

Shabat Towrah Study Yahowah Nathan Qowl Huw' Yahowah Offers His Voice Year 5991 Yah 02Aug24

0:00 Good evening and welcome to Yada Yah Radio. It was an interesting week for Israel. Who knows what the upcoming week will bring. Israel managed to assassinate the number one leader of Hamas. They were also able to verify that they had killed several weeks ago the number three leader in Hamas. Now all that really remains is Sinwar and they will have a trifecta of Hamas's leadership. At the same week they were able to kill the number two leader of Hezbollah. Hezbollah by the way is a Quranic party. Hezbollah is actually mentioned twice in the Quran so it's bothersome to me when Hezbollah is referenced exclusively as a terrorist group because they are an Islamic group. Hezbollah means "party of Allah" and Hamas which is from a Hebrew word, it means "terrorist" is also an Islamic organization and to refer to them as anything else is misleading. While I would celebrate the death of these swine, the world is better off without them, I still say that it will make no difference until Israel fundamentally changes its attitude towards Islam, towards these people called the Fakestinians, towards any kind of negotiation with Muslims.

1:48 I was deeply troubled this week when after the assassination of Haniyeh in Iran, which is deeply embarrassing for the Shiite theocracy there because they killed him right under their nose which means Israel just as easily could have killed the Ayatollah which I think would be in their interest; I would do it if I were them just as I think they should kill Nasrallah. I think that is also in their interest. The reality here is that so long as Israel continues to say that they're fighting terrorist organizations and Hamas and Hezbollah they're going to lose because they'd be lashing out at symptoms and then it becomes one man's terrorist as another person's freedom fighter.

2:49 Kamala Harris, who I despise, I view her as one of the most lethal people on the planet vis-à-vis Israel. She is more conniving, if you will, than any member of the squad and given the opportunity as president, if she's elected, you can be assured that the only country that keeps Israel from being embargoed by the world, the United States by its veto in the Security Council of the United Nations, will stop doing so. It brings up a discussion I had with one of my dearest friends who is absolutely Covenant and wants the best for not only the Covenant family but also for his family who has a family that's comprised of people who identify themselves as progressives and he's disappointed that I am so vehement against progressives on this program. He says it precludes someone that he dearly loves - family members (I understand that. I can appreciate that.) from considering this message because as a progressive they have a kneejerk reaction that says if you are condemning progressives, which I have done and will continue to do and I will share the reasons why in a moment, that you must be for that other guy, and they have a visceral hatred for republicans and for Donald Trump in particular.

4:41 I'm no fan of Donald Trump but I'm also not stupid and I know that Donald Trump for all of his ego and foibles is still the best president for Israel, which I care deeply about, than any other occupant of the White House in perhaps 200 years. I know that Kamala Harris would be a disaster for Israel. I work for Yahowah; that is my job. I serve Yahowah's people on behalf of God's request and so I have done what I said I would never do. I am a one-issue man as it relates to politics. While I am anti-political and I do not participate in either political party and I would encourage everyone who is a Covenant member to disengage from politics, not support a candidate and not vote, I am so supportive of Israel that even with Israel's being a house divided with progressives on one side and the ultra-religious on the other and they're both wrong and they're tearing the country to shreds while it's being attacked from outside and inside by

Muslims and their parliamentary system is a disaster, it's a country that doesn't even have a constitution which means they have no business even having a high court because there's no limits on their power, even with all of that being the case, Yahowah's interest is His people; it's always been that way. His place is Israel, His people are Yahuwdaym/Jews. I care deeply about them and anyone who tries to harm them in any way whether they be Christians or conspiratorialists or Muslims or now progressives you become my foe. You are God's foe.

6:54 In this particular case while it is obvious that the Roman Catholic Church has been an enemy of God's people, Jews, for almost 2,000 years, that the Christian New Testament exists to replace Jews with a gentile church and to blame Jews for their God reneging on His relationship with them and therefore hating the people that He says He loves. Now, of course, everything we read in the prophets is exactly the opposite of the Christian point of view but evidence and reason, even God's word, has never appealed to the religious and so as a result of a vehemently antisemitic New Testament and Replacement Theology Christians have persecuted, dehumanized, demonized, and persecuted Jews for the better part of 2,000 years.

8:07 I am vehemently anti-Christianity. I am vehemently anti-Islam, and I'm the only person on this planet that has ever written a series of books denouncing both Islam and Christianity and doing so in both cases by comparing the words of those who claimed that they spoke for the God of the Towrah to the words of the God of the Towrah, and so I am vehemently against Islam because Islam declared war on Jews and perpetrated genocide against God's people starting 1,440 years ago with Muhammad and the first Muslims. They exterminated every Jew within camel ride of Yathrib. They were savages. Their hatred, and Allah's hatred, of Jews is unfathomable and unquenchable and undeniable. It's why on the initial covers of *God Damn Religion*, when they were reinstated, the covers quoted Muhammad as saying "Kill Every Jew." It's been tamed down to "Islamic Terror" now. Nonetheless, that was the message.

9:25 Christians and Muslims aren't the only foes against Jews, and they are not the only foes that I am speaking out against. I speak out against conspiratorialists. The most popular conspiracies over the last 2,000 years have been "Blame the Jews." Jews are blamed for all manner of things, and it reminds me of the saying, "Tell me what you have against Jews, and I will tell you who you are." Almost universally the claims that Muslims, including Congress women, hold out against Jews they are guilty themselves of doing and the Jews are not. So, it is a world of utter chaos and insanity that they come from and the only solution to Islam is to quarantine it. It is a pandemic disease vastly more deadly than COVID.

10:38 Today Muslims who are rioting worldwide who are protesting to annihilate Jews which is what "From the river to the sea Palestine will be free" means, they would have no traction, no sanction, no opportunity, no credibility if it were not for progressives. They are coddled, they are supported by progressives who march with them who scream out lies about Israel along with them. And since Muslims are genuinely too stupid to get out of their own way with an IQ averaging about 70, without progressives they'd be nothing. It's the progressives that want the two-state solution. Muslims don't even want it; they want Israel annihilated. So, progressives are the problem. They are the enemy of Yahowah. They're the enemy of God's people. They're my enemy. I'm sorry, they can say well that's not what it means to me. Well, I'm sorry, but that happens to be the essence of who you are today.

12:00 It goes beyond that and that is that Yahowah is anti-government. He says the bigger the government the bigger the problem. When Israel wanted to have a government like the Gentiles Yahowah quickly explained to Shamuw'el the 12 things that that government was going to do that would be harmful to His people and everything He said is true and playing out today; the bigger the government the worst it is. The bigger any human institution is the worse it is. Man can be good or bad. Man as a communal creature is always bad. There has never been a human civilization that was good and most of them have been hideously vicious and destructive. Collective man is horrible. Progressives, the new name for Socialist Secular Humanists, want larger government. They want more government control and intrusion into people's lives. They would be wrong. They would be opposed to what Yahowah stands for.

13:08 Let's be honest. Hitler was a progressive. Mao was a progressive. Stalin was a progressive. They were all extremely liberal in their desire to control others and to increase the influence of government. It was the German Socialist Workers Party; they were all progressives. If we were to apply the term as it's being used today, they would all be progressives.

