0:00 Good evening and welcome to Yada Yah Radio. Happy Shabat to one and all. I'm here with Kirk and Dee. It's been a hellacious week. I always wondered why Yahowah stopped prophesy for exactly 1,000 years. 'Abraham is called a prophet only because his dialogue with Yahowah regarding the Covenant literally permeated all of history from that point going forward, but his words are only retained through the prophet Moseh | the Great Liberator. From 1447 BCE to 447 BCE, exactly 1,000 years, was the full range of Yahowah's prophets. There have been no more. I've pondered over the years why God stopped there and why there were not others. One thing that strikes me is that it wasn't long after that time that Israel broke into warring factions between the political and religious interests in Israel, and across the Maccabean Wars, against the Greek occupation and there were no winners in that. It's likely that of anybody that could have read Hebrew and would have had access to the Towrah, I would say the chances were one in a billion that any one of those individuals would have been receptive to Yahowah. He doesn't force himself through people, He doesn't use them as robots, there would have been no available prophet. If you look at Dowd arriving to fulfill Pesach, Matsah, Bikuwrym, and Shabuw'ah in year 4000 Yah, 33 CE, there is not a single record in a Jewish hand acknowledging that Dowd arrived to do these things, not one. The only eyewitness accounts are what Dowd wrote coupled with what Yasha'yah prophesied.

2:22 You've got prophecies in Yasha'yah and quite a few other prophets like Mal'aky and Zakaryah and others pertaining to what he did, but most of the eyewitness accounts are in Dowd's own hand. That's certainly fine. We don't miss anything more but not having anyone chronicle it tells you that there wasn't a single Yahuwdym whom Yahowah could reveal prophecy through. The level of commitment and responsibility of being Yah's Prophet is really extraordinary and there wasn't anybody beyond ordinary, so it's easy to see why there weren't any. And then during the time of the Romans there were warring factions among Jews with Jews fighting the most beastly regime on Earth and they were sent into Diaspora. Clearly, there's no attachment to the Land, that God has given up on His people for a very long time, has returned to Shamaym, and is going to let history play out which is what has transpired all the while He had this plan that beginning on Taruw'ah 32 years before His return He would reach out and reconnect with His people although not with a prophet.

3:51 Now the reason I say this, speaking of the history of the prophets and God speaking, is that I started off rough. My first translations of Howsha' were crude and I made many mistakes in terms of speaking of a renewed Covenant when the Covenant won't be renewed for another ten years and trying to incorporate some New Testament statements into the presentation when the New Testament is a piece of trash. I did not recognize until a couple years ago that Dowd not only was the Messiah, but that he is the Messiah, not only was he the Son of God but that he is the Son of God, he is our Savior. So, some things have come slowly.

4:49 I'm rewriting *Prophet of Doom* as *God Damn Religion* and will finish Volume Three this coming week. One of the reasons I'm rewriting it is that I made a lot of mistakes in the first version. There were

minor mistakes as it relates to Islam, but the biggest mistakes were related to Twistianity and this notion that there was a Yahowsha' and that Yahowah somehow used him to fulfill Pesach, Matsah, and Bikuwrym; I didn't know. So, it's vital that we rewrite it. That's the reason if you look at the yadayah.com homepage there is no longer a link to *Prophet of Doom* because as soon as I'm finished with Volume *Three of God Damn Religion*, I'm going to ask our good friend Jeff to replace the book *Prophet of Doom* with the rewrite *God Damn Religion* so that *Prophet of Doom* will be no more. *Prophet of Doom* was a decent tool, I guess as an introduction. After I made those mistakes, and it certainly isn't a knock on a witness to make a mistake, if I were a prophet, it would be deadly, but I'm not. I'm a witness, a Herald, a Choter, and it's a very different level of responsibility. I know I have communicated more to benefit the Children of Yisra'el than any one prophet over the course of the last 22 years; it has been by relying upon the prophets that I was able to do this.

6:59 The driving point in all this is that I finally figured out why there are no more prophets. It's not just because there was not a single Yisra'elite that was willing and able to do the job; they weren't needed anymore. Over the past 10 to 15 years, I have routinely attempted to use what I have learned to predict what was going to happen and I've never been wrong. I've made hundreds, maybe thousands, of predictions about the way things were going to play out.

7:36 One of the predictions that I made was that the United States was going to be a Trojan horse, that all this with Israel, was like the Greeks offering the gift of the Trojan horse to Troy. I was able to predict this because Yahowah's prophecy paints such a comprehensive picture of what is going to happen, and man has been so consistently bad over the years, that it's really easy to see how the pieces are going to fit together.

8:16 Something I've always been cautious in talking about is how the United States, of all nations, will be the great betrayer of Israel in the presentation in Yasha'yah 17 and 18, and yet that's exactly what Yah says. It's in some 30 different descriptive references that describe only one nation, the United States of America. God is really disgusted with what this nation has done and is doing. Yahowah doesn't speak of nations no matter how bad they are if they're not negatively or positively influencing His people. So, this means it had to be that the United States was the most egregious actor in the world relative to the security of Israel. ... hard to explain when the United States is the only country voting in favor of Israel at the United Nations and is supplying Israel with some manner of military support and where about 70% of the American people are in favor of Israel which is higher than probably most any other nation on Earth. So, how in the world does the United States fall to such a point that we are considered to be by One who a lot about such things, Yahowah, the most menacing country to Israel? And we're witnessing it.

