## Shabat Study April 2, 2021, by Yada

Please Note: I have transcribed this to the best of my ability. Sound bites of parties speaking simultaneously and those which were inaudible to me have been deleted from the transcript. If I guessed at a word, it was followed by ()? A \_\_\_\_\_ (blank line) indicates I could not understand the word or phrase and three periods ... indicate an interruption in the dialogue of one party by another. Thank you for your understanding. Good evening and Happy Shabat. It is the conclusion of the celebration of Pesach, Matsah, Bikuwrym for us in the Caribbean and probably close to the conclusion of the celebration for those living on the Eastern seaboard of the United States, and for you, Kirk, in the land of fruits and nuts, you still have a couple hours to go.

We had matsah for dinner again tonight before the show for good measure because we like it and we had a Hezekiah Pesach anyway in that we did Pesach on Friday and Saturday evenings.

I didn't want to share this news story last week when it came out. It was too disgusting. But now that we've finished with Yahowah's first three celebrations for this year, I want to share some news from New Zealand. A commission in New Zealand found that a quarter of a million children were physically and sexually abused in New Zealand by faith-based institutions and overwhelmingly by the Roman Catholic Church from the 1960s into the 2000s. The inquiry found that children, some as young as nine months old, suffered years of abuse including rape and electric shock treatment by staff and state psychiatric workers, clergy and foster guardians. The quote is, "We acknowledge that the systems and culture of the Church allowed abuse to occur. These systems and culture failed, and they must change," said Cardinal Drew. The population of New Zealand is 5 million, and yet a quarter of a million children as young as nine months old were sexually and physically abused by the Church. I want to say as flatly as I know how that the Roman Catholic Church and the religion it spread across the globe by compulsion is the single most disgusting institution in the history of mankind. God despises it, and if you are a Roman Catholic shame on you. It is a disgusting institution. God hates it. I hate it. You should hate it. These despicable individuals should all be locked up from the Pope on down. Hell is too kind a place for where the popes, cardinals, bishops and priests are headed. They deserve far worse, and I hope that God sees to it that they endure it.

YADA: 5 million. And you've got a quarter million children being abused in a population of 5 million? How does an institution this reprehensible survive? It survives because the people who call themselves Roman Catholics are as disgusting as their church.

Let me speak to another disgusting religion. I am so sick and tired of receiving absolute rubbish from the conspiratorial whackos that are now on an anti-vac crusade. They will claim everything from a gazillion miscarriages to, well there's one congresswoman who says they are the mark of the beast. Good god, it's a vaccine! If you don't want to live, that's your choice. If you don't want to be responsible for your own life, go die someplace. See if I care. But because you're unwilling to take it others will die. And because of your moronic conspiracies particularly when you associate them in the context of Yahowah's word, you not only destroy your credibility but all of those that you spend any time with and around. Go away!

The newest conspiracy has the Muslim that killed 10-12 people in Boulder, Colorado said it was a false flag and never happened. What ever happened to evidence and reason, to just thinking or to being reasonable and rational? What is it with people?

Speaking of stupid, the AstraZeneca vaccine, I'd have to think long and hard before I'd take a Chinese or Russian vaccine because of their efficacy, not for any other reason. The next worse on the list is a vaccine that was developed and manufactured in the U.K. It was the Oxford-AstraZeneca and has all of Europe in a tizzy fit. Europe \_\_\_\_\_ to treat Britain like crap because of because no one else would try to leave the European Union. That didn't work out very well for them because the only vaccine developed within Europe is the Oxford-AstraZeneca vaccine. It was developed in Oxford, England and is manufactured in the U.K. The U.K. is screaming bloody murder because they aren't getting enough of those vaccines and yet the U.K., who developed it, said, "Hey, wait a minute. We developed it. We are manufacturing it. We're happy to sell it to you but we're not going to license other people to make it. We have a responsibility to our own people first. And we don't trust you because you've already gone on record saying that you need (fairness)? In vaccine and yet we need to be giving them to the Fakestinians, Africans and to everybody else in the world who had nothing to do with developing them and for them or manufacturing them." Yes, it's a nice thing to do. Once the people had paid for, created and manufactured the vaccine have vaccinated a sufficient number of their people to rid their country of this virus, then it is noble and appropriate to sell the vaccine at very favorable prices to other countries. It's good for everybody. But you don't do it first. It's like if you are in an airplane that depressurization. You don't put your child's mask on and then put yours on because then you're both going to fall asleep. I'm amazed by our universal stupidity.

The biggest problem for us is that our economy is so out of whack because we've had morons, and your governor is probably the worst of them, think they are in a position to somehow manage the economy and decide what is and is not essential and tell people when they can and can't go to work. It's truly amazing what they claim they are able to do. I cannot even fathom how much damage has been done. Most of it has been done to the supply lines where somebody says that's not an essential business when the whole thing is inner related. The combination of that and ten trillion dollars spending on the corona virus because you wanted people to become dependent upon you, and you shut them in. People are up in arms because there are so many mass shootings during the recent month or so. And it's no wonder because we are social creatures and yet you're ... depriving them of their livelihood. You are controlling every aspect of their lives. People around the edge are either killing themselves, drugging themselves into oblivion, or worse. We are in the position where it is only blind faith that keeps our economy going. There is no substance to it anymore. Any thoughts, Kirk?

KIRK: Yes I do. We are an empire. I've never looked at it any other way than an empire. Because I have spent a lot of time reading history books and studying it seems to be the one common denominator of an empire that collapses is when they run out of money. ... The Romans took a long time and most of that often comes from expansion and trying to control areas that are no longer cost effective.

YADA: The Romans are a classic case. The Romans stopped making anything and they didn't want to work anymore so they enslaved people's work. To enslave people you must have an enormous military. First you have to constantly go out and enslave more people. People don't like that very much, and the people you have enslaved don't like it very much...slaves inside your country want to rebel and those countries you have taken slaves from want to kill you. After a while you get to a position where you're not doing anything, you're not making anything, and you can't support the military to impose slavery.

KIRK: That's the whole thing. And you can only borrow so much money as countries have done. England has problems and we propped them up because we had the money, and they didn't. So, with that as a backdrop you start thinking about the news stories and where we are. There are some really interesting stories in the last couple weeks. For instance, there are seven countries, including Russia and India, that now are officially buying oil with Chinese Yuan. That's devastating to the US dollar because the only thing that is propping up the US dollar that makes it valuable, there's nothing behind it, is there are two things you have to do. You must buy oil in US dollars, so you have to have a supply of US dollars.

YADA: The US dollar is the world's primary reserve trust and all trade between countries is conducted in dollars. However, with the advent of the Euro, with the rise of China, and with the beginning of crypto currency there are now many countries doing business using the Chinese yuan or the European community euro. Crypto currencies are no longer trading in dollars, and there are a lot of countries buying goods with the Russian ruble. And when we ... erode our reserve currency status then no one needs to hold dollars and when you don't need to hold dollars the currency becomes essentially worthless.

YADA: Freefall right now and continue to be in freefall because they've gone from being primarily a secular country to a fundamental Islamic country and Erdogan is one of the most draconian dictators in the world, and that is a flash point for world war because of what he has done to his country.