13:44 It brings me to this current election. Progressives have this visceral hatred of Donald Trump. Donald Trump says a lot of stupid stuff. Now his policies were better for America than were Biden's, but Biden doesn't say as many insane things; he just can't put two sentences together. But this visceral hatred of an individual is a communal effect of progressivism. It is a ___ response. And when the person that they will now vote for would be the single most destructive individual vis-à-vis the survival of God's people, Israel, while the person they would vote against would be their biggest supporter in the world, that would make them an enemy of God's people which should make them an enemy of God.

14:58 I have long said that if you want to be overtly political no matter how you view your politics, "I only want to be a progressive because I think a woman should have control over her body." All right. That's your choice; that's a good choice as far as it goes. But unfortunately, women not being able to control their bodies is why they're using abortion as a form of contraceptive. They might say, "I'm in favor of Black Lives Matter." That would be really stupid because 90% of the time that a young black man is killed, he is killed by another black man which means the problem is in the African-American community and until you identify the problems in the African-American community and start to deal with them you ought not be pointing the finger at the cause of the other 10% ___. That's just the reality. Plus, as I've said, those that profited from Black Lives Matter were anti-Israel and now that has become overtly apparent.

16:15 Two states is not a solution and that's what they give lip service to. It is the dissolution of Israel. Prophecies abound about what's going to happen. Dowd spoke of them as did Yasha'yah and said that the consequence of this is going to bring the worst war that Israel has ever experienced. So, it is a race to see who can be the next Neville Chamberlain and just like the last Neville Chamberlain led to the deaths of six million Jews this next Neville Chamberlain will usher in the deaths of millions of Jews. This time it may not be six million Jews who are killed. It may only be three or four million, could be five million but there's a difference. Hitler and his goons while they starved many Jews and worked many Jews to death their principal means of killing Jews was to gas them, put them to sleep, and then burn their bodies in their crematorium. That isn't how Muslim savages work. They taunt their victims, they rape their victims, they mutilate their victims, they taunt their victims some more, they rape their victims some more, they kill their victims and continue to rape them and then they desecrate their bodies and then they bring them

back to their huddles as if they were some kind of trophy. Muslims are savages. They're monsters and so the torture that is going to be perpetrated against Jews with the next iteration of what occurred on October 7th, which is going to occur in 2027 and be a thousand times worse than what Jews experienced this past year in Israel, it's going to be torturous because Jews are savages excuse me Muslims are savages when it comes to harming ____.

18:51 Dee, you created and now my wife is partnering with you something that I got to see; Kirk you got to see. The world will be delayed in seeing it because of two things: One is I couldn't help myself and while praising it saying it's by far the best thing I have seen on our behalf ever, I made several suggestions as to things that would improve it and in the process you also found that some of the audio files degraded and that you needed to redo them. The good news is that in doing so between you and my wife you found some much more effective images. But I'm here to tell you I'm hoping that it's available next week and we can talk about it next week. It's the most powerful thing I've ever seen. You know, it's one thing for Jews to say this was awful what they did to us, it's another thing for Gowym, the Nakar, Choter, Yada, Dowd's basar, to say in my voice, and to have the Covenant members, the two lead of which are both Jews, together in this audiovisual presentation of what has happened and will happen to Israel also through the voice of the prophet, Yow'el. It is easily the most powerful thing I've ever witnessed and what it says is that Muslims are savages; they're inhuman. You could say, "Well, I know a Muslim and they're a nice girl or boy." Then they're not Muslims or you're fooled.

20:43 It's really quite clear. All good Muslims are terrorists. Should they not be a terrorist, they're no longer a Muslim. Allah calls them Hypocrites and tells good Muslims to kill them so that he can torture them forever in hell.

20:54 DEE: He calls a nonviolent Muslims the number one enemy of Islam.

0:21:00 YADA: That is correct. So, if you don't know these things then it's your ignorance. Just shut up because you don't know. The fact is that those who do know and, if you want to know I have 4,000 pages for you to read in the five volumes of *God Damn Religion*. They're all free online - read them. The case against Islam is black and white or should I said say bloody red. Islam exists to annihilate Jews. It's a declaration of war against all mankind but the Jews are first to die, and it is progressives that are facilitating this Islamic onslaught of Israel. So, I'm sorry if you want to define yourself as a progressive, if you are angry at me because I'm criticizing progressives you do not belong in this Covenant. You are not going to be comfortable in God's Family. The first condition of the Covenant is to walk away from the integration of religion and politics and progressivism is religion integrated into politics, and so you just are not ready, you're not welcome. Someone must first be willing to walk away from religion, to disassociate themselves from religion, to withdraw from the societal influence of religion and politics before they can even consider what Yahowah is offering. He's not interested in sharing anything he has to offer with anybody that doesn't first forego religion and politics. So, I will continue to denounce religion. I will continue to denounce the conspirators. So many of the those on the right are conspiratorial and so many of those on the right are fundamentalist Christian in their religion; they aren't welcome either. So, this is where we stand on those issues.

23:30 Before we return to Yow'el, you can blame this on Kirk, just kidding. I received a letter I guess a little over two weeks ago that I dished off a response, shared it with some members of the Covenant family,

particularly those engaged in social media because it's helpful for others to see how I would answer somebody who is snippy and cops an attitude, and so I sent it off and I really thought nothing of it until Kirk sent me a text, or an email, and said, "You know I think we I we ought to cover this thing." The last time we did that we had a mutiny. The whole Pacific Northwest went off on their own. Was that Moody Scot or somebody, Moody Jeff, that was who it was. He was a theological student that had issues with the truth and with Yahowah and I was dismissive of him and the Pacific contingent. "Meaner. You can't be meaner." Well, I've done my best to hone my attitude such that it matches my Father's and if you don't like it then you're not going to like Him very much either. So, we're gonna continue.

25:12 All right, Dee. I sent this to you. You've seen it previously. You want to read this and then I will interrupt you as I see fit. Don't be upset with the interruptions.

25:27 DEE: No worries. All right. So, Miss Harsh is what we're calling her and she wrote this:

25:33 "Hello Craig. I was an atheist who has come to discover the existence of god." (lower case g).

25:39 YADA: Lower case g by the way. You know, how would one discover the existence of God? She doesn't bother to say. Okay - or who God is. She doesn't bother to say.

25:51 KIRK: Or which one

YADA: Or which one. Could be a million of them floating around, particularly of the lower g-o-d variety; there are millions.

26:05 DEE: I was stunned by the lowercase g actually. That's weird; it's very strange. She writes "I'm not emotionally attached to religion or the Bible, so I look with a very open heart and open mind for THE TRUTH." (all caps)

26:16 YADA: All caps. So, we're screaming THE TRUTH. Okay.

26:23 DEE: Yeah. "I'm also a huge skeptic of most things. A friend gave me your book last year and it was my first experience reading quote the Bible unquote ..."

26:33 YADA: Just stop there for a moment. If you're writing me, how would you reach me? I think there's only one way to reach me. You have to go to the website, and you have to follow the "about us" and there's a contact us button there. If you were to go to the website, what's your first impression on the website? Is there a book there?