10:05 I shared a month or so ago that the United States was scheming on the notion of either abstaining from the UN Security Council vote or actually proposing that a state of Fakeistine be declared, not negotiating with Israel but shoved down Israel's throat, in a direct reward of terrorism. It's far worse than what Neville Chamberlain did to start World War II because at the time Hitler had not acted on his threats but had written *Mein Kampf*. In this case they would reward a state to Muslims that have over and over lied, killed, and maimed Jews. That was a pretty strong hint. I don't think I've ever witnessed anything so blatant by any country. I'm in my 60s. I have never seen anything by any country as blatant as what the United States is doing now to Israel where the Biden Administration, both Biden himself, his pet Jew and fellow Progressive Schumer, and Vice President

too stupid to even be named, are all saying, "Oh yeah. We have Israel's back. Israel has the right to exist. Our beef is with the Israeli government. The real problem here isn't Hamas, it's Netanyahu. We think Israel needs to have elections now and replace Netanyahu; Netanyahu is the problem."

12:04 For years the United States through its CIA and the State Department overturned the governments of nations around the world. We assassinated leaders that didn't capitulate to what we wanted and if we didn't assassinate them then we gave guns and money to the opposing side. Why do you think we're in the mess in the Ukraine? It's exactly what America did in the Ukraine. And we've done it all around the world. We didn't like Saddam Hussein even though he was the most antifundamentalist Islamic terrorist dictator in the Islamic world and so what did we replace him with? We killed him and replaced him Shiite theocracy that is run out of Tehran. Nicely done. We didn't like Muammar Gaddafi, so we killed him. What did we get? A government by Islamic terrorists. This is what do. We didn't like the government of Vietnam, so we replaced him; we made certain that he was killed; it's what we do.

13:19 You need to know, America, that America is scheming to do the same thing in Israel but this time unlike any other time, because Jews are held to a different standard, the United States is vocally condemning the only democratically elected government in the entire region. What gives us the right to do so? Talk about belligerent! This isn't Lithuania, Monaco, or Switzerland. This is Israel. This is the one bastion of hope in a sea that is plagued with Islam. This is God's people and God's country and we're spitting in His face. Do you know what happens to nations that do this to Israel and Jews? They're destroyed.

14:26 For many years I was a Netanyahu fan because Netanyahu is one of the few leaders in the world who would actually stand up to the truth. Occasionally he would give a speech and say there's no such thing as the Fakeistanian, it's all a marketing myth. He gave that speech to the United Nations and to the U.S. Congress. Good for him. That was the right thing to do. He's never backed down from a fight with Islam when Islam was threatening the existence of Israel, and he is the only person now who is saying we're not going to capitulate.

15:16 Now to his shame, when asked to take responsibility he should have immediately said the greatest mistake I've made in my life led to this event. For one IDF Soldier, Shalit, I released over a thousand Muslim prisoners, many of them are the leaders now of Hamas. That mistake led to this day. So, I am responsible, and I will fall on my sword. It is my job now to make certain that Israel is not destroyed. But the day this war is over I will resign, and we will have the next round of elections. But I will see it through because this is going to be a tough battle. Now he didn't do that, unfortunately.

16:15 Gantz looks distinguishing. He's a tall, handsome guy, was Minister of Defense for Israel and ran the IDF, and so you'd say alright, there's a man. But he's a stuffed shirt and not intellectually bright nor particularly articulate, and he's got no cojones. When the United States started lambasting Israel, rather than licking his chops and saying, "Hey man. I'm first in line. They do in Netanyahu, and for the first time I'll have the job I've always craved. I'll be prime minister of Israel. That's the Gantz we've come to know. Instead of that, he should have said, I'm disgusted by the United States' Biden Administration. I know that 80% of Americans support what we're doing, but to have this Administration seek regime change in the only democratically elected government in the Middle East is revolting. It is absolutely appalling for them to make such an announcement, and I want to tell you I will not be any part of it. I will also tell you that when it comes to the defense of Israel, Netanyahu

and I may have our differences, but not on this; I stand shoulder-to-shoulder. I would make no decision that is any different than he has made, and I think I can speak for Gallant when I make that statement. Even the most liberal who doesn't have a chance of being elected, Lapid, would say the same thing. Every Israeli of any responsibility is going to do exactly as we have done. So, for the United States to say oh we're for Israel, we're just against the government is a pitiful lie, and I'm just disgusted by my country.

18:37 But now we know the answer. Now we know why Yahowah had Yasha'yah write a detailed exposé against the United States of America in the last days for what it does against Israel. This is where we are. That's the first thing I wanted to bring to your attention.

19:03 Brigadier General Dan Goldfus, dressed in Army Fatigues standing in front of a tank and a jeep while speaking into Channel 13 mics, gave an interesting speech. He told the politicians of Israel, "You better be worthy of us." As a soldier defending his soldiers for what they have endured, good for him. As a man who is in a democratic freely elected nation where the military reports to the government, shame on him. This is not what we do. If you're going to make remarks like that, make them meaningful; don't just talk about unity. His deal was before the war we were at each other's throats over the judicial system reform.

20:09 That problem is not going away if they don't pursue judicial reform. Israel doesn't have a constitution. The Supreme Court in Israel is more powerful than any elected official, and it's almost resolutely Progressive. They have no checks and balances; Israel can't survive that way. Israel either has to have a Bill of Rights or a Constitution, or it has to limit the power of their Supreme Court, and they have to come up with a way for elected officials to choose who participates on that panel. That's just a fact. And to say we can't be at each other's throats and that we must be unified, there's no more of that, then what's the answer? They say that the IDF heads are exceedingly Progressive; that may be true. Maybe that's why Israel got ransacked and surprised by the Muslims because even though Progressives still have decent IQs, they can't think. Perhaps this is the problem that Progressives can't think. It's just a statement of fact; they spew out unfounded opinions and that's all they've got. They're more religious than the most zealous of the fundamentalist religions, and almost everything they stand for is wrong. I wanted to bring him to your attention because it was an interesting statement that he made.