KIRK: You've talked a lot about the way the world is lining up which is like World Wars I and II only we now have the China factor. But from the time we've destroyed the Middle East with our malfeasance, which no one has been \_\_\_\_\_ (admit)? but you hear it here certainly. You've got Russia tied up with China and Iran. They don't need the oil or natural gas. They've got all they need, so they are in a powerful position, and they are not trading with dollars. Then you've got Europe and America and we are tied up with the Saudis. The tragedy of that is where does that leave Israel? And that's where the war will come from. That's the way everything lines up.

The last thing I was thinking about was in 1980 our budget was 6 billion dollars. In 2020 six billion dollars a year is our debt payment. The U.S. public debt ratio to GDP (Gross Domestic

Product) is currently at the highest in modern history. Historically in the U.S. when the ratio hit 90%, we suffered extreme inflation. This is not to scare anybody but to make you aware of what's going on. What we've done before we will do again. They we have inflation from anywhere from 6 - 17% annually. According to history books 1915 went on for about two years. In 1972 under the Carter administration, if you recall, and I lived through that and lived within 10% in our bank account. Everything was going up. We now in 2020 according to government records are 127.3% of our GDP. No one has ever survived that. In 2021 we'll hit well over 140. What can you do?

YADA: Nothing. By the way we have someone in the chatroom that has been with the show for quite some time. He calls himself yhwhsoldier, and I'll guarantee you he has nothing to do with Yahowah. He is ranting about all kinds of conspiratorial myths about the vaccines. I find it absolutely repulsive. The one thing that I've asked from the beginning is that if you want to pursue conspiracies get the hell away from here. Go play with somebody else. Go make pretend in your own little world because your very association is exceedingly disruptive and it's unbelievably destructive to credibility. I don't want you anywhere near us. Literally. If conspiracy is your religion and you want to believe that Bill Gates is trying to poison people and pharmaceutical companies whole mythos is let's see how many people we can control with government, and that vaccines are somehow a counterproductive thing as opposed to probably the most beneficial scientific invention in history then I do not want to share anything ... I don't want to share the space, the time, I don't want you in my chat room; I just want you to go away. You're disgusting; you're an idiot. What's next, chemtrails? What's after that, Building 7 at the World Trade Center, false flags? Why don't you go play with Larry in Unpopular Truth? You guys belong together.

You remind me of a nut case who was constantly writing me about how Trump had this whole army, and he was going to retain power and was going to reveal that Biden was in some kind of cahoots with somebody and that the whole fraud of the election was going to be such that Trump was going to be empowered as the next president. After 50 different emails, every one of which would make these bold claims and none of them turned out to be true, I wrote this person and I said, "I haven't bothered you in all of this stuff and I disbelieve it. But now that you have promoted all of this rubbish for all of this time and none of it turned out to be true, what in the hell is wrong with you?"

I came out with concern about the messenger RNA vaccine. I said, "This is new to science and I'm not certain that this is the best thing in the world. I not sure I want my DNA messed with and I did some research to see what it was all about. One of the things I learned is that it does not change your DNA. It's a messenger code written into the messenger strip of RNA to produce the antibodies. What a stunningly clever invention. And for this congresswoman in Washington to claim that this is the mark of the beast and is somehow controlling your ability to think or to give the government control over you as opposed to protecting you from a virus, why don't you think that Pfizer provided Israel with some 12 million doses of this vaccine? Israel has kept astonishingly good records and has demonstrated over a very large cross section of people that if you take the vaccine, you are not going to die from the corona virus, that you've got a 96% likelihood that you'll never get it and a 99.9% likelihood that if you do get it you'll be either asymptomatic or will not have issues with it that require hospitalization, and you're not going to

die. I like those odds. I really like living. God's promise to protect us so that we can share His message is not from our own stupidity. If I don't eat, I'm going to die. If I am so stupid that if in the middle of a pandemic, I'm irresponsible enough to say I don't want a vaccine that will give me a 99% of a chance of staying around, I'd better not take that. I want to test God. I want to make God have to work double time to make certain that everybody's hand that I shake, everybody that I meet is somehow controlled, so they don't get corona virus and they bring it to me. Wake up people. That's my point of view. If this is what you want to do with your life you go do it, but you go do it someplace else. Don't associate with Yahowah's name, don't associate yourself with the Covenant or with anything that I have written. Crawl into a hole. I despise conspiracy and so does God. God despises conspiracies for lots of reasons. Most of them evolve from or devolve to the point of blame the Jews. Christianity is a cult based upon claiming that the Jews killed Jesus.

Now that I mention it, today is the day Christians call Good Friday and of course they don't even have the date right. Pesach was last Friday but to hell with them. Getting the date right means nothing. They claim that today is good because this is the day that you have the dead god on a stick, the symbol of their religion. And then they claim that the Jews are the ones who killed him. Since when did Jews participate in crucifixions? Well they did participate in crucifixion. They were crucified by the Romans. The Jews are experts in crucifixion, it's true, because it was perpetrated by the Romans. Let's just pretend that these numbskulls with Christianity were somehow right and the Jews killed God. Well then good god, we ought to be worshipping the Jews.

The basis of Christianity is that all those promises that God made to Jews that He's going to fulfill to the end of time, when God is talking to Pharoah through Moseh one of the things He constantly says is, "Let My people go." Do you know why He said, "Let My people go?" So they could choose of their own free will to want the same thing. So we can celebrate a three-day journey into a place where we can ponder the Word. Why does God want them to work with Him? Why was this going to be a celebration of a three-day journey into the word? Because the (words)? are the medium of our communication with God. Had He not created His people, had they not chosen, at least some of them, to work with Him, God would be literally unknowable. We wouldn't know His name or anything about Him, and the only means to develop a relationship with Him would be unknown. Not a single person would be saved, not one. That would be the end of life for all of us with no hope for tomorrow because all of it was communicated through Jews/Yisra'elites. And yet these numskulls of Christians want you to believe that because God was killed by Jews, which is impossible on two fronts, they had no control over life and death in the Roman Republic and he was crucified which was the Roman form of punishment. But nonetheless they claim God got really pissed off at those Jews for killing Him.

One thing I learned in Volume Four of *Questioning Paul* which is completed, published and available at Amazon, is the most comprehensive review of how the Christian New Testament beyond just Paul's letters were written and the role that Odysseus, both the Iliad and the Odyessy, the Sibylline Oracles, and most particularly Paul's influence over Mark, Luke, and over the writer under the pseudonym of Matthew and how those books were all written one five, one ten, one

twenty years after Paul's death based upon Paul's influence over those individuals. They read like Paul's letters because they are the gospel according to Paul. And it's all out there for you.

Today we're reconstructing a house and our little community won't allow anyone to work on a holiday. Today is a holiday in my community, Good Friday. No one can work and I was just disgusted. All day it has eaten at me, and the realization is that Christianity is the most popular cult ever conceived and it is a death cult that was based upon the conspiracy Blame the Jews.

KIRK: The tragedy of celebrating the crucifixion that releases the soul then you still have sin on the soul and not participating in Matsah is the cruelest thing in the history of mankind because it wasn't His intent that anyone goes to She'owl.

YADA: I don't think we have to worry about too many Christians celebrating Pesach without Matsah, they are too enamored with their dead god on a stick.

Returning to where we were two weeks ago as we were considering what transpired immediately outside the Garden, why things devolved so quickly to the point where Yahowah had to do the grand reset and start over with humankind/Adam with a neshamah. The passage we read at the end of last week's show is as follows. This is Yahowah speaking to Qayn before he became a murderer.