27:03 DEE: Like 34.

YADA: Yeah, so why would you say, "I read," "someone gave me your book?" Which book? And even of the 34 books that's there what edition of which book? I mean come on. You want to take the time to write a letter, can you please tell me which god is it that you think exists and which book you might have read and why you would equate that book to the "Bible"? I would never use that term.

27:45 Bible means "with bel." It's *ba bel* which is "with the Lord Ba'al." The Lord is Satan and is it based on the Hebrew word *babel* which means "to confound and confuse by intermixing" in this case all forms of

religion together. The Hebrew word is the basis of the Greek word which is also the name of a Egyptian goddess so great term. Okay.

28:18 Since writing that she says, "Since then I have Christian friends warn me that you are a recluse hiding in the islands trying to deceive people."

28:32 Okay. Well, let's deal recluse. I would have to be probably the first extroverted recluse in all of history, may even be the first recluse to have done 20,000 talk radio programs and blogs and probably the first recluse ever to put my name on the cover of 34 books. So, it would be a very different kind of recluse. But I began to think here a moment and well recluse is used as a pejorative, it is based on the idea of being reclusive and if you look up reclusive it means to withdraw from society or culture. What is the first condition of the Covenant? To walk away. So, wouldn't every Covenant member be reclusive by definition?

29:29 DEE: I think we are.

YADA: Yes. When Dowd was hanging out there in the Garden

KIRK: You mean 'Adam.

YADA: When 'Adam was hanging out there in the Garden, was he not a recluse? When Yahowah decided to choose Noach, wasn't it because he was the ultimate recluse disassociating from the Nephilim community surrounding him? When He chose Moseh to go into Mitsraym, wasn't Moseh out tending sheep in the wastelands of Arabia? Wouldn't that qualify as a recluse? When He reached out to 'Abraham wasn't Abraham somewhere on the road out of town out Ur of the Chaldeans? Wouldn't that make him a recluse? When Yahowah turned down all the sons of Yshy (Jesse) and said, "No. I want the guy that's the recluse out there tending sheep in Bethlehem." And 'Elyah. What a great celebration of reclusively. You want to go find him man you had to go into the boondocks. Be careful of the pejoratives you pick because in this particular case it is a condition of the Covenant from the sense of reclusively which is "to draw away from society."

31:09 Okay. Hiding in the islands. If I were hiding, would I tell people I was living in the US Virgin Islands? Would you be hiding if on your website you have a picture of yourself sitting there on the beach just below my home? Oh, good grief. Okay. So, I'm really not very good at this hiding thing but nonetheless okay.

31:53 Oh. Trying to deceive people. Okay. If you want to engage with somebody that has written 34 books and done 20,000 or so radio programs and you wish to get their attention and have them answer questions for you, would you begin by saying you are deceiving people? If you're saying you are deceiving people, wouldn't you have already made up your mind? The letter was just designed to be harsh and mean and because you're harsh and mean and just leave it at that.

32:40 If she's read your book, she would understand none of this is true so why ask the question?

32:47 If you were trying to deceive when you write your translation, you know my whole shtick for 23 years is I have a very unique way of presenting Yahowah's words and that unique way is first to go to the oldest extant sources the Dead Sea Scrolls or the Masoretic text, whichever is older, and in any particular passage I will always review it in context. I'll never take something out of context, always in context the whole story going to the oldest extent source, and I provide as complete and accurate a rendering of each

word that is absolutely possible and then just to make certain that you have the ability to validate or invalidate the translations, I provide the most nominative and genitive form of each word within the brackets, you can copy and paste it into any Google search engine and validate the meaning of the word for yourself. Is it possible to be a deceiver? And has the only translation ever to be fully amplified providing all potential meanings and to give the reader the ability to validate the translation themselves, does anybody else do that? Does anybody when they translate something and there are a variety of potential meanings or that the meaning that you have deduced from the most reputable lexicons and from the letters that form these words and you have a significant difference will write three and four paragraphs about the word and say this is my position on the word but this is what other people have come to think? You're free to make up your own conclusion, but here are the facts. Has anybody else done that?

34:58 KIRK: What a deceiver you are. DEE: Nobody else has done it.

YADA: Has anybody else written books and made them all public for free and then gone back when they have learned something that they have said that isn't as accurate as they would like it to be because well they've learned more as they have continued to study and they'll go back and spend years of their life making the corrections so that every book is as accurate as it could possibly be? I'm not aware of anybody else that has ever done these things or has chosen to make every book available in its entirety for free. Oh, but it gets worse. After trying to deceive people hiding in the islands, trying to deceive people you are a recluse.

35:49 DEE: You are also accused of being maniacal and obsessed, possibly even Satan possessed.

36:04 YADA: Okay, [laughter] so the primary gist of *God Damn Religion* is that Allah is Satan and that Muhammad not only admitted to being Satan, demon possessed, but that it was obvious. The principal thrust of *Twistianity*, formerly *Questioning Paul* is to reveal that Paul also claimed to be demon possessed and that his Lord is Satan. I don't think there's anybody that has ever devoted more of their time, energy and resources exposing Satan as I have done.

36:51 Your work on Ezekiel it's groundbreaking. No one has done this. No one.

36:57 Yeah. What Dee is referencing here is that I was going to write a series of volumes on the events of the last days and so many things are presented in Ezekiel, the valley of the dry bones and the Gog and the Magog conflict, and then all of these final battles and then the creation of the new Temple and the like I figured you know what the heck I'll start there. Then in Ezekiel 1:1 there's a presentation of Ezekiel presenting his god and it's all pagan, it's got astrological signs and beastly renderings and I'm going whoa this isn't the God I know and as I read it becomes obvious that everything in the book is from Satan's perspective. He presents 25 ways to kill Jews. He talks about raping Jewish women, graphic about his 25 ways to kill Jews. It's really disgusting. And then his whole plan is to deceive and eliminate God's people. His new temple paves over not only all of Jerusalem, not just the Temple Mount, not just all of Jerusalem, all of Judea completely paved over by what is essentially a concentration camp to annihilate Jews. His homecoming feast is the Feast of the Beast where blood is served, and flesh is eaten and it's the flesh and blood of the *Gabowr*. The *Gabowr* is Dowd. He then goes through this whole explanation of what happened in the Garden of 'Eden from the perspective of the *Karuwb*, even refers to himself as that. He

goes into the entire account in first person and explains how he views it; it's Satan's autobiography. It's Satan's playbook. I don't think there has ever been anyone who has been as opposed to HaSatan.

39:28 And this bears explaining because as I was completing *God Damn Religion* and beginning *Twistianity*, my rewrite of them, it became quite clear to me why Yahowah decided that he would announce hundreds of prophecies regarding the mission that we are fulfilling and my specific calling which is to awaken Israel to Yahowah's name, His Son, His Mow'ed Miqra'ey, His Beryth / Covenant, what awaits them, the upcoming Harvests, and His ultimate return on Yowm Kipurym. What I came to realize is that Yahowah makes a big deal about this. He probably speaks more about this than almost any other subject. If you look at prophetic topics, and there are hundreds and hundreds of references to the role that I am being asked to perform on behalf of God's people at this time, it would be hard to find any other topic that is as prolific as this one.