21:55 Qatar has an interesting relationship with the United States because our fleet is there. Our fleet is in Qatar because we built the base in Saudi Arabia, and after Saudi Arabia decided it didn't want us anymore, after spending five billion dollars, we had to move, and so we're in Qatar. On October 8, 2023, Qatar said, "This thing with Hamas is not working out very well for us, and we'd just as soon exile them." The United States said, "Nope. Not going to do that. Keep them right there because there we have access to them and can negotiate with them." So, if you want to know why Hamas, these mass murderers of Jews who are being bribed by hundreds of millions of dollars of American and United Nations money, is being protected in Qatar, it's because of the Biden Administration. This is

23:10 On the positive side of the news, a survey was taken this past week in Israel. Israelis now have almost no faith in their government; only 23% of Jews in Israel trust the government and only about 20% of religious Jews trust the rabbis. So that means that there's 20% of Jews that trust the government and there's 20% that trust the rabbis. I don't know if that's collectively 40% or if they're

double counting but that means somewhere between 60 and 80% of Jews are now at least potentially open to Yahowah and the message of *Yada Yahowah*. I say that because until a person, and this would include a Yisra'elite or Yahuwdym (there aren't two paths to God but one) does what 'Abraham and Moseh did which is to walk away from religion and politics they are not welcome in the Covenant. There's no way to approach God, no way to even know God, no way to engage in a relationship with God, and there's no means of Salvation. So, with 80% of Israelis no longer trusting their government, then at least with those who are not religious among that remaining 80% there's hope. This is exactly what had to happen for *Yada Yahowah* to resonate in Israel.

25:12 There is a weeping and gnashing of teeth around the world about poor starving Gazans, and I've said before, I really don't care. The Gazans were overwhelmingly supportive of Hamas. They are fundamentalist Muslims; they celebrated the rape and murder of Jews and they celebrated the abductees from Israel. The United Nations was part of the plot and actually participated there. Tens of thousands if not hundreds of thousands lined the streets celebrating the terrorists and shouting, "Death to Jews!" The women there are incubators for future terrorists, the children are vipers in waiting, and all the 15,000-plus jihadist Islamic terrorists that have been killed are no more civilians than the man of the moon. So, of the maybe 5 to 10,000 others in Gaza that have been killed I just have no sympathy; I am the opposite of the rest of the world. I do not care. You did this to yourselves, and you are the reason that Hamas is there. You're the reason that Hamas is still there. So, the world gnashes its teeth and blames Israel for the humanitarian crisis in Gaza and doesn't want to condemn Islam or Hamas but does want to condemn Israel. As I said last week, the fact of the matter is, there's 50% more food being given freely to the Gazan Muslims than before the war. Now you can't starve on 50% more food, so what's the difference? Islam and Muslims. Muhammad was a plundering, conniving, murderous terrorist and thief. That's just who he was and everything about Islam, once it moved into the Islamic era in Yathrib was about terrorism and thievery; there's nothing more to it. That's what's wrong.

27:41 The food trucks are robbed. The Muslims there are savages as they attack them. They are not attacking them because they're hungry they're attacking them because they're greedy. They are trying to steal the food so they can sell it. Stealing it to sell it. They don't care if people starve; the more they starve the better they look. It has nothing to do with hunger and all to do with the corrupt nature of Islam. That's not my opinion; that's just a fact and if you don't know the facts, then shame on you. So, Israel finally said, "Wait a minute. It had nothing to do with us; this is what Hamas is doing. If you think that people are hungry, and there are some that are hungry, it's because Hamas is stealing the food, jacking up the prices, and not allowing the people to eat." Nothing more to it than that. And, of course, the nations surrounding Israel that could have easily provided safe sanctuary for the Gazans and Muslims chose not to. They prefer to be put in this situation where Hamas is hiding under the dresses of their women. So, no, it's not Israel's fault; it's Islam's fault. The United States has even committed to building a port to bring ships and even thinking about putting boots on the ground to oversee the distribution of food. Talk about stupid! And in Gaza now the most powerful of clans was the Doghmush clan. The head of the Doghmush clan was just executed by Hamas because Islam tolerates no rival and even though they were both Muslims the crime syndicate is run by Hamas. Just look at the pictures of the bags of grain. They're all being carried by Hamas jihadists in plain clothes.

30:02 This week Bilkin said, "Protecting civilians must be job number one for Israel and Gaza." Bull! Killing Hamas is job number one. Israel didn't bring this war on itself. They weren't occupying Gaza.

They didn't do anything to the Gazans. They massacred Jews and the consequence of that is to go after them and kill them. It's the only reasonable response. And while Israel has gone to greater lengths to protect non-combatants than any other nation in the history of the world, somebody finally said okay, it's the United States. The United States lost 2,000 servicemen at Pearl Harbor. You killed 3 million Japanese civilians, and you want to ...? You want to ...? The Germans didn't kill a single American and you firebombed their cities roasting women and children alive, 50,000 a night. Congratulations, America. You had an Islamic jihadist coordinate some flights into U.S. buildings, so you decided to invade Iraq and Afghanistan, countries that had nothing to do with 911, and over a million civilians died. And you want to lecture Israel? A million civilians died, and you pursued two countries that had nothing to do with 911. Since that time, particularly under the Obama Nation, the United States started using drones to kill anybody that the president wanted dead. We killed over 30,000 civilians, none of whom had killed Americans; we just killed them. The president says, "Yeah. That one. Go ahead and kill them. 33:14 Netanyahu said in a speech to IPAC, "The United States and the world cannot say that you support Israel's goal of wiping out Hamas and then oppose Israel when it takes the action necessary to achieve that goal." Now as I said on the evening of October 7th, it's impossible to wipe out Hamas. So, while I will defend Israel's right to try it cannot be done because Hamas is a symptom of Islam and there aren't enough bullets and bombs in the world to take out two billion Muslims. The only solution to Islam is one that can no longer be deployed because after the United States invasions of Iraq, Syria, and Afghanistan Muslims have now infested Europe and the United States, so the plague now has spread, it is contagious, and it can no longer be quarantined. But that was the only answer. Right after 911 Islam had to be quarantined or it would infect and kill everything it touched. It is a death cult and always has been a death cult. It is impossible to coexist with Islam. To say otherwise is to be stupid. To not know what the Quran says, or what Muslims believe, or what Allah demanded, or who Muhammad actually was is just pure ignorance to take any other view. 35:00 I just found out today that our closest friend on the island is Jewish. We had a hint that she was Jewish based on some of her ancestors and have treated her as such for a while. She found out today and I welcomed her into the Family and said, "You know, being Jewish is the only ethnicity that matters. The tone of our skin is irrelevant; it's the character that matters not our skin tint or our ethnicity unless that ethnicity is Jewish in which case there should be a sense of honor."