"If ('im – to the contrary and based upon the proposition) you act appropriately and are pleasant to be around (yatab – if you are consistently cheerful and happy doing what is expected and right, you are pleasing, and joyful, reasonable to deal with (hifil imperfect)), you'll find forgiveness and acceptance (sa'eth – your situation will improve dramatically because you will be lifted up, supported, and sustained, you will ascend, rising in status and honor, be exonerated, experiencing an increase in dignity, brilliance, esteem, and illustriousness).

And if (*wa 'im*) you act inappropriately and are miserable to be around (*lo' yatab* – aren't pleasant, pleasing, or joyful, if you continue to be wrong and hard to deal with (hifil imperfect)), then the sin of being wrong and going astray (*chata'* – the offense of being guilty by missing the way, being ignorant and incorrect) is crouching (*rabats* – lying in wait) in the doorway (*la ha petach* – within the portal and entrance as well as the opening to understanding, the unfolding of knowledge, the disclosure of revelation).

You are too into yourself (*wa 'atah 'el*). These intense desires and impulses, the overwhelming urge for dominance and yearning for salvation (*teshuwqah huw'* – it is the uncontrollable emotions, strong feelings and cravings, the need to win, and passion for conquest) are things you must learn to better explain and govern (*wa 'atah mashal ba huw'* – you should seek to understand and learn how to control)." (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:7)

The thing that strikes me as I read the first part is there is nothing more debilitating than a bad attitude and nothing more empowering than a good attitude. But a good and bad attitude ought not be defined by our propensity to be accommodating and accepting. For example, I just went on a tirade against conspiracy in our midst, how God detests it. I detest what God detests. I've worked too damned hard to share Yahowah's message as accurately and as completely on behalf of His people to see nincompoops undermine it with such rubbish.

You read Yahowah's testimony and there are lots of times where Yahowah says these people are horrible. I've been translating the Prelude to Passover, and it's God's overt condemnation against Mitsraym – the crucibles of human oppression. He doesn't like them at all, and He said so. So, you can have a good attitude and still expose and condemn corruption. As a matter of fact if you don't expose and condemn that which is harmful to God's people then that's really displaying a bad attitude.

Hate is a virtue I've said that many times. You just need to know what to hate and how to hate. You don't hate with your fists, this was Qayn's problem. We need to know what to hate. Qayn hated all the wrong things. He hated his brother's success, he hated Yahowah's rebuke when Yahowah's rebuke was in fact designed to instruct him. If we didn't know what to hate, like religion, politics and conspiracy and how to hate it which is to use our words any other way.

The second part of this is part of what we were beginning to discuss and closed the show with two weeks ago:

You are too into yourself (*wa 'atah 'el*). These intense desires and impulses, the overwhelming urge for dominance and yearning for salvation (*teshuwqah huw'* – it is the uncontrollable emotions, strong feelings and cravings, the need to win, and passion for conquest) are things you must learn to better explain and govern (*wa 'atah mashal ba huw'* – you should seek to understand and learn how to control)." (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:7)

There are so many odd things about Christianity. The idea that God would die, the curtain-call for the Passover Lamb, the Babylonian Trinity, contradicting everything about ... we are going to worship on Sunday, even the notion of a god that would want an inferior being that he created to worship him isn't worth knowing. Of those, one of the greatest is that they expect God to save them even though they are unwilling to listen to anything He has to say. They want a God whose name they don't even know to allow them to live eternally with Him. They are willing to accept and bow down to a false god and are willing to make a contribution to a church that abuses a quarter of a million children as young as nine months old in a country of five million, and they expect a god who despises all that to say, "Yes. Come on into My home. I really want more of that. What could be better than to have someone that abuses my children?" This notion that a god they won't even listen to, a god whose name makes them cringe when they say it, a god whose teaching they despise, is supposed to save them. This saying is for you, Christian! You are way into yourself. It's this idea that I'm going to pray to God and tell Him what I want. He doesn't give a rat's patootie and has no interest in listening to you. He does not care what grade you get on the test, how hard you hit the baseball, or what girl you date. He does not care. Part of the reason He does not care is because you do not care to listen to Him. You are too way into yourself as opposed to finding out what God is saying, what He is offering, and what He is expecting in return.

Pharoah twice in the Prelude to Passover said, "Okay. I'm wrong. Yahowah's right. Let's just all get along. Stop the hail, stop the locusts." The second time he said, "Okay I may have done something at sometime that was somewhat incorrect. But only once, so it's no big deal. Let's all just get along. I want you to accept me." In the second place where we all translated God "hardened Pharoah's heart," at this point there is one place where He says, "stiffened his judgement," "He made his ... but in this particular one He says, "No. I honored and rewarded Pharoah's judgments." So, that's a powerful statement that people just read over and probably never think of, but look how much there was for us to learn in that statement.

As I shared some of the commentary I wrote on this chapter we ought not seek salvation and we don't preach salvation here. If your goal is to be saved, go away with all the conspiratorial nut cases. God doesn't want to save you. He's not offering to save you. Even the Hebrew word *yasha'* is the primary word to be translated ... The first meaning is "to deliver." The second is "to free," the third meaning is "to liberate," the fourth meaning is "to keep from harm's way." If only "saving" not in this eternal sense of "I'm going to save you from your sins so you can live in heaven and avoid hell." No. It's never used that way. Even when it's translated as "save" it's I'm saving you from man and religion.

The lone prerequisite of the Covenant is to walk away from human political, religious, and cultural alliances. It is only then that we can act upon the next three: allowing Yahowah to perfect us, trusting and relying upon Him, and doing so by closely examining and carefully considering the conditions of His Covenant. The fifth condition is to circumcise our sons, showing Yah that we intend to raise them such that they will also choose to separate themselves from the *babel* of men.

Contrary to religious belief, God does not want us worshiping Him or seeking to placate Him. He wants us to rise up, stand up, and become ever more like Him by thinking our way to Him.

I am constantly pondering what is it about Dowd that caused Yahowah to say, "I chose him. Then after He says, "I chose him." My criterion for evaluating man is different than man's." So you think about, what do men like when they choose or vote for somebody. Tall? Articulate? Clever with words? Pretty face? Are they rich and powerful? All the things that man says, that is what appeals to people. I guess for many years it was your ability to fight was the thing most appealing. That was how you became King. God says, "No. The things that appeal to men about men do not appeal to me. I have a different criterion."

God said He chose Dowd, so how is Dowd different? Dowd was brilliant, thoughtful, very articulate, a superb and perhaps the greatest writer of all time. His Psalms and Proverbs were great. He was a man's man. When it came to protecting God's people there's only one, legitimate reason for violence. It's the imminent threat to harm one of your own family. His family was Yisra'el, and he protected Yisra'el from harm. He wasn't going half-way around the world on some crusade. He was the opposite of Alexander the Great who left Macedonia and never came back. He wasn't protecting Macedonia. Julius Caesar went into Gaul and Spain and came back with lots of slaves. And the next thing you knew rather than protect Rome, he attacked Rome. Genghis Kaun, Gulbis Kaun, Tamerlane, weren't defending Mongolia. They were out robbing the world. Dowd was unique and an extremely skilled soldier that only fought to defend his people. God liked that and called him His shepherd; He likes shepherds. He called him His song writer; He likes songs, this man's songs for sure. He called him His chosen king for His kingdom forever. He liked Dowd's style of leadership. He made Dowd a prophet; He trusted Dowd with His words. That's the kind of fellow we ought to be emulating in our lives if we want to be useful to God and

if we want to please Him. I cannot imagine Dowd in today's world listening to an advocate of conspiracy, politics, or religion and him not grabbing a stone, and before taking the slingshot saying, "You foulmouthed idiot, take this." God likes that.