40:50 Yahowah uses a lot of just nominative terms that are of no great consequence unless you're really in on His vocabulary like *Choter* which is "a secondary branch" and "a sucker." Secondary branch is because Dowd is the primary Branch because He talks about coming from the rootstock of Jesse which is the source of Dowd which means that the stump of Israel has fallen and the *Choter* is there to give it new life. He speaks of a *Nakar* which is "an observant foreigner" and He speaks of *Basar*, which is "a human herald." He speaks of a *Qowl* which is "a voice." These are not exalted terms, they're just pragmatic explanations. He speaks of him being a *'edah* "a witness." He uses the name Yada which means "to know, to recognize, and to acknowledge." But He uses one term that made me exceedingly uncomfortable until I realized what was at stake – that's *zarowa'*. There are three *Zarowa'*. Moseh is a *Zarowa'*. He is a "strong ram and shepherd" who led his people to freedom. But the ultimate *Zarowa'* is Dowd. He is not only the "ram who has led and guided and protected and nurtured his sheep," he's not only a *zarowa'* in the sense of he's "the strong arm of God," he's a *zarowa'* in the purest term of the word, the way It Is defined in the Towrah which is "sacrificial lamb;" he fulfilled Pesach and Matsah. So, it is Moseh as the *Zarowa'* that explained the Miqra'ey and how they fulfill the benefits of the Covenant all brought to us by Moseh as the first *Zarowa'*. Dowd is the living embodiment of that Covenant and he's the one who has fulfilled the Mow'ed Miqra'ey. Great as they were, and they were great, there's no two men in all of human history, no two people in all human history anywhere close to these two men, Moseh and Dowd. However, with God's people it would all be for naught. The entire Human Experience would be for naught. The Towrah would be for naught if it were not for the third *Zarowa'*.

43:43 That sounds impossible. How could you say that? The reason I say it is simple. Three thousand years ago when Dowd was living his first life and was the king of Israel, the anointed Messiah, Yahowah pronounced he was to Him as the Son of God, His Chosen One, and Dowd explained that he had decided and Yahowah had agreed that he would serve as the Passover Lamb. He made it exceedingly clear and then even provided a prophetic eyewitness account in first person of him doing so in the 22nd and 88th Mizmowr. And then in the great song of Dowd in the 89th Mizmowr Yahowah celebrates all of this. This was recited, inscribed for everyone to read 3,000 years ago. And yet in those 3,000 years until just a matter of years ago not a single Yahuwd on the planet knew it. Not a single Jew recognized Dowd as the Passover Lamb, as their Savior, as their Messiah, as their returning King. Not one. And that was not going to change. Yahowah tells His people through Yasha'yah, "I searched to find someone that I could communicate through, and I found no one." God made a promise that He would always communicate through people

because His people said they never wanted to hear His voice again and there was not a single Jew on the planet for 2,500 years that He could communicate through who would listen to Him, who would speak for Him. Not one. And that wasn't going to change. There is absolutely no indication whatsoever that after 3,000 years that all of a sudden Jews were going to wake up and say, "Oh yeah. Really. God's name is Yahowah. Dowd is our Messiah and returning King and he fulfilled Pesach and Matsah. Oh, by the way, Shabuw'ah Harvest is upcoming and Taruw'ah is our last chance for a gleaning and oh by the way God is returning with Dowd on Yowm Kipurym in year 6000 Yah which is October 2nd, 2033. That's how much time we have left." There was a 0% possibility that that was going to occur. In fact, there isn't a Jew even today apart from what they have heard or read on this program that have come to realize that that is true.

46:42 So, Yahowah realized if there wasn't a third Zarowa' the seeds that would grow to produce the Harvests of Shabuw'ah and Taruw'ah and the remnant that will be there for the ultimate Homecoming on Kipurym, it is all for naught. You can't have a harvest without fruit. There would have been no standing grain, there would have been no olives on the uppermost or the cut off branches, there would have been no remnant to return to, the prophecies of the Miqra'ey would be unfulfilled without the third Zarowa' sowing the seeds which would take root and grow and bear this fruit. That's why. Yahowah speaks more about this individual and this mission than any other prophetic witness even beginning in the Towrah, even with the first chapter of the Towrah.

47:47 So, why do I mention this in conjunction with exposing and outing Satan? The reason is quite simple. For Satan to prevail he needs to deter Yahowah from coming. He needs for there not to be a Shabuw'ah Harvest, for there not to be a Taruw'ah Harvest, and most importantly for there to be no Jews there, no remnant of Israel on the homecoming of Yowm Kipurym because then Yahowah and Dowd don't return. And that's the way it was going to be until we went fisticuff and I began my assault on behalf of God's people because Yahowah will prevail. God's people will prevail. Dowd will return just as it is predicted and the reason that's going to happen is because Yahowah enabled a third Zarowa' and that third Zarowa' has crippled the ambitions of HaSatan, the Adversary. So, I can tell you quite certainly that while the religious have been deceived by men who were demon possessed, Paul and Muhammad are profound examples. Even with Israel their first king Shaul was demon possessed. Israel will never hear a voice that is more engaged and exposing and emasculating, condemning Satan than it will in these books and these words.

50:00 So, the reason that her Christian community is of that opinion is because both Paul and Muhammad while not very clever they did what Satan does - Satan condemns Satan in the Quran and in the New Testament because Satan hates the Adversary title. The only way he can be worshiped as God is for him to shed it and so he condemns Satan because he hates the Adversary title and both books, the Quran and the New Testament, label anyone who criticizes the satanic scriptures that are found in both of them as being satanic. It's the ultimate ploy of most politicians. If you blame your rival for what you are guilty of it muddies the water. It clouds the issue, and you end up neutering the number one argument that can be brought against you by falsely accusing your adversary of what you're guilty of. That's why the Christian community would say such things. All right. I'll get off my point here but this one's important to me. It's important that the audience understand that there is really a HaSatan.

51:35 Maniacal we'll deal with later. Obsessed, that part is true. I am obsessed. If you were not obsessed it wouldn't be possible to sit in this chair and do what I do 13, 14 hours a day 7even days a week. So, I'm

exceedingly passionate and obsessed. While I've always been passionate since the last 23 years since Yahowah's calling in this regard I have been passionate about doing the best I could to serve Yahowah. When we began to read all of the statements, all the prophecies one after another that Yahowah has made regarding this role and came to appreciate how much it means to Him to do it well my perspective was fundamentally changed, and I am driven by a desire to please my Father. You can call it selfishly if you want but selfishly, I want when I first enter His presence to have the opportunity to stand back in the far back of the room and watch him greet Covenant members who came to be part of His family because of the work we did together. I think that would be tremendously rewarding and I want His celebration of the Taruw'ah Harvest and His return on Yowm Kipurym and His camping out with humankind beginning on Sukah to be enormously satisfying, and if we do our job well it will be. The very thought of doing something that has an eternal and pleasing influence on my Father and the Creator God of the universe motivates me. I can also say that I'm somewhat motivated by, I can't imagine the horror of showing up and saying that okay, so I slipped up. I wasn't as devoted as I should have been, and the results were disappointing. I don't want that. I focus on I want God to be pleased with what we're doing. And I realize that the amount of effort that I put into it now pays dividends that are infinitely beyond what any of us are investing and I also recognize, and this is really proven true over these last couple of months, it takes a family. Even when Yahowah was working through individuals like Moseh and Dowd, they did not perform alone. They're always supported. And in this case, we have an exceedingly wonderful, supportive, engaged, loving, compassionate, passionate family. So that is what we are about in this regard. All right. Go ahead. What does it say from there?