35:42 Jews represent 0.002 of 1% of the world's population and are responsible for 40% of the world's most important advancements. Israelites are the prophets of God. But it's also a responsibility and so Netanyahu is wrong bellyaching that no one is held to the same standard as Jews are. That part is true. He thinks it's wrong; I think it's right. I think Jews should be held to a different standard - they're God's people. That was the whole intent all along was to hold them to a different standard. And when they wake up and understand who God is then they will understand why they've been called to hold up a different standard.

36:38 On its overall attack on Netanyahu the same time that the comatose Biden Administration announced that Netanyahu was the real problem, that they need to have elections, we need regime change in Israel, and then the U.S. intelligence report, of course, it's not signed and is nothing but a political hack job against Israel, says, "Netanyahu's survival as prime minister is in danger." I don't think that was coordinated. What is wrong with journalists today? This was in the *Jerusalem Post* breaking news and the Progressives at the *Jerusalem Post* aren't smart enough to say, "Well wasn't that convenient?" Now every prime minister in a parliamentary system is always in danger; the whole nature of parliamentary systems is they know gobbledygook politics. He's at the head of a coalition that has Haredim.

37:59 Eighty percent of Israelis want the Haredim to serve in the IDF. Can you imagine those spindly arms on these useless idiots that don't know anything? They don't even study math. They speak Yiddish, so they aren't even conversant in English or Hebrew. They don't know how to use the internet and barely know how to use a cell phone. They don't read newspapers, they are not current on any world event, they can't be around a woman, or they go berserk, and the IDF is as co-ed as any institution in the world. They are opposed to fighting (but they are good at spitting). So, what good are they? They are a parasite on Israel, and they'd be a parasite in the IDF. I think that the government paying them to study their Torah is an absolute disgrace because their Torah is not Yahowah's Towrah. 39:21 Chief Sephardi Rabbi Yitzhak Yosef, dressed in his gold brocade and blue robe with the fancy hat is one ugly son of a bitch. Since there are some perks to this job, I can assure you that Bilkin and Biden have bought their tickets to She'owl, and so has this fellow. She Whose Name Should Not Be Mentioned Because She's Not Worthy says, "Don't conflate Jews with the Israeli government. We're going to separate the Israeli government from Jews because, well, Jews have every right to survive as do the Palestinians. They both have an equal right to survive. And so, it's the Israeli government that's causing the problem, not Islam or not Hamas." UNRWA, the United Nations agency that had terrorists rape, rob, kidnap, and murder Jews on October 7th, not just 10,000 of them that blew up their social media

accounts celebrating the death, mutilation, and rape of Jews, but a score of them that actually participated, UNRWA says, "That's not fair to us because some agency employees admitted heinous crimes only under Israeli coercion. I'm coming home with a pocket full of shekels. No! They admitted that they had ties under coercion. What the hell is wrong with us? And yet nobody in the Israeli media or the world media has the chutzpah to say no that's ridiculous, here's the truth.

44:29 There is a report out of Switzerland that says anti-Semitism in Switzerland has tripled since Hamas invaded Israel but even then, the *Times of Israel* doesn't word it that way. It has tripled since the Hamas-Israel conflict. It's like the Jewish-Arab Wars. What's wrong with people? Muslims attacked Israel; Israel sought to defend itself. They're not equal. Hamas attacked Israel. Israel is defending itself fighting for its survival. There's not a Hamas-Israel conflict. There is something seriously wrong with Islam.

45:22 Biden is drawing this red line in the sand that says if Israel enters Rafah to weed out Hamas to release its captives, that's a red line and that the United States will withhold its supply of weapons which only exists for one reason. Do you know why the United States has to give weapons to Israel and why renouncing them for any reason would be a grotesque breach of the United States commitment? Do you know why that happens? Why does Israel get \$3 billion worth of United States weapons each year? The only reason is that Israel controlled the Sinai and the United States wanted Israel to give it back to Egypt because they wanted to woo Egypt into buying American weapons rather than Russian weapons and if the United States could force Israel to surrender the Sinai, which it controlled and was about to control Cairo and would have controlled Cairo at the end of the Six Day War, that to bribe Israel to give up the Sinai the United States promised \$3 billion worth of weapons aid forever. Now if Israel continued to control the Sinai there would be no Gaza, there would be no Muslims in the so-called "West Bank." They have plenty of places to put them. So, for the United States to renege on that or to threaten to renege on it is disgusting.

47:14 The Jordanian Queen must have the IQ of a gnat. She's probably in there at the same IQ level as the Gazans at about 67, which is sub-retarded. She said, "The humanitarian crisis in Gaza is deliberate." Now it is deliberate, but it's by Hamas, not by Israel. Talk about stupid.