Keep in mind Goliath was not in Philistia shaking in his boots because the Yisra'elites had chased him halfway around the globe. He was ...

KIRK: In Yahowah's territory.

YADA: Absolutely. God is interested in those who stand up. He wants men to be men and women to be women and to celebrate the differences, both being all we can. He wants us to be far more than we can be on our own. His whole deal is to lift us up so we can be more like Him. When we bow down to Him, we are negating everything ...

The primary meaning of *yatab* in the preceding statement is not "to be good and do good," which is how it is translated because the religious want people to do good which they define as being obedient to them, but instead "being pleasant, pleasing, and happy." … Be pleasing to Whom? God. And since Yah has used *towb* time and again in this account to convey "good," it must be the attitudinal aspects of *yatab* that are important. God wants us happy, and the best way to be so is to heed His advice.

And therein lies the entire purpose of this discussion. Hebel followed Yah's lead and Qayn did not. If you want to be right, learn what God values, what He condemns, and take the same perspective and approach. One found himself accepted and favorably regarded and the other was ignored and rejected. Heaven is for those whom God values. He values those who value Him.

I think Qayn's issues are central to mankind's problems. We are all too often led by our emotions rather than by our minds. The whole conspiracy thing is (nuts)?

Today we have an extraordinarily liberal conspiracy that I think is going to wreak havoc in the world. It's called the Cancel Culture. The Cancel Culture has grown out of the hysteria of the conspiracy called Black Lives Matter. Black Lives Matter is a conspiracy because it's mostly led by people who have miserable lives and who want blame others for their failures when in fact the community is responsible for 93% of its own deaths. The Cancel Culture evolved from that and says that anything that they think that has even at a distant period of time could be somehow misconstrued to be offensive to their sensibility it must be cancelled. So, Dr. Seuss, personally ... I know some people learn to read by reading much more sophisticated things than this, but as for me, one fish, two fish, red fish, blue fish ... oh the things you can think when only you try, I really like Dr. Seuss. I thought he had a really clever way with words. If you are Cancel Culture, you have to cancel Dr. Seuss and take his books out of your library because some of the red fish blue fish will be racist. I like Green Eggs and Ham. That's pejorative to those \_\_\_\_\_.

The world in terms of slavery, slavery was pervasive around the world from the beginning of recorded history which would be about 4000 BCE. Slavery was pervasive before that we just didn't know it because there was no recorded history. Slavery was the economy of Rome, Greece, and Egypt, Babylon, Persia. It was the economy of the Roman Catholic Church, the feudal system of serfs and Lords. That's why Yahowah is so opposed to slavery.

I did a study on caste systems the other day because the caste system is a form of segregated slavery. The bottom of the caste system in every culture in civilization was the slave. Above the slave the indentured servant, above them the farmer, the lowest level of \_\_\_\_\_. And it went up, of course, to the king's family and then either the priests or the military officials depending on which country you were in. Then, you worked on down chain. I looked at Assyria, Babylon, Sumer, Greece, Rome, Egypt, Carthage, the Aztecs, Incas, the Chinese and the Japanese. I found in every one of those cultures the same caste system; different names but the same system with the Roman caste system being the most complex. The Romans had six different variations of the equestrian caste which is basically a soldier class whether or not you had armors and weapons and how many you had at your disposal. It was third or fourth down on the pecking order but way up from the slave. In every culture the same thing; a segregation of people.

In the feudal system that was conceived by the Roman Catholic Church that was imposed upon the Europeans there was no upward mobility. If you were a serf, you had no rights. You worked for the pleasure of the King, and yet with the slave trade into the Americas being controlled by the crowned heads of Europe. The only people that fought against it were the pirates. Piracy was filled with freed slaves. They fought against it and people who were working for kings who were universally disgusting. And yet this Cancel Culture would condemn Americans saying if you are Caucasian, you are just wrong, and are responsible for racism and slavery; it's just part of your nature. No it's not. And America has to wallow in shame when American was about as responsible for slavery on the grand scheme of things nothing compared to Europe or South America. The institutions are wrong, absolutely. But it was the way of man which is why God despises the way of man. You have the Cancel Culture which is to literally eliminate from society anything that they think is opposed to their agenda. The first is that they would teach children in school that if you are Caucasian, you are automatically a racist, you are guilty, you should be ashamed, you should have to apologize and give up all that you have because you're disgusting.

The Cancel Culture does have a point on Caucasian countries being so bad. Do you know there are 40 southern African countries? And can you tell me which one of these African countries is thriving, free or that is safe ... incentive ... place to live? If the problem is that the Caucasians came out and harmed the Africans, why are the African cultures so disgusting? Really, they are. In all fairness it is far more difficult in some environmental areas to thrive. The disease of Malaria and the like is a real problem. I think that skin color is a meaningless concept, but culture is not. Culture is the problem, and the culture in the African Countries is horrible. In the Republic of South Africa, while apartheid was wrong, what we have now is worse. Elderly Caucasian men and women are burned alive for no other reason than revenge. Zimbabwe has gone from the flower of Africa to a country where death is celebrated.

Qayn's issues are central to mankind's problems. That is to say we should be more interested in thinking our way to intelligent conclusions and being rational than we should be lashing out emotionally as Qayn did. As such, political and religious men coveting sex, power, and money have mercilessly and without constraint robbed and raped the masses without interruption for six thousand years. Qayn's problem is mankind's problem. Unwilling to listen to God, man's animal nature roars to the forefront, killing all that is good.

As had been the case with his mother before him, Qayn did not listen. Carried away by cravings and rage, he murdered his brother, Hebel – which his mother named him Waste of Breath. Then when Yahowah asked the killer what happened, he answered yet another question with a question. In this way he reminds us of another who should be questioned, *Sha'uwl* / Question Him / Paul – the founder of the religion most menacing of Jews.

"Then (*wa*) Qayn (Qayn – Conceived to be Possessed, created and acquired, commonly known as Cain) responded (*'amar* – threatened in a boastful manner), confronting (*'el* – directed himself toward) Hebel (*Hebel* – A Waste of Breath, one who lacks value, who is meaningless and futile, useless vapor, commonly called Able), his brother (*'ah huw'*).

And (wa – additionally) when it came to be that they were in (hayah ba hayah hem ba) the field (ha sadeh – the cultivated area for growing things (i.e., on Qayn's home 234turf)), Qayn (wa Qayn – then the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain) rose up and established himself (quwm – stood up and exalted himself, rising up (qal imperfect)) against ('el – toward, in the direction of, and confronting) his brother ('ah huw'), Hebel (Hebel – A Waste of Breath, one who lacks value, who is meaningless and futile, useless vapor, commonly called Able), and (wa) he murdered him (harag huw' – slayed him, taking his life, violently and viciously killing him)." (Bare 'syth / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:8)

Whatever the reason, Qayn struck his brother with deadly intent preferring fists to rhetoric. I find that this is the preferred approach of those who do not think and who do not know what to say. Those who resort to violence do so because they are incapable of responding appropriately. It is the cause of sexual abuse, violent crime, murdering wars.