54:58 DEE: All right. She writes that she doesn't know you from Adam, "but your books intrigue me as to your podcast your name brings up a LOT (all caps) of conflict in my Christian community. Even my husband who is pretty agnostic is skeptical of you. In order to get to know you I wonder could you answer me these questions."

55:27 YADA: Okay. Before we do that how could you not be religious and have a Christian community that you would call "my Christian community?" How can somebody be "pretty agnostic?" Isn't agnostic already pretty, I mean pretty much this, pretty much that? She called herself an atheist and her husband's an agnostic and they both have a Christian community. Can you even imagine somebody? Listen. The reality here is that even though I've done all of these talk radio shows and podcasts and written these books and the like and I'm doing a really job lousy job of hiding, the fact of the matter is that there would be really no reason to know me unless you had either a religious agenda, a political agenda, you would have to be overtly religious, overtly political where I am an antagonist towards your religion or your politics or you were earnestly seeking to know Yahowah and you've done a search and it led you here. I can't imagine that there would be anybody outside of a few little pockets here and there that would have a clue who I am other than those two things. You guys who work in social media, particularly you Dee, is there really any other way that somebody is going to be aware of me? So, there's something very odd going on here with a "pretty much agnostic" being skeptical and this "conflict in my Christian Community." There is now more and more the possibility that within both the rabbinical community and the Christian Community that they are going to be exceedingly bothered and worried by me because I don't think there's anybody who's ever been more thorough at disproving the Christian New Testament than what I have done with *Twistianity*, formerly *Questioning Paul* and there's no one who has been as thorough at dismantling all of

the myths of Islam than I have been in *God Damn Religion*, and clearly no one has been as forceful against Rabbinical Judaism as I have been throughout all of these books but particularly in the *Babel* series, so it's clear that I would be getting under the skin of a lot of religious zealots and that's a very good thing. I would view that as an exceedingly positive thing.

58:24 So, I wonder if you can ask these questions, Dee, it's just from a human point of view, a reasonable point of view, if you were writing somebody and you made these claims of them demon-possessed and a maniacal recluse, deliberately deceiving, what do you think the motivation might be for somebody to answer your questions under that basis? Have you already sort of primed the pump and it's pretty obvious where you stand? For example, why don't you read the first question because the first question pretty much says it all.

59:04 She writes, "Are you hiding? Why?"

59:04 YADA: So, by putting the "why" at the end of it it's like are you still beating your wife? Are you hiding what? So why are you hiding? Okay. I'll deal with that one in my response, but oh good grief. Okay. Number two.

59:29 Dee: Why after all of these years is your following still so small? If God backs you, so you say, where is your grand following?

59:41 Think for a moment how pejorative that was written: "If your god backs you why don't you have a grand following?" Obviously, they have never read even the summary statements that Yahowah etched in stone. What did Yahowah say in terms of the numbers of people that would benefit from His Covenant?

KIRK: Very small.

YADA: He said thousands. What is thousands amongst billions?

DEE: That's infinitesimally small odds.

YADA: It's one in a million. Can you tell me at any time in of all of history has Yahowah been popular? Even during the Exodus was Yahowah popular during the Exodus?

KIRK: They hated him.

YADA: Yeah. Did Moseh have a grand following or did he have nothing but a bunch of whiners and bitter contentious jerks that were trying to constantly harass and demean him?

DEE: And 600,000 men and women and children or 600,000 men alone came out not including women and children and only 40,000 men crossed over. That tells you your odds.

1:01:09 YADA And that was the second generation because from the first generation only two. Where is the "grand following?" Only two!

DEE: Yahowsha' ben Nun and Kaleb, right?

1:01:28 YADA: Right. "Why is your following so small?" First of all, did Moseh have a following? No. Did Dowd have a following? No. Do I have a following? No. Didn't she just say that I was a recluse hiding away

on some Island? If I'm a recluse hiding away on some island I can't have a following. I don't have a clubhouse, I don't have a "Donate to Me" button, I have never once in my life asked anyone to follow me. Even Dowd didn't say follow me.

DEE: Paul sure did, quite often. He has lots of followers.

1:02:22 YADA: Well, today but not initially. Even in his last letter to Timothy he says all of Asia has deserted me. And rightly so. So, Miss Harsh, I do not have a "following." I do not want "a following." I would like Yisra'el and those who are interested in knowing Yahowah, a name that you didn't bother to use, to follow the path that He has provided home. I am not that path. The path is the Mow'ed Miqra'ey. It begins with the doorway named Passover and over the threshold of UnYeasted Bread past Bikuwrym to Shabuw'ah. That is Yahowah's path and if you want to meet Him you would have to follow that path home. It is the path that Dowd enabled. There will never be a "grand following" along that way. God was very clear about that and nothing's going to change in that regard. Our hope, our expectation I should say, is for there to be thousands. I would love for there to be 70,000 between Yisra'elites and Gowym who are part of the standing grain that join us on the Shabuw'ah Harvest. I'm not told the number. All we know is that it is a fruitful Harvest of standing grain and Yahowah is pleased with the result. But if there were 70,000 among 8 billion then we are dealing with a very, very small number of people. As we move to the Taruw'ah Harvest I expect that to be around 7,000. Two or three would be Yahuwdym, four or five would be Yisra'elites, and I think that would be a really excellent result amongst the surviving remnant of Jews at that time. We're not told the number of Yahuwdym that will survive the onslaught of Muslims to the Day of Reconciliations, but I would be surprised if there were more than a few thousand if even of that of Yahuwdym on Mount Mowryah awaiting Yahowah's return. Fortunately, Yahowah is always more impressed with quality than quantity. He was content with 'Adam. He was content with Noach and his family. When I first was tasked with this mission and I began to translate Yahowah's testimony as crudely as I could initially and began to learn I came up with, I don't know, it was 15, 20 pages of white paper of here are the differences just initially between my former religion (I was once an Evangelical Christian, an elder in the Presbyterian Church). largest now) I have learned some things which are deeply concerning, and I would appreciate if you could schedule a day. We'll meet starting lunch; we'll go through the afternoon. I want your top Hebrew scholars, everyone that is associated with Old Testament studies (I still used that term at that point) and I want the brightest that you have and I'd like you and them to join me for a lunch and we're going to go through some issues and some concerns I have." I brought up all these issues that there was no Jesus, God's name is Yahowah, that He is very opposed to religion and that there is no indication there could have been a New Testament because when the Covenant is renewed it's renewed with Yisra'el and Yahuwdym, not a Gentile Church, no sanction for Sunday worship, no sanction for Christmas and Easter - in fact they're pagan. I went through the Messiah is David not this other fellow, resurrection is a counterproductive concept. You don't want a physical body. You want to get rid of your physical body and become a spiritual being. At the end of the presentation Jerry Falwell said, "Everything you've said is true. There's not a single point here that we could argue with. We know it's true. But if we were to say these things the envelopes that arrive every day that are filled with checks to support my church and my university would stop arriving. If I were to say these things no one would come and sit in the pews of my church and if you were to say these things they will label you a kook.