47:45 Zbigniew Brzeziński, an exceedingly evil man, was the fellow that decided that if the United States rented the Taliban from Pakistan and bribed the Pakistani government with weapons that the Pakistani government would be able to impose an Islamic dictatorship over its people and complete their atomic weapons development. The United States by paying them to rent the Taliban would give the Taliban all manner of weapons to fight a proxy war against the Russians in Afghanistan because we were upset that the Russians provided weapons to the Viet Kong in Vietnam to make it difficult for the United States to invade and occupy South Vietnam. So, he decided that the right answer would be to go tit for tat and arm the Taliban by ensuring we have a dictatorship in Pakistan. They finish their nuclear weapons, and we give stinger missiles, anti-aircraft, and anti-tank weapons to this religious fundamentalist group to bludgeon Russians by downing their helicopters, war planes, and tanks. All the while the Houthis roared, kidnapped captains, and sank ships with Iranian weapons, and Hezbollah is armed to the teeth with Iranian rockets. And the reason there's been no discussion of the Iranian bomb? It's done. Congratulations, America. And by the way, guess who built those tunnels in Gaza. The Russians and Chinese. Nicely done, America. The weapons were provided by the Iranians, but it was the Chinese and Russians who had the wherewithal to do that.

52:34 I don't want you to miss this last news item that I have predicted for the past 20 years that the U.S. economy will collapse when we lose our reserve currency status, which will happen. The reason the United States is trying to force the Netanyahu government out is because the United States wants to establish a Fakestinian terrorist state. They know that Israel will be destroyed three or four years down the road. The United States will be destroyed if it doesn't capitulate to the demands of the Saudi Arabians, which is to have a Fakestinian state not because they like the Fakestinians (they can't stand them and have exported all of them out of Saudi Arabia and Kuwait; they don't fund them anymore and are disgusted by them), but they want to threaten Israel and the best way to threaten Israel is to have a Fakestinian state. So, to maintain petrodollar and Federal Reserve status for the U.S. currency the United States is being blackmailed by Saudi Arabia into establishing a Fakestinian State. 54:02 There were two reasons for the 2008 loan crisis. One is the Clinton Administration legalized bundling and selling loans as derivatives, so billions of dollars of loans were bundled and sold as these derivatives. They had no value because of the fabricated illusion that if you want people to believe in the economy and in fiat currency, which is a debt instrument, the best way is to have them buy into that economy through home loans. So, they allowed people to buy a home with negative 5% cash down rather than putting 20% down which has always been the minimum. You could get a loan for 105% of the assessed value of the home so that you'd have money to make your first payments and then they were all based on adjustable rates. So, when the United States went into this mode of quantitative easing and creating the illusion of selling our treasury bills and thereby inflating the currency so the currency had less value, the only way you could resolve that was to charge higher and higher interest rates. Interest rates began to go up, the people who had these homes couldn't pay for it, the loans were all non-recourse and the easiest thing for them to do was welch on the loans.

As that started there was an avalanche, and with the avalanche, prices fell further until none of the loans had any value. That's just what happened.

56:01 I mention it because there is another economic bubble involving office buildings and retail space. In places like New York, entire skyscrapers have zero occupancy because tenants have moved out. Then, when COVID happened, politicians mismanaged the economy and became dictators. They controlled how many employees could physically come to work, how many had to work from home (working from home is not nearly as efficient), who could and could not work, and what was and was not an essential business. They screwed everything up, and the world will never recover from what they did. And because employees worked from home, those empty office buildings didn't generate any revenue, and the non-recourse loans on those buildings became worthless. We will have a collapse, not only because of worthless office space but also because of worthless retail space; megamalls and strip malls have no value. Hotels in central cities have no value either. No one is attending a convention, and hotels are not safe. So, there is a collapse of commercial real estate coming.

57:46 All right. That's my news for today, and it's all good. How could you have all that terrible news and say it's all good? For the same reason I said that Israel not trusting their government is good news. It's less than ten years until Yahowah's return and over that time we're expecting that 7,000 people will be ready by 2029 for the Taruw'ah Harvest and some 77,000 people will be ready in Jerusalem, mostly Yahuwdym and Yisra'elites, in 2033 for Yowm Kipurym when Yahowah and Dowd return. 59:48 I'm going to share something with Progressive Jews worldwide. They may not like Israel, they may want Israel to fail. But prior to the 1920s and 30s and through the 40s there were relatively few prosperous Jews around the world. There were some in America and a few in Europe, but for the most part it was very difficult for Jews to prosper. The majority of Jews we're living in Shettles and were deprived either by the Roman Catholic Church, Socialists, Fascists, or Muslims. What changed was Israel. When Israel became a nation and there was somebody advocating for Jews, when Jews had a safe haven, it became possible for them to flourish around the world. 1:01:31 All right. We were dealing with the saddest episode in Dowd's life and I'm going to share the speech that Yow'ab gave to him. 1:02:37 "Then Yow'ab | Yah is the Father arrived at the home of the King, and declared, 'You have become emaciated, withering away, confused and disappointing this day in the presence of your coworkers, all of whom would have saved your life, and the lives of your sons and your daughters, the lives of your wives, even the lives of your concubines, (Shamuw'el / Listen to Him / 2 Samuel 19:5) because you love those you should hate, and you hate those you should love.

1:03:28 I don't think I have ever heard anyone deliver a message based upon what Yow'ab said. But think of the power of those words. "You're a disgrace, you are disappointing, you are an emaciated withering man who is a shadow of his former self because you love those you should hate, and you hate those you should love." I've long said, and I will continue to say, hate is a virtue. Yow'ab knows it, Yahowah knows it. We must know what to hate, when to hate, why to hate, and most especially how to hate. It's essential.