Have you watched any or listened to any of the testimony thus far that the prosecution has brought against Officer Chauvin, the police officer who killed George Floyd? I am so enormously conflicted in this trial because for the past twenty years I have been screaming at the top of my lungs against police brutality; they are way too aggressive and out of control. They are too empowered to eliminate other people's freedoms and are way too prone to lie, plant evidence, to ignore when they should be helping, and intervening where they don't belong. Way too ... Way too heavily armed, way too many of them, way too many different agencies, and they are too protected within the judicial system. So, I have been opposed to American's army of national soldiers for a long time from the FBI on down.

What happened to George Floyd is testament to police overreacting. For that part, throw the book at these officers. But another says that we ought not think that we can be stupid and expect to be treated as if we were not. George Floyd was a convicted felon not only for drug abuse charges but most notably for pistol whipping a pregnant woman in her home. This was a very bad man. He had a drug problem all his life from cocaine to fentanyl which is probably what killed him. He was also on methamphetamine which caused him to be unusually aggressive. The store clerk said he was barely coherent. He also knew he was infected with the corona virus and, of course, wasn't wearing a mask. He was driving under the influence of those drugs, putting other people at risk. He tried to pass a counterfeit bill, he stole cigarettes. When the cops tried putting him into the police vehicle and he resisted arrest, this was the technique they used to take him down.

Up to that point, Floyd brought everything upon himself and it's likely the technique that Chauvin used wouldn't have killed a man whose body hadn't been subjected to years of drug abuse as well as being infected with the corona virus. Nonetheless Floyd pleaded for his life; he said he couldn't breathe. He said he was going to die, and yet this cop did nothing. He kept his knee on Floyd's throat. I'd like to see Chauvin made an example of and suffer the consequences for what he did. At the same time I don't like it when somebody who is so corrupt is turned into a hero. Either the State of Minnesota or the City of Minneapolis gave the family of this nincompoop 12 million dollars. That man's life wasn't worth twenty-five cents. When you're a drug addict, you have decided that your life isn't worth anything; it's not me being pejorative. He made that decision. If you're willing to pass counterfeit bills for nicotine and cigarettes, you're saying your life isn't worth anything. For them to award him 12 million dollars prior to the jury trial is astounding.

"So therefore (*wa*), Yahowah (*Yahowah* – God's name transliterated as guided by His *towrah* – instructions on His *hayah* – existence and His role in our *shalowm* – reconciliation as '*elowah* – Almighty God) said ('*amar*) to ('*el*) Qayn (*wa Qayn* – then the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain), 'Where is ('*ey* – as an interrogative questioning the purpose and location of) your brother ('*ah* '*atah*), Hebel (*Hebel* – named A Waste of Breath, one who supposedly lacks value, who is meaningless and futile, useless vapor, commonly called Able)?'

**He answered** (*wa 'amar huw'*), **'I do not know** (*lo' yada'* – I am unfamiliar and unaware, I am ignorant and do not understand). **Am I** (*h 'anoky*) **my brother's** (*'ah 'any*) **observer** (*shamar* – responsible for closely examining and carefully considering him, watchman, guardian, and protector)?"" (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:9)

I understand everyone is used to hearing "Am I my brother's keeper" but *shamar* doesn't mean "keep." "Responsible for closely examining and carefully considering him, watchman, guardian, and protector."

This is the second time that Yahowah has asked about someone's whereabouts, first with 'Adam and now to Qayn about Hebel. An omnipresent and omniscient God would have known and thus not asked. While Yahowah could have easily located both men, one alive the other dead, the purpose of the question was to demonstrate what should be obvious. Yahowah is set apart; He's special, thus He cannot be omnipresent without being everywhere, making Him common rather than unique. We can't be set apart from Yahowah if He's omnipresent. He would become the creation rather than remain the Creator. And He would suffocate those He wanted to love. Moreover, an all-knowing Deity would make a mockery of freewill and ruin any hope of the ensuing relationship being interesting.

The religious are not very bright because they somehow over thousands of years haven't been able to think these very simple concepts through.

**"He said** (*wa 'amar*), **'What** (*mah*) **have you done** (*'asah* – did you bring about through your actions)? **The Voice** (*qowl*) **of your brother's** (*'ah 'atah*) **blood** (*dam*) **is crying out** (*tsa'aq* – is providing a summons) **to Me** (*'el 'any*) **from the ground** (*min ha 'adamah*). (*Bare'syth* 4:10)

**So** (*wa*) **now** (*'atah* – at this time and henceforth, this being so) **you are cursed** (*'arar 'atah* – you will be 236annoyed and tormented) **by the ground** (*min ha 'adamah* – from the soil and out of the earth) **which** (*'asher* – as a result of this relationship) **has opened its mouth** (*patsah peh hy'* – has created a fissure in the earth and gaping orifice) **to receive** (*la laqach* – to accept and obtain) **your brother's** (*'ah 'atah*) **blood** (*dam*) **from your hand** (*min yad 'atah* – away from your influence). (*Bare'syth* 4:11)

Therefore, indeed (*ky*), when you work ('*abad* – you toil, laboring) in association with the earth ('*eth* ha '*adamah* – against the ground), it shall no longer (*lo*' yasaph – it will not continue to) produce (*nathan* – bestow) a healthy crop (*koach* hy' – its vitality, vigorously yielding its resources) for you (*la* '*atah*).

**You will consistently be** (*hayah*) **a shaken and staggering nomad** (*nuwa'* – trembling and wavering, riddled with insecurity). **And** (*wa*) **you will** (*hayah*) **wander away aimlessly like a fugitive** (*nuwd* – constantly traveling without a home or destination, an unhappy, emotionally distraught vagabond) **throughout the region** (*ba ha 'erets* – in the land)."" (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:12)

Accountability is an essential aspect of morality, of justice and fairness. That's the thing I keep harping on. Something like Black Lives Matter. Accountability matters. The culture of the community is creating young men that are 800% more violent than any other community, and therefore 13% of the population is responsible for 93% of black deaths. There's something in the culture that is causing this, and you need to be accountable. Stop blaming someone else. Accountability is essential. God is accountable; we ought to be accountable.

That said, the key to understanding this statement is that for mortal man separation from God is the penalty for sin – not death. He judged Qayn. What was the penalty? He separated him such that he would wonder around like a nomad. <u>Separation from God is the penalty for sin.</u> That is really, really important folks because <u>Pesach, which makes us immortal, all that does is resolve</u> the consequence of our rebellions. Our penalty for being rebellious is to spend eternity separated from God in She'owl, and that is what Matsah resolves. That's why Christians are so lost in their celebration of Easter.

"Qayn (wa Qayn – then the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain) said to ('amar 'el – expressed to) Yahowah ( $\epsilon\phi\epsilon\iota$  – the pronunciation of YaHoWaH as guided by His towrah – teaching regarding His hayah – existence), 'The consequence of my sin ('awon 'any – the punishment for my wrongdoing and the guilt) is greater than (gadowl min – more substantial and severe than) I can bear (nasa' – I can carry, tolerate, and endure). (Bare'syth 4:13)

Surely today (hen ha yowm) You have driven me away and banished me (garash 'eth 'any – You have removed and expelled me, estranging me) from upon (min 'al) the presence (paneh – the face) of the ground (ha 'adamah – earth).

And from Your presence (*wa min paneh 'atah*) I will be concealed and vanish (*sathar* – I will be hidden and perish).

