling to me to see God take this flock of ____ exceedingly brilliant and passionate man, and Him working through him in this mighty way. We're just lucky to be here, fortunate to be here, and happy to be here.

We're condemning Judaism because God loves His people. He wants you to start listening. Reject the religion so that you can be part of Yah's family.