1:04:31 I had one of the most bitter blows I have experienced in a while. I'm over it now; you move on in life. I think I shared with you that I mentored five or six young men, all in their 20s, had never worked at a normal job before. I defended them, got them out of jail, taught them a trade, shared my family and home, we shared meals together and I spent hundreds of hours of my life investing in each young man. The one that was closest to me, Elvis, I bought a truck for, I hired the best attorney in the world to keep him from serving a minimum of 30 years in prison, I got his best friend out of jail, hired his best friend, wrote the judge to get him released from house arrest so that I had the chance to mentor the both of them. Well, this young man stopped showing up one day in November. Towards the end his car broke down; I gave him my truck for like three months. I never drove my own car, he drove it. He didn't even have a license, so think of the risk that I was putting myself in. I noticed that his mind was no longer on the job. His attitude shifted but I said, "Oh well, everybody got goes through this." I even put him up in one of our closest friend's two-bedroom condo with an ocean view to get him out of the depression; did everything that you could imagine for this young man. Won the case with the judge based on the affidavit that I had written and the attorney that I had hired for him. There was \$23,000 worth of credit card fraud perpetrated against him and Citi Bank will hold me harmless likely on most of it, but I'm not sure they'll hold me harmless on all of it. It's not my fault, but this is what happened. It was all local merchants, so I knew they had to be complicit, so I filed a police report. I do want to file charges and this last week I was asked to come to the police station to meet with the detective who had a video he wanted to show me of the person that they knew was fraudulently using my credit card. The card wasn't present; they took a picture of my card and used the numbers. It was Elvis, the man that I had done so much for. It was devastating and I cried right there in the office. I'm not a very emotional guy but I cried in front of the police. I was devastated. I came back home and a very close friend and local artist who is doing some projects here in the house (We called it "Gilding the Lily") says, "Now that you know that I have something to tell you that you're not going to want to

hear but II need to tell you this. Back in November another man that you had working here was driving Elvis back and forth, before you gave him your car, and went into the apartment that you had made available for him from your friend and took a picture of a kilo of cocaine and a full functioning machine gun sitting next to it on the kitchen counter." And he didn't tell me. On the same day Elvis confessed to this other individual that worked for me that he had killed a man who happened to be a Columbian drug lord that had a hit out on his life that had been threatening him. He and a number of his friends murdered him. When my friend questioned him on it saying, "How could you do that? That's a pretty immoral thing to do," he said, "Well, you know, that's the way we do things around here. He was threatening me, so we took him out and I sleep just fine over it." He didn't tell me until almost four months later and I said, "Listen, we're friends. I'm not going to hold this against you, but I want you to know how horrible a thing you did by not telling me. My family was subjected to a murderer and a thief, and you said nothing. I know you like the kid. I know that wouldn't want to hear it, so you're a coward." He said, "Well, I didn't want to get involved, you know, what happens if I have to testify, and he comes after me." I said, "What is wrong with you? Where's your character? Where's your morality? Where's your backbone? I thought you were a man." Back in my day you expected men to stand up to things like this. Today I would say that it's equal responsibility for women to stand up in the same way too. A man is just stronger, and they have a little better way to defend themselves, but nonetheless, I'm thinking what's wrong with you.

1:10"24 First of all, to know that somebody committed a crime and not say something is a crime. But secondly, look what you did to us because you were a coward. I was exceedingly disappointed. We continued talking it through and he kept giving excuses. I kept saying, "No. There are no excuses for this. What you did was wrong. You didn't have the courage to stand up and to say what needed to be said." My wife talked to him and said, "Listen. We're still great friends." I care deeply about this individual and I'm going to overlook what he did. I'm just saying this, and I didn't mention his name because this is an example to compare to Yow'ab.

1:11:28 Yow'ab knew that there are times to hate. 1:16:13 Instead, you have implied this day that you don't have leaders or coworkers. I realize that if 'Abshalowm had lived and all of the rest of us had died this day, then it would have been seen by you as pleasing and correct.

1:16:35 So right now, stand up and choose to go out and speak from the heart to your coworkers, because I promise by Yahowah if you do not go forth, and if you remain an obstinate and immobilized individual, if you cower, this night will be worse for you than all of the evil that has befallen you from your youth until now." (Shamuw'el / Listen to Him / 2 Samuel 19:6-7)

1:17:16 That's one of the greatest speeches ever in the history of the world. The only one that gave better speeches was Moseh. I love Dowd's lyrics, but this is right to the heart.

1:17:28 I can understand; Dowd grieved for his son and for the Father to hold him accountable for what he had done. And just as our Father stood up for us, Dowd would take a stand on behalf of 'Abshalowm. Yes, he was guilty as sin, but so is everyone else Chag Matsah and Kipurym are designed to redeem and reconcile.

1:17:58 It is all true, Dowd should have hated what 'Abshalowm had done, and he should have loved him nonetheless as his son. There was only one way to do both. Dowd would fulfill Chag Matsah, carrying 'Abshalowm's guilt, and ours, into She'owl and depositing it there.

1:18:22 I wrote a paragraph in *God Damn Religion* today where Allah had his militants who turned tail and ran at ____, and he's saying that they should beg for forgiveness. I just stopped and said, "You know I've been with Yahowah now for 23 years and I've never asked Him to forgive me. Never once asked Him to save me. I would never ask Yahowah to forgive me; there's nothing to forgive. Why is there nothing to forgive? Is it because I am perfect? Why would it be foolish to ask Yahowah for forgiveness? 1:22:28 **A great many** (*rab* – the preponderance of people, the great majority, an abundant and extensive amount, and a widespread and numerous quantity) **rise up** (*quwm* – take a stand, are established, honored and exalted, yet incited, powerful and standing fast) **against me** (*'al 'any* – over me)." (*Mizmowr* / Lyrics to be Sung / Psalm 3:1)

1:22:35 *Tsar* is an exceptionally important concept for us at this moment in time. There is no tribulation but there is a time of Ya'aqob's Troubles. Ya'aqob is a synonym for Yisra'el, so it is the time 'eth of Israel's Troubles. Troubles is from *tsar*. When you want to see *tsar* in action, look at Mitsraym. He actually likes the flavor that is part of the communication of people who are passionate, who have backbone, scars and callouses, who have had experiences like I shared with you what happened this week, to have those kinds of experiences, that know what Dowd knows about a broken family because that's how we develop character and how we get an appreciation for what Yahowah has endured. So, when we read about Dowd doing a dunderhead thing and being brokenhearted over a fractured family, it's because God chose to reveal this message through men who knew what it was like to have love and lost, just as He has, who have failed and got back up, who have taken the risk to do the right thing and have seen it through. That's why I said I admire what Yow'ab did. I don't think I have the horsepower to pull that off, not to Dowd. But he did and I admire him. I couldn't have done it. I think I might have been able to do what Moseh did in Mitsraym; I would risk it all for that. But this is God's Son; that's a whole different thing.