**I will become** (*hayah*) **a shaken and staggering nomad** (*nuwa'* – a trembling and wavering migrant, riddled with insecurity). **And** (*wa*) **I will** (*hayah*) **wander aimlessly like a fugitive** (*nuwd* – constantly travel without a home or a destination as an unhappy and emotionally distraught vagabond) **throughout the region** (*ba ha 'erets* – in the land).

**Then it shall come to pass** (*wa hayah*) **that whoever** (*kol*) **discovers me** (*matsa' 'any* – learns about, becomes aware of, and finds out about me) **will seek to kill me** (*harag 'any* – will try to slay me, ending my life)."" (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:14)

Oh good god, stop whining. You just killed your brother! Why are you complaining that somebody might want to kill you after you just killed your brother? If you didn't want to be killed, why did you kill him?

It's like the Muslims. They go off griping that they need to kill Jews because they say there was some Jew back in the past that killed a Muslim. Your religion was literally started by killing Jews; killing the men, raping the women, and enslaving the children. Why are you complaining because someone might have reciprocated after a time?

Qayn murders his brother and is now whining that somebody may do the same to him?

KIRK: I don't understand why it never occurred to Qayn to say, "You're right; how can I make this right? Is there a possibility I can make it right?"

YADA: No. Alright, listen. When Chawah and 'Adam screwed up and chomped down on the fruit from the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Bad, had they at that point said, "Wait a minute. Before you judge us, I remember now Your instruction was that if we made a habit of eating from this tree that we would come to resemble death. I set it down; she set it down, in fact we just tossed it away. We're not going to do that again," God would be duty bound to say, "Okay. That's what I said. We had a deal. Let me explain to you again what is good and not good for you, and we will go on." This is a different story. You don't undo killing your brother. This is 'Adam's kid. He not only murdered him it was premeditated murder out of envy. So, God ... up. You've got a crappy attitude, nobody wants to be around you so shape up. And the first thing he goes off and does, rather than try to endear himself to his brother and get his attitude right, he goes off and murders him? No. There's no "I'm sorry, God. The rock slipped. I won't do it again." ...

KIRK: \_\_\_\_\_ is probably the most horrible word I've ever translated. It's the fence or at least the briar patch letter that separates you from the upright pole which stands for the message and then the observant man. It's just three letters. If He says that in a sentence to you, you're really doomed. And you have no hope at all.

YADA: Any Hebrew word that contains a "g" ... it's the last letter in *harag*. We'll speak to ... The fact of the matter is that the "g" in Hebrew is a bad letter. That is the letter of gowym and Gomorrah. There's not a lot of good things that came out of that.

And while those of concern to Qayn may have been without a *neshamah*, they appear to have had a tit-for-tat moral code, with violence breeding retaliation – one in which cold-blooded murderers were punished. This statement, therefore, is one of many which seem to confirm what we have

come to know through anthropology and archeology is that homo sapiens existed outside the Garden in large numbers and had at least a basis of right and wrong. They communicated with one another the first writing systems were beginning to \_\_\_\_\_. Man has been around for a long time. So if you are among the numskulls that think 'Adam and Chawah were the first man and woman and are therefore the forefathers of all of us *Homo sapiens*, then this makes no sense. Who was it that Qayn feared would kill him? So yes, they existed outside the Garden.

In August 2007, there was a challenge to the evolutionary tree depicting man evolving from chimp to *Homo habilis*, to *Homo erectus*, and then to *Homo sapiens* over the course of a million years which turned out to be untrue. *Homo habilis* and *Homo erectus*, both of which are far more ape than man, lived at the same time. How can we have evolution if they lived at the same time?

KIRK: I did a little research and the Grotto in France, the \_\_\_\_ with all the paintings on it, the carbon dating on it is 15,000 - 17,000 years ago, so that's predating all that. They weren't there; the flood didn't touch them. The cave painters drew symbolic art, so they must have communicated with these symbols as well and had to be able to think so they could understand what was depicted on the walls. They carbon dated similar things in the Iberian Peninsula to 60,000 years ago.

YADA: \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ tool because those images are either chiseled into stone or they are chalked with tar or residue in stone, so ... The Garden of Eden existed 6,000 years ago and expulsion from it started the march of time to our return to it. In that period there were *Homo sapiens* everywhere. It's not only a situation where we found out that *Homo habilis* and *Homo erectus* existed at the same time but so did *Homo sapiens* and ... *Cro Magnon. Neanderthal* and *Homo sapiens* existed at the same time. But we're not evolving one from the other. We also found out that this notion that all humans evolved from Africa and that we evolved from the ape is not true.

It's like with all the conspiracy people that write me when what they claim turns out not to be true. One of the advantages of Israel with all these tests, we know exactly what the vaccine does. We know how many people have headaches and fever after it, how many people are infected with corona after it and how serious those infections are, how many people are hospitalized after having received two vaccines, and how many have died. We know it's effect on everything from pregnant women to blood clots. The information is unbelievably prolific and available to read. It is sad when people promote myths, and when evidence proves them wrong, they just dig in. It's the same thing here with the scientific community on evolution. The evidence has proven them wrong, yet they dig in.

"Then (*wa*) Yahowah (*Yahowah* – a transliteration of  $\varepsilon \varphi \varepsilon \iota$ , our '*elowah* – God as directed in His towrah – teaching regarding His hayah – existence) said to him ('*amar* '*el* huw'), 'Assuredly (*la-ken* – know that for such a case), anyone (*kol*) who slays (harag – who murders) Qayn (*Qayn* – the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain) shall experience sevenfold (*shib* '*athaym*) retribution (*naqam* – punishment based upon their guilt).

**So** (*wa*) **Yahowah** ( $\varepsilon \varphi \varepsilon \iota$  – the pronunciation of *YaHoWaH* as guided by His *towrah* – teaching regarding His *hayah* – existence) **placed** (*sym* – put and set) **a sign** (*'owth* – a non-verbal symbol

or mark) **upon Qayn** (*la Qayn* – upon the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain), **lest** (*la bilty*) **someone** (*kol*) **who discovered him** (*masa' huw'* – found out about him, uncovering the truth regarding him and caught him), **strike at him** (*nakah 'eth huw'* – attack, smite, hit, beat, and / or kill him)." (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:15

There's a lot here. First, it again shows that God isn't going to zap the murderer dead on the spot where the religious would blame God for everything that happens in someone's life. The second thing is that when it comes to life and death decisions that's God's responsibility, not mans. If another man chooses to take your life, I'm going to hold them accountable, but that's not their job. The other is that by putting a sign on Qayn all those other *Homo sapiens* out there have to be sophisticated and intelligent enough to know what a sign is. They had to know. Part of the beauty of this is if you look at Paleo Hebrew, the oldest form of the alphabet, you could read that alphabet without being naturally literate. Each of the characters depict something. A ram is the protective leader of the flock, a beyth is a family home, the hey is an upright man, a rosh is the head of an individual who is looking ahead hearing, listening, thinking. The quph is the horizon; the dawn of a new day. The lamed is a shepherd's staff for protection, rescue, walking and leadership. Dalet, the doorway. Chet, the fence. Shin, teeth, nourishing word. Every one of these letters conveyed something. So God came up with a sign that they would understand.

We find additional proof that there were humans around who could read, or at the very least had the capacity to interpret a sign. Therefore, while this conversation occurred outside of 'Eden, and just shy of six thousand years ago, humans have existed far longer. One of Christendom's greatest myths is that 'Adam was the only man in existence during his stay in 'Eden and yet that belief is being pulverized by God's Word.