1:10:50 Miss Harsh, I've been there. I have also done talk radio where all manner of clerics have and can call in. I have responded to hundreds of thousands of emails. I have done public debates. One does not demand anything, I'm sorry, your little condescending attitude here, but I did those very things and never had anyone ever be able to bring up an issue. But do you know what this really means when you ask for this as a religious person? It means that you don't have the wherewithal to contradict anything I've said, to disprove anything I've said. So, you think that maybe somebody smarter than you can do it. That's what you are saying. Well, if you can't maybe you shouldn't. What's the next point on Miss Harsh's list?

1:11:58 DEE: So, following up her question she writes "There are so many professors and academics that have dedicated their whole lives translating Hebrew, the Old Testament." And that's just not true. But anyway. "Why don't you demand to debate with them? These questions reflect..."

1:12:17 YADA: Demand, demand, demand! Demand, by the way, demand. What good would it, it's just so unbelievably immature for a person to write this kind of thing. First of all, as you said, it's not true. The number of people who have actually made an attempt to translate Hebrew in any one generation is exceedingly few. There are very few actual translations of the original Hebrew. Even in all of the various Bible translations most of them are revisions of the initial Latin Vulgate translation of the Greek Septuagint which was a translation of the Hebrew, and they continue to parrot the same phraseology because familiarity sells. So, there are exceedingly few. Even the books that claim wow, this is a new translation - not even close. Those that say, "We have our translations from the most recent findings in the oldest manuscripts" and you compare them to the oldest manuscripts, and they didn't pick up any of it. And one of the things that you learn very quickly and, Kirk, you have been a student of this. You've taken the translations that I've had, you first confronted them and say well the man was kind enough to give me the tools that I could use to disprove him or to validate it. Much of what he says resonates with me. I think it is true but let's take the time. You looked up virtually every word for the first two or three years, didn't you?

KIRK: Oh, 10,000 translations I found in my boxes before I moved from Folsom down here out of the West to Carmel.

1:14:27 YADA: And not only that, what is the current project you're working on?

KIRK: I'm working on a glossary to make it easy for somebody to validate this stuff.

YADA: Which you have done for the last 10 15 years.

KIRK: Correct. 17 years.

1:14:38 YADA: It's so exceedingly easy. Rather than put it off and say why don't you provide me with a debate of a Hebrew scholar, why don't you just simply get off your butt, Miss Harsh, and look up these words for yourself. You want everything served up to you on a silver platter because you're special? Why don't you take some initiative? Why do you have to have someone else fight your battles for you? You call yourself a skeptic and yet you have no idea how to proceed as a skeptic. All right. What does Miss Harsh say next?

1:15:30 DEE: She says, "These questions reflect the push back I keep getting regarding you and your claims."

1:15:43 So, you're in a religious and political community that doesn't like the fact that speaking for God I am exceedingly antagonistic towards religion and politics. They are things that God says are the prerequisites. There's only one prerequisite for being part of the Covenant - walking away from Babel / from the intermixing and confusion of religion and politics. That is the lone prerequisite, and so she's obviously in a community, either political or religious, where these things are issues and people have push back. But, may I interject why do I matter? Are you incapable of reading the words and validating whether or not God said them? Why is it that you are fixated on me as opposed to the source of the words that I'm translating and presenting to you? Why must you use an ad hominem argument? Are you incapable of avoiding fallacious arguments? Go ahead, Dee.

1:17:04 DEE: She writes, "They want these questions answered."

1:17:10 YADA: Who's they?

1:17:17 DEE: The Christian community.

YADA: If you wanted the questions answered, why don't you read? If you were to read the 34 books that are currently available for free by the way, are there any material questions about who God is, what He's offering and asking in return that are not answered?

KIRK: Fifty pages would do it.

DEE: I mean if she wants to get to know you as she suggests, then read the books.

1:17:48 YADA: Listen. My wife knows me and she likes me. That's a nice thing. My dogs know me pretty well, they like me. Dee and Kirk, we've spent a fair amount of time together. We get along famously. But is liking me or knowing me, does it matter at all as it relates to our mission? No. In fact I think with everyone I constantly say that we have to do this as a team. There are times when the team members chafe. What

I would ask you to do is deemphasize personal conflicts and personal issues and let's capitalize on what everyone can contribute. There's very little time left, there's a lot to accomplish. Let's just focus on the message. And that's the same thing I would say to Miss Harsh. Stop it with getting to know me; I'm irrelevant. I'm meaningful to Yahowah because of the message that I'm providing, but it's the message that I'm providing that is material, not who I am.

1:19:02 There are exceptions to this. Dowd is an exception. Moseh is not even an exception to this. Moseh is all about the message, not the man. Dowd is equal parts message and man, so Dowd is someone we all need to get to know as well as listen to on message, but for everybody else including me it's message, and in my case there is something quite unique about the role that I'm playing that no one else has played previously and that is that with Yasha'yah it's fresh from Yahowah's mouth. Yahowah said this; Yasha'yah writes this. He gave us this sweeping history of God's people in his prophetic testimony, many of those insights for the first time. Moseh listened to Yahowah explain the Covenant and His Mow'ed Miqra'ey and the purpose of things like the Yowbel and so he was revealing truth for the first time – I'm not.

1:20:15 Everything I have to say is conveyed by previous prophets, everything. My conclusions, my presentations, my attitude, my perspective, my warnings, my encouragements, they're all based upon what Yahowah revealed through His prophets. So, that makes me nothing but a messenger and as a messenger all that matters is the message. All right. Go ahead, Dee.

1:20:56 DEE: She says she has a 5-year-old son. "Circumcising him is something my husband would never allow. How can I convince him you are legit?"

1:21:03 Interesting there. If the husband would never allow it, how are you going to get it done? Second of all, he's five, not eight days old. Third. Why would my legitimacy matter when God is explicit on this issue? Go ahead, Dee.

1:21:26 She writes, "Thank you for your understanding [Laughter]. I realize the tone of this email is harsh but like you I am cynical especially of man and I need more." (apparently more than 34 volumes) "Thank you. Also, before I go, after reading your introduction book last year I stood up and felt the presence of something behind me watching me. I stood up and turned around and saw this image attached (she put a picture). I felt in that moment that god (lowercase G) or an angel or the spirit was communicating something to me. (because she's seeking your advice) Can you take a look and pay particular attention to the top left section of the cloud?"

1:22:38 YADA: Actually its's "of the clud."