1:35:48 We need to understand why we hear these stories. Look at 'Abraham. He pimped out Sarah twice for money. That's terrible and disgusting. And yet, Yahowah loved him because He knew what

Dowd was going to do and could retroactively apply it to 'Abraham. He saw the good parts. He didn't have to overlook the bad because the bad was gone. It's a marvelous plan that He came up with.

1:36:25 "You (wa 'atah), Yahowah (Yahowah – an accurate transliteration of the name of 'elowah – God guided by His towrah – instructions regarding His hayah – existence and our shalowm – reconciliation), are a shield all around me and my source of deliverance (magen ba'ad 'any – You have provided the gift of protection over me and are a defensive weapon which shields me from attack, covering and surrounding me such that others may benefit by the same directions and path), my manifestation of power and attribution of status (kabowa 'any – everything I value and respect, my splendor and glory, my source of abundance and enrichment, my gift and reward), and the One raising (ruwm – lifting up on high, exalting and honoring) my head, first and foremost from the beginning (ro'sh 'any – my uppermost being)." (Mizmowr / Lyrics to Sing / Psalm 3:3)

1:36:51 If we are looking to be protected, Yahowah is the One to do it. I've received thousands and thousands of death threats, and I've never once ducked. When people say aren't you afraid that this young man that killed somebody that you are now prosecuting for credit card fraud is going to attack you, I say, No. Let's see how close he can get; it might be entertaining. If you're doing something that Yahowah wants done, then He's your shield and your source of deliverance. If you want to accomplish something worthwhile, He is the manifestation and attribution of status for everything of value. He's the one willing to raise our heads above the crowd. I've always said that if you're one of the rare people that is going to go against the crowd and going to raise your head against the crowd saying you're all going the wrong direction and let me tell you why, you are going to be stampeded and maligned. The fastest way to develop enemies and to be slandered is to take a stand, put your head above the crowd, and Dowd did that. I think that's a lot of the reason why he finally just wore out, particularly in Israel; that's a tough crowd. It just became too much at the end.

1:38:28 There are times where it's hard, and Dowd finally wore out. Now he's going to be reenergized and it'll all be fine again but here as he's inspiring this Psalm, he's got the answer. The answer is all over the 91st Psalm that Yahowah is a shield around those and a source of deliverance, the manifestation of power and the status, the One who will raise our head not only above the crowd but protect it once it's there.

1:39:01 It was never realistic to believe that Dowd was actually concerned for his safety. He fought 66 battles and never lot one. For example, my relationship with Yah is wonderful, but barely in the same universe when compared to Dowd's, and yet, I'm not bothered in the least with what others say of me when it pertains to the Word of God. When it comes to the Word of God, you can say whatever you want to say, I do not care. I'm going to continue to convey Yah's testimony and I'm going to continue to condemn that was is opposed to Him and His people.

1:39:36 I know something of this, having received countless thousands of death threats from Muslims for having had the courage and sense to reveal the truth about Muhammad, the Quran, and Allah, doing so publicly on five to ten thousand radio interviews, all under my own name. And yet, I haven't lost so much as a minute's sleep over any of it. And I'm far less important to God in comparison to the Beloved and Anointed King of Yisra'el. God takes care of those who take care of His people.

1:40:19 I share this because the insurrection perpetrated by 'Abshalowm was so easily and quickly resolved by Dowd's forces. It might have been the first day of battle. It was only the ensuing sacrifice to save his son's soul that would be cause for celebration and grief.

1:40:50 Dowd held greater status with Yah than all the rest of us combined. He would have had no reason to duck, causing us to realize that this reference to raising his head from the beginning, attributing great power and status to him, delivering him, speaks of something special, of something that was and soon will happen and something that has happened as well.

1:41:19 Yahowah delivered Dowd's *nepesh* from She'owl following the fulfillment of Matsah. Then during Bikuwrym, Dowd became the *Bakowr* | Firstborn. His status was raised from King to Liberator following in the footsteps of Moseh. He became the first and foremost among men.

1:41:43 And speaking of unique, what follows has the invitation in Dowd's voice and the answer in God's rather than the other way around.

1:41:59 "I communicated audibly calling out to and summoning (qowl 'any 'el qara' – using the sound of my voice I spoke out, inviting, then reading and reciting I make my declaration to, welcoming (qal imperfect)) Yahowah (Yahowah – the proper pronunciation of the name of 'elowah – God as directed in His towrah – teaching regarding His hayah existence and our shalowm – restoration), and He answered me (wa 'anah 'any – so He responded to me, providing testimony and evidence for me (qal imperfect)) from (min – on account of and by way of) His Set-Apart Mountain (har qodesh huw' – His dedicated and consecrated place of separation). Pause and consider this (selah)." (Mizmowr / Lyrics to be Sung / Psalm 3:4)

1:42:24 It is our responsibility to listen to what Yahowah has to say. Even Dowd with his relationship, his brilliance, even though he had the ultimate gift of gab when it came to conveying Yahowah's testimony, even he knew that the right approach was to listen to God as opposed to yabbering at Him, that God is sending us the invitation that we should answer. And yet here in Mizmowr 3:4 he's the one who is qara'. Qara' was written in first person qal imperfect. "I communicated audibly calling out to and summoning Yahowah, and He answered me. Why did he do that on Matsah or Kipurym? He was the living embodiment at that point of qara'. He was the living embodiment of Yahowah's 'anah | answer. He had made this sacrifice on the Set-Apart Mountain so that we could be qodesh. That's what I consider important when we pause to contemplate what he said.