**"Then** (*wa*) **Qayn** (*Qayn* – the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain) **went away from** (*yatsa' min* – departed and descended from) **the presence** (*paneh*) **of Yahowah** (*Yahowah* – written as directed by His *towrah* – teaching regarding His *hayah* – existence) **and he settled** (*wa yashab* – came to dwell and live) **in the land** (*ba 'erets* – in the region and territory) **of Nowd** (*Nowd* – to waver and be shaken, to lament wandering away, to complain and have a grievance, and to bemoan one's plight), **east** (*qidmah* – *existing prior to*) **of 'Eden** (*'Eden* – Happiness and Joy, Favorable Circumstances and Delightful Conditions." (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:16)

It's interesting he went east of 'Eden. Where did the Flood occur? East of 'Eden.

KIRK: Up north by Lake Van.

YADA: Lake Van is where 'Eden was and to go east of Lake Van you have to go ... so everything that came up when the asteroid struck went right up through the Tigris-Euphrates valleys leaving the sediment and silt from the tsunami right up into the Black Sea which is where the greatest indentation took place with a 500-foot rise of water turning it from fresh to salt water \_\_\_\_\_ those civilizations that rushed out through the \_\_\_\_\_ Straits. He went east of 'Eden.

...and he settled (*wa yashab* – came to dwell and live) in the land (*ba 'erets* – in the region and territory) of Nowd (*Nowd* – to waver and be shaken, to lament wandering away, to complain and have a grievance, and to bemoan one's plight), east (*qidmah* – *existing prior to*) of 'Eden ('Eden – Happiness and Joy, Favorable Circumstances and Delightful Conditions." (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:16)

Clearly if it was the land of Nowd the Nowdians must have lived there, don't you think? Places were named after people, or at least types of people. The land of Nowd was a place of people.

After being banished, *Qayn* | Cain found a woman among the nomads of Nowd, and he chose to marry her. Though it does not say so implicitly, it is implied that the men and women living outside the garden did not possess a *neshamah* | conscience. But the offspring of a parent like Qayn with a *neshamah*, although his was not working very well, could be so equipped. It is the only rational conclusion which can be made from the Towrah's upcoming justification for the flood and archeological evidence – whereby written history dates to this time and place.

While you can look at cave drawings from 15,000 years ago, you're not going to find the remnants of civilizations like you find 500 feet beneath current surface of the Black Sea. In fact we find going down the Tigris-Euphrates rivers Assyria, Babylon and Sumer. This was the birthplace of civilization.

A professor was giving a presentation on the rise of civilization and how it manifested itself in various places. He said, "There's this great myth among the scholarly that civilization is the best of man, that we progress and become great through civilization. I think we are doing hunter gatherers a great deal of discredit because ... that the hunter gatherers were better people than were the civilized." It's apparent that the children inherit a neshamah from their parents because Qayn would not have been judged by Yahowah if he were incapable of knowing right from wrong. So, he had a neshamah; he just didn't use it very well.

This point is driven home in the introduction of the fifth chapter of Bare'syth/Genesis, which we'll get into next week. Also, in the conclusion to the flood, Yahowah declares that He achieved His purpose, that of ridding the region of corrupt souls with a *neshamah*. So, if you rid the region of souls with a neshamah, then the only reason they would have a neshamah in this region is because Qayn and the other descendants of 'Adam and Chawah infiltrated this region. This is the place we will learn that the sons of God, which would be the descendants of 'Adam who were considered God's sons, married the women that they felt were beneficial to them. They conceived children with a neshamah, and they became *nephal* – very warlike, political, militant, and vicious.

If you look at some of the museums going through time, you will find that civilizations rose over other civilizations because they developed better weapons. In the ... became weapons and the will to use them. So, the development of weapons required to some degree the use of a neshamah, just ...

Collectively, these insights strongly suggest that both the *neshamah* / conscience / seat of judgment and the *nepesh* / consciousness / soul are passed on as part of human conception. The child of a parent with one, gets one.

Sometimes you wonder, are there humans alive today without a *neshamah* and if so what is the fate of such souls? It is possible, but we are not told. That said, if it were true it would certainly explain some of the thoughtless and horrid behavior we have seen throughout human history and what we're witnessing today. It would also resolve the disconnect we see in today's news where information is plentiful and accessible and yet people have never been as foolish, immoral, or hypocritical. It's not just stupid, but ... it's also immoral not doing the right thing, treating other people ... and totally hypocritical, blaming others for their own faults. Foolish, immoral, hypocritical, ignorant and irrational. And yet, information is ubiquitous.

Look at this contrast between the intellect that was required to create a messenger RNA vaccine and the stupidity of saying it's the mark of the beast or that your government is giving it to in order to control and manipulate you. Just think of the dichotomy between those two positions. You have enough information available to create a messenger RNA vaccine and yet far more people are so stupid because they think the government is trying to manipulate them. The conspiratorial types hate Bill Gates and are convinced that he is spending his fortune trying to kill people or manipulate them. It's such circular reasoning; they are all just hyping themselves up.

I've long said that *yada*' is a relational sense of knowing. It means "to know in a relational sense." Just like 'Adam came to know Chawah, and they conceived. Well here it is.

"Qayn (*Qayn* – the one conceived to be possessed, who was created and then acquired, commonly known as Cain) became acquainted with (*yada* ' – came to know, becoming more aware of) his wife (*'ishah huw*'– his woman) and she conceived (*wa harah* – became pregnant) and gave birth to (*yalad* '*eth*) Chanowk (*Chanowk* – to inaugurate and dedicate, to train, and to be merciful (transliterated Enoch)).

I don't know how you get Enoch from Chanowk. They only have one letter in common, the nun. The "ch" is replaced with and "E." The nun is there. The "o" is there but it's not based on the wah as is ... and when it ends with a "ch," the "k". What is it that you just can't transliterate it the way it's written and then try to understand what the name means? I don't get it.

Then it came to pass (wa hayah) that he built (banah – he constructed) a town ('iyr – a village or city).

How did he build a town based upon one kid unless there were a lot more people out there?

He called (*wa qara'*) the name (*shem*) of town (*'iyr* – village and / or city) after (*ka* – like) the name (*shem*) of his son (*ben huw'*), Chanowk (*Chanowk* – to inaugurate and dedicate a new beginning, to train and be equipped to be merciful (transliterated Enoch))." (*Bare'syth* / In the Beginning / Genesis 4:17)

"*Chanowk* | Enoch walked with God...365 years. Chanowk walked with God and he was not, for God took him." (*Bare'syth* / Genesis 5:22-24)

Boy, there's a whole lot of things that are claimed of Chanowk/Enoch. Christians would have him being the Second Witness because it says, "For every person.." ... he was just taken, so the other one that was just taken was 'Elyah, so those are the two Witnesses. 'Elyah's got game. God's

going to be really snarky at the end. 'Elyah is the posterchild for sarcasm. I can see why God would choose 'Elyah of all people to speak to His people. And before he got worn out God said, "I'll just take you out and bring you back later." The other one is not named but it's pretty obvious the other one's experience has got to be ... just like Moseh was chosen ... he understood all the garbage that was afflicted by Egypt, so God didn't have to explain it to him. He could go right to Pharoah and be disgusted by what Pharoah represented, so it was perfect. So, this other dude is going to understand social secular humanism, Islam, and Christianity, and that's going to be his target; he's going to be very snarky too. Chances are he's going to have a bit of an attitude and not like those things very much. But it's not Enoch. I'm certain Yahowah found Enoch charming, but he had no experience. God uses people with experience who are in the game...