1:22:46 DEE: I was doing her a service there.

1:22:46 YADA: All right. I probably have covered most of this but let me share my response, and by the way, we are mocking this, and we mocked someone previously because it deserves to be mocked and if you don't like a mocking tone you're just not going to like Yahowah because that is the tone that He takes. That's the tone that 'Eiyah takes, and we're going to get our fill of 'Eiyah here shortly. It is the only approach to deal with this level of deliberate ignorance.

1:23:23 I just can't get over that she says this and then asks you to look at something and give her feedback if you're so unreliable.

1:23:35 YADA: Yeah. You'll hear my feedback in a moment.

Hello Harsh,

It's good to hear that I'm irritating Christians in your religious community and that the best you and they can do against the wealth of information in the 35 books I have written and offered freely online about who God is and who He is not is pose mean-spirited ad hominem attacks. Over the 23 years that I have been devoted to exposing and condemning religion and to translating and explaining the testimony of Yahowah, (a name by the way, she never mentions) never once in hundreds of thousands of emails and talk radio programs has anyone shown that I am incorrect. You didn't either. But you did a fine job of being harsh - which was your intent by your own admission.

Your response is not surprising, in what has become a thoughtless generation so horribly influenced by Progressive ideology, evangelical Christianity, and nutcase conspiracy theories in the West and orthodox Christianity, Islam, and Hinduism elsewhere. Personal attacks and irrational opinions are the retort of those incapable of using evidence and reason. This moronic approach prevails due to the ignorance and irrationality of the audience. If I were a recluse, why would I expose myself in these ways? Is anyone capable of thinking in your religious community?

I live on an island because there are fewer distractions and I can translate, contemplate, and write twelve hours a day, every day. I enjoy nature more than asphalt, concrete, and traffic, and I love the environment and weather. Simple. Obvious.

If I were trying to deceive, why would I do so by more completely and accurately presenting the Towrah, Prophets, and Psalms from the oldest extant sources? Are you, and your religious friends and family suggesting that Yahowah is a deceiver? If my purpose was to deceive and if I was serving Satan, why would all of my conclusions and insights about God have been deduced from the Word of God - that which is proven inspired through prophecy?

If I were in league with Satan, why am I the first to expose the fact that both Paul and Muhammad admitted that they were demon possessed - destroying the credibility of the two most popular religions admittedly inspired by Satan? As further advice, before you, as a member of a Christian community, accuse someone of being demon-possessed, read the conclusion of 2nd Corinthians.

Conflicted?

God or man? Relationship or religion? Observe or accuse? Study and think or slander the messenger? Yahowah or Jesus? The Towrah or New Testament? Moses, David, and Isaiah or Paul, Peter, and Luke? Set apart or popular?

Thirty three of my thirty five books are freely available to you at YadaYah.com. You can read them or reject them, benefit from them or demean me for having written them. You can come to know Yahowah as He revealed Himself to us or continue to believe in the religious myths of your popular Christian community. The choice is yours.

1:37:24 Well, you know that was done, which you really shouldn't do in a letter, which is I read her letter and I tried to respond to every point that she raised and then give her a general assessment of what was wrong with her approach, not for her because someone that's going to write with the tone that she wrote with and say the kind of accusatory things that she said is not reachable. So, I actually wrote it because we have social media sites and I think it is helpful for the Covenant family to know how to deal with these kinds of things, so I try to set an example. But in this particular response I read what she had written which

is uncommon for me. Typically I just scan something like this and then toss it away two or three sentences into it but I did, in this case, read the entire thing and then responded to it point by point and it I don't know if I took 15 or 20 minutes and normally then the proper approach is to wait a day or two and soften it before you send it, but in this case I decided to hit send and this is the result, and having gone through it again today, I think it is really quite appropriate.

1:38:42 We only have 15 to 20 minutes left in our program, but we can resume where we were on Yow'el 2:11. We probably won't even get past this one statement, but I have found a new affinity for Yow'el. His name means "Yahowah is God." He has more to say that is pertinent to Yahuwdym today than almost anyone. His focus is on what is occurring now to Jews and what is going to occur as we move towards Yahowah's return and how should they respond. He is in effect doing my job, so he makes my job a lot easier because all I have to do is read what he said and make certain the audience understands it and we have mission completed.

1:39:48 But Yahowah was very good at providing these tools and one of the things I did not say when we were talking about the role that I was asked to play is that I the last thing I'm going to do is brag about having been given this role for two reasons. One is that we're a long way from done yet and we've got a lot of work to do. And the second reason is Yahowah did for the Choter, Yada, the Nakar more than He has done for anyone else. The only person in all of God's story that He ascribed and bestowed all seven spirits, the Spirit of boldness and of understanding and communication, He did all for this guy. And that would not have been necessary had he been more competent on his own. When Yahowah said that He gave His Spirit to Dowd when he was anointed at eight, and his Spirit never left him. His Spirit was singular. With the Choter, with the Nakry, with Yada, with his Qowl (voice), it's seven and God goes through and explains each of the seven and what their role is in enabling what it is that He is writing for His people at this time. So, there wouldn't have been seven if one was sufficient for Dowd and Dowd was much more insightful and brilliant and a better communicator than I. So, there's the reason for the seven.

1:41:43 That's why we don't brag. We can be very proud of what we've accomplished as a family, but the very fact is that Yahowah has made certain that we would prevail. He's given us everything we need to prevail and the reason He has done this is because failing in this case is unconscionable; it annuls the entire Human Experience. So, God was going to make certain that we made this work.

1:42:12 **Yahowah** (*Yahowah* – God's name transliterated as guided by His *towrah* – instructions on His *hayah* – existence and His role in our *shalowm* – reconciliation as *'elowah* – Almighty God) **offers appointing, enabling, and putting in place** (*nathan* – provides) **His voice** (*qowl huw'*) **before the appearance and presence** (*la paneh*) **of His especially worthy individual and empowered and capable man of exemplary character who is especially forceful and bold. For it is certain that His place to camp out is closely associated with Him greatly exceeding that which is required, therefore a robust, capable and powerful force** (*chyl huw'*). **Indeed** (*ky*), **exceedingly great** (*rab me'od* – with power beyond measure) **and capable, influential and forceful** (*'atsuwm*) **sufficiently competent to complete the mission. The One who engages and acts upon** (*'asah*) **His message from His Word** (*dabar huw'*) **is indeed** (*ky*) **exceedingly valuable and uncommonly important** (*gadowl*) **on the Day** (*yowm*) **of Yahowah and he is tremendously respected** (*yare' me'od*) **by whoever** (*wa my*) **is lifted up and carried away by Him** (*nasa' huw'*). (*Yow'el* 2:11)

1:43:25 I did not think that this is where I knew we were going to start in Yow'el 2:11. I did not read it prior to the program; I probably would have said less had I done so. You might say why would I not read it before the show and the answer is quite simply that if I am speaking from the heart extemporaneously about Yahowah's passages and what He is saying to us then these programs can be augmentative; they can go beyond what I have written. I realize that while Yahowah much prefers the written word because it can be validated much more readily, and it has a legacy and an existence to it that the spoken word does not have, a reliability, a dependability, an endurance with the written word. The two go together beautifully, the spoken word and the written word, and it is important to speak of Yahowah's testimony because there is a passion that can be conveyed and nuances that aren't possible in writing that are possible with the spoken word, and so I prefer to be vulnerable in doing these programs so that I can speak to you from the heart about what God is saying to us.