1:43:57 Dowd knew where to turn his ear to listen to God, but he also knew there was a time to summon God. Further, his summons was answered because long before Dowd called out to Yahowah on this day he had listened to His Towrah, engaged in the Beryth, and attended the Miqra'ey and now he was fulfilling them. It is the proper order of things and brings the most beneficial result.

1:44:29 Yah and I chat, and I'm sure you do as well. But I do it probably a thousand to one listening to talking when it comes to God; it just works out better that way. I learn more. I don't embarrass myself; I'm enlightened, I'm energized and am empowered when I do something worthwhile with my life. The only time I talk is on this program. Understand this program is really the opposite of the relationship I have with God. Now, to some degree, it's the same because we're reading Yah's testimony and I'm sharing the insights that can be derived from it and that's how Yahowah and I live our lives together. But in our normal existence most of my responses are, "Wow! Thank You for sharing that here. I'm

impressed. That was another good one. You're good at this prophecy stuff!" We have a Father son relationship. He's the grownup and I'm the kid, and you know, it's nice to be the kid in this relationship. So, it is the proper order of things and brings the most beneficial result. And in this case, Father and Son had rehearsed what they would accomplish together 1,000 years in advance of the occurrence. They knew that they could rely upon one another.

1:46:18 And that really is essential. Yahowah knew that in the end when it came down to the most important moment of His life He could rely on Dowd. Dowd was committed to making this happen and, of course, Dowd knew he could rely on Yahowah. I think to some extent, we've been doing this now for 23 years, I think Yahowah knows He can rely on me. I'm not going away, I'm going to see it through, and I think it's comforting even for God to know that He can. That said, I expect Yahowah to continue to make it as easy as He can. By Easy I mean we don't need a whole lot of distractions to get this done, so I'm not inviting distractions to say okay how many distractions can you handle before you're no longer eager to keep going ahead. But I can tell you that Yahowah has done a marvelous job of removing distractions, and I think He knows I'm devoted to the cause and that I completely trust Him to do as He's promised.

1:47:36 What Dowd reveals next did not occur during the fiasco with 'Abshalowm. 'Abshalowm is 'ab | father of shalowm | reconciliations, so father reconciles. It's kind of an interesting name and an additional motivation for Dowd to fulfill Matsah. Helping us to recognize this is likely much of the reason we were provided so much detail on Dowd's reaction to the end of the coup. By knowing what happened then, we are able to see this as addressing a much greater past and future event: the Second Coming and Third Coming, when Dowd came to liberate us and will return to lead us at the conclusion of the very worst of the Time of Ya'aqob's Troubles in the summer of 2033. Revived and productive, he will take action, as a result of Yahowah sustaining and supporting him throughout the ages.

1:49:00 When Dowd came to fulfill Chag Matsah, he had spent a thousand years with Yahowah. When he returns as the King of Kings, as our Shepherd and great leader, he will have spent 2,000 years with Yah. I share this because when 'ElYah returns, he will have spent what 2,700 – 2,800 years with Yahowah. I have spent the last 23 years with Yahowah but not in the spiritual realm and not as a seven-dimensional being that can embrace so much of who Yah is. It's just what we can know in three and a half dimensions versus what we can experience and know in seven dimensions is a very different thing, so our physical power to produce, to perform, to be effective as a spiritual being is infinitely beyond what we can do as a mortal physical being. So, when Dowd returns as a spiritual being that can take physical form when he so chooses, it's just like 'ElYah, it's going to be so energized. It's one of the reasons why I asked Yah that He can do whatever He wants, but I would really like to have six months in Shamaym between the Taruw'ah Harvest and returning on Pesach in 2033. If He needs more help here, I'll stay here, but can you imagine how energizing that would be?

1:51:06 So, when Dowd returns, we should expect a Dowd as brilliant as the sun. At this point we can only imagine what 15 minutes would be like in Yah's presence. I mean if Yahowah were to walk up and it's in the spiritual realm, but tangibly we think in the material realm, put His hand on our shoulder, look us in the eye and smile, do you know what that would do for our confidence, our courage, our capacity to do the right thing? That's what Dowd will have gone through and by that time he will have spent 3,000 years with Yah.

1:52:05 Revived and productive, he will take action, as a result of Yahowah sustaining and supporting him throughout the ages. If not, what reason would Dowd have for telling us in the midst of the 3rd Mizmowr | Psalm that he did the same thing we all do almost every night: that he fell asleep and woke up refreshed and productive the next morning? It was quite a night.

1:52:38 "I relaxed ('any shakab – I stretched out and reclined, lying down to rest (qal perfect)) and fell asleep (wa yashen – and slept). I will awaken revived and productive (qyts – passing through the summer and the heat of the moment, I am to be roused, feeling alive and refreshed, taking action and bearing fruit (hifil perfect)) because (ky) Yahowah (Yahowah – an accurate transliteration of the name of 'elowah – God guided by His towrah – instructions regarding His hayah – existence and our shalowm – reconciliation) sustains and supports me (samak 'any – upholds me, steadfastly focusing upon me such that I can lean on Him for whatever was necessary (qal imperfect))." (Mizmowr / Lyrics to be Sung / Psalm 3:5)

1:53:18 As the famous line in the movie says, "I'mmmmm baaaaaack!" That is what Dowd is revealing. He fell asleep 3,000 years ago but was awakened to serve his people 1,000 years later, most especially during the fulfillment of Bikuwrym. And ten years from this revision of *Coming Home* in 2023, as I wrote it, we will witness the Third Coming of Dowd, and I think that is exciting! And he is going to be sustained and supported by Yahowah. He's going to be awakened, revived, and protective. It's going to be extraordinary to see the Dowd that we witness and that we get to enjoy is going to be the best of what we see and hear in his words and lives an infinite fold. And we are going to be infinitely greater than we are as well.