At this point, Yahowah presents Qayn's lineage. From a prophetic perspective, the most important descendant is Tubal-Cain, the "forger of implements of bronze and iron." I say this because Gog, the leader of the Islamic Magog Federation, is predicted to attack Israel between 2027 to 2029 during the Time of Ya'aqob's Troubles. He is a religious, political, and/or military leader from Meshech and Tubal. Meshech can easily be traced to this region of eastern Turkey but without this tip, Tubal would have been more difficult to locate.

Also, Noah's Ark was found in Eastern Turkey, east of 'Eden, on the mountains *of* Ararat (at an elevation of 6,300 feet MSL) which is a much taller and newer volcanic mountain. Even the rivets for the glue lens that were used to construct the ark were made of iron, magnesium, sodium, and titanium, which makes the forged implement of metal particularly interesting. It's important to know where all of this was taking place. Even softer metals were found in the ballast of the ship and a lot of it is consistent with the residue of metal production.

Since I mentioned 'Elyah here and we just finished Passover, and I know I mentioned it last week, it's so fascinating when we find an affirmation. Revelation we have to be very suspect of because much of it is based upon Dany'el, Yirma'yah, Yasha'yah, Zakaryah, Mal'aky, and Ezekiel. So much of it is citations from those books and we can go back and validate all of that. Some of the text is just an extrapolation from bringing those prophecies together. That's how you understand. You look at all the places where something is referenced in the same period of time, and you can make reasonable connections. There's a lot of that in Revelation, and one of them talks about the two witnesses. They are also mentioned in Zakaryah. 'Elyah is clearly one of them. It talks about the attitude and appearance of these witnesses. One of the things that's interesting in Revelation is that it tells us there will be 1,260 days, there will be fire bands with this message of Yahowah, and finally they will be killed and there will be three and one-half days before they rise up to heaven. The natural timing of all this would be that their ascension would occur on Yowm Kippurym, the Day of Reconciliation when Dowd comes back because they are literally going to be troubadours for Dowd. They're going to be saying, "Dowd is coming back. You really should get your act together. A voice calls out in the wilderness, if you will, and come to embrace what Dowd has to say and what he is offering on behalf of God. Otherwise you're going to be his enemy and you don't want to be that man's enemy. He's really good at what he does." What's so interesting about this is that if you subtract in the year 2033 / 6000 Yah 1,264 days from the celebration of Yowm Kippurym which is on October 2, 2033, in that year and in that year only,

2033 which is 6000 Yah, and you go back 1,264 days you have him arriving in the afternoon. That's Passover. So, he's arriving in the afternoon right before sunset on Passover in 2027. What's so cool about that is the rabbis have everything wrong about Passover. They have everything on the Passover plate except lamb. Interestingly, when you study the Passover plate what you have is Qayn's offering and not Hebel's. It has every kind of fruit and vegetable imaginable, and no lamb. So, the Passover plate of Rabbinic Judaism is Qayn's offering as opposed to Hebel's. I don't know how that's supposed to endear any loyalty to God but at the Passover Seder the rabbis always set a place for 'Elyah, of all people, and ... in 2027 it's 'Elyah that's coming back for Passover. Hopefully just the snarkiness of that will awaken some Yahuwdym, some Yisra'elites and cause them to question 'Elyah for Passover? Something's going on here. I need to pay attention.

We'll pick this up next week. We've gone way beyond our normal broadcast time.

I became quite frustrated with what I was reading after we had gone out of our way and then I am reading how disappointed that this person is in me for selling out to the horrible nature of big pharma and Bill Gates' plot on the world and I go oh god ...

Yahowah is there to protect us while we're engaged in doing His work. He's not there to protect us from being stupid. If I say, "God's there to protect me so I'm going to take the nail gun that my carpenters use and shoot it between my eyes and put ... NO! I'm going to jump off a twostory balcony and just prove that a malak will catch me. NO! You're free to test God, but test Him in the right way by challenging His words. Translate the words that you think are the most unbecoming and least appropriate. Find something you don't agree with, translate it, and see if you have a bone to pick with Him. Challenge Him that way. Don't jump out of the airplane and say you don't need a parachute because God has promised to protect you. He didn't promise to protect you from your own stupidity. He wants to work with you ... because you're not stupid.

I just got passed a note that says, "If 'Eden is equated to Yaruwshalaim and east of 'Eden equals Iraq, Iran, Arak, and then Irad which is Arabicized "fugitive, wild ass, (heap)? of an empire ultimately becoming Babylon and the confusion that is derived by intermixing which is the basis of Rabbinic Judaism." It's just an amalgamation of all sorts of lies, some Greek, some Roman. The other day I watched an intellectual program that demonstrated how much of the Babylonian was amalgamated into the Talmud. It's just frightening. There are so many parts of the Talmud that are Hammurabi laws and Babylonian edicts. Even Rosh Hashanah replacing Taruw'ah. Here you are in the seventh month celebrating the Babylonian new year. Come on folks.

I was writing a chapter and was talking about how Christians have replaced Pesach, Matsah, Bikuwrym, Shabuw'ah, Taruw'ah, Yowm Kippurym, and Sukah with their religious holidays. Christmas replaces Sukah, Good Friday replaces Passover, Easter Sunday replaces Bikuwrym, the birth of their church at Pentecost replaces Shabuw'ah. And, of course, they have a few others they throw in just to irritate God like All Hallows Eve, the Assumption of Mary, etc.

I also looked at Judaism. They celebrate Passover by replicating Qayn's offering. A really swift maneuver, dudes. They celebrate Matsah historically as it was a day of freedom, but they don't know what it was freedom from. Matsah is about taking the fungus of the religion and politics of

Mitsraym, the crucible of human oppression, out of us so that we can be cleansed and adopted into God's family. They don't have a clue. They don't even bother to celebrate Bikuwrym; they celebrate Purim instead. They have no interest whatsoever in Shabuw'ah anymore. They changed Taruw'ah to the Babylonian Rosh Hashanah. Then on the day that was established especially for them, Yowm Kippurym is all about God reconciling His relationship with Yisra'el and Yahuwdah, they turn Reconciliation into a day of afflicting and debasing one's soul. And then they add a festival day called Hanukkah. God doesn't mention Hanukkah and dealing with the Maccabaean period where you have two factions vying for power and the ones who prevailed were the ones who adopted Greek influences. Their big miracle is the oil lamps that they thought would burn for four or five days that burned for nine days. Oh boy, isn't that a miracle. What about defeating the Egyptians and freeing you from religious and political oppression?

So, we'll be back with you next week. Having endured, which was my fault because I brought him into this show as a co-host until he became so absurdly conspiratorial that it gagged me, and then I heard how abusive he was to people. But once I learned from Yahowah just how opposed He is to conspiracies. He says don't promote or listen to them. You can condemn them if you want but just do not engage in them. I learned that they are the great credibility cesspool of humanity and that today it's the fastest growing and most debilitating of all religions, and just like in every other religion evidence and reason mean nothing to these dunderheads. The more that you prove that they are nincompoops, the more aggressive they become. I would say to them the same thing that Yahowah said to Pharoah. Let my people go. You go away and be as miserable as you want, but do so on your own.