1:45:08 However, that said, there is one topic that is exceedingly difficult to discuss, and my preference would be never to have to discuss it. I loved being anonymous as Yada and wrote under that pen name for 10 years. It's not what God wanted. God wanted this mission, Yada Yahowah, to be exceedingly well known. He wanted what we are writing and what we're saying to be endorsed such that His people would listen. And so, while I would prefer anonymity because you have all of the advantages, all the enjoyment of studying Yahowah's testimony and being with Him and learning and the joy of sharing what you have learned doing so without responsibility, that all changes with statements like this. Now there's responsibility and God has made not only stated expectations, He has provided His assessment of what we're doing. And while I don't concur with Him; I do not view myself as He presented me in this statement, I just don't. Yahowah does not see me as I see me. He sees me as Dowd enabled me to be.

1:46:45 Dowd, by taking away all of my guilt, everything I've ever done that is inadequate and depositing it in She'owl on Matsah made me look perfect in God's eyes and so there are some really positive things that I can contribute to God's family, and that's all God sees. It's the best possible kind of relationship - a loving father that sees the best in his son. And you have to understand that Yahowah's approach is to work through us, and so when He finds someone who is excited to work with Him he wants to share credit. So, while our relationship is that He is infinitely more responsible and deserves infinitely more credit than I do, that's not the way that Yahowah sees it. His preference is to credit us for our contribution no matter how infinitesimal it might be compared to His because there are so few people willing to do it and because He enjoys it so much. So, you have to understand this is a proud father speaking of a unique son in this regard and He's saying things that sound over the top to me, but who of us as parents haven't said these things about a son or daughter at their proudest moments. So, Yahowah is saying,

1:48:28 **"Yahowah will offer appointing, establishing, and putting in place His Qowl (His voice)."**

1:48:46 Now mind you Yahowah made a commitment He would not speak directly to His people. They asked Him not to; He agreed I won't do it and He immediately went to the plan where He spoke through Moseh and then spoke through Yahowsha' ben Nun. Then He spoke through Shamuw'el and then He spoke through Dowd. He spoke through Moseh. He spoke to these people that He chose. He spoke through them, and they became His voice to His people. What Yahowah is saying here, and this is in context with the time of Ya'aqob's Troubles, that **He will offer, appoint, and enable, putting in place His voice."**

1:49:33 No one else is explaining how to properly pronounce Yahowah's name or how it is important to know and use. There's no one else that is celebrating what Yahowah has achieved through His Son, Dowd, the Messiah, King, the Zarowa', the Sacrificial Lamb, and our Savior, our returning King, that understands His seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey and how they play out not only in our past but how they will be fulfilled in our future and when, why, where, that understands the five conditions and five benefits of the Covenant and how they are delivered by answering God's invitations to meet with Him on these seven days. There's no one else that is speaking to God's people and urging them to come home to Father and Son.

1:50:22 **"Yahowah will offer appointing and enabling..."** I love the idea of enabling more than appointing but He did both **"...putting in place..."** *nathan*. It's His gift.

1:50:38 You know, I wanted to on the covers of both *God Damn Religion* this expose on Islam and how it's perpetrating genocide against God's people and on *Twistianity*. These are gifts to Yisra'el and to Yahuwdym. Both of them, particularly *God Damn Religion*, I have risked my life to tell you this story. It is my gift to you clearly from the Father, but from the Father through one of His sons. His voice, His qowl. I am the voice calling out in the wilderness to make a raised highway back home for the great day of Yahowah when He will return on Yowm Kipurym.

1:51:37 **"...for the appearance and presence of His special, especially worthy individual."**

1:51:45 Well you can't deny worthy when he is aided and abetted by the seven spirits of Yahowah. You can read Yasha'yah 11 where this is presented. The seven spirits of Yahowah would make a mouse worthy of roaring, so I will accept that because the seven spirits of Yahowah make that possible.

1:52:13 **"...certainly an empowered individual who is now as for an exemplary character..."** That is Yahowah's perspective. I'm certainly judgmental. I certainly stand up for what is right and there's no question that I am exceedingly forceful and bold. If Yahowah wanted forceful and bold he got it. Sounds like He does.

1:52:46 **"... for it is certain that his place to camp out is closely associated with H/him..."** Now his can be lowercase, can be uppercase. It is certain that Yahowah could be saying through His prophet that His place to camp out, which will be on Mount Mowryah in Jerusalem in the midst of Yahuwdah within Yisra'el on this blue planet swirling in space that Yahowah's place to camp out, which would be during Sukah or His place to camp out in Shamaym.

1:53:30 **"... is closely associated with (lowercase) him."** In other words, His Voice is leading people to the place where we can all camp out with Yahowah and therefore these things are directly associated.

1:53:55 **It is exceeding what is required.** Again, I don't like having to be the messenger of this because it's uncomfortable speaking about oneself particularly what God has to say about an individual, but it is exceedingly comforting to hear God say that he is greatly exceeding what is required. Now I've been given every advantage a person can give and be given and more. Yahowah is not a slave driver. He never usurps free will; it is always the choice at five o'clock in the morning to sleep in or come into my study and commence again. It is always the opportunity when the clock strikes seven and the eyes grow tired to know should I stay and do a little more. Today was a fruitful day, 125 pages of edits in one of the books that I am rewriting. So, what I'm reading here is as hard as I am trying to meet my Father's expectations,

my Father is saying I'm exceeding them. That means that we as a family are doing more than God expected of us and the dividends of that will reverberate for all time because that means there's more members of the Covenant family enriching the experience and also that those who are members of the Covenant family are growing in their knowledge of Yah and are working to protect and enlighten God's people. So, after saying that we are greatly exceeding what is required He says,

1:56:00 **“Therefore, he is robust and capable, influential and forceful, sufficiently competent to complete the mission.”** And this means that Yahowah has seen our future. We do everything that He had hoped of us, and the results pay dividends; we will succeed. Our Father is already pleased.

1:56:36 **“The one who engages and acts upon his message from His word is indeed exceedingly valuable and uncommonly important on the Day of Yahowah.”** And that's the point. That's the entire point is that everyone who engages and acts based upon what we have shared in these volumes of books under *Yada Yahowah*, what we have shared on these programs that *everyone* who engages and acts upon that message which is Yahowah's message explained for our time and God's people at this time will become **“exceedingly valuable and uncommonly important on the great Day of Yahowah”** which is Yowm Kipurym in year 6000 Yah, sunset October 2nd, 6:22 p.m. It's when it will commence in 2033, less than 10 years from now.

1:57:42 God enabled me to do this for you so that everyone who responds and takes advantage of what we have collectively offered becomes valuable to God, so valuable to God He views everyone who capitalizes and acts upon what we have shared in His name as His sons and daughters, the most precious things in the world to Him, His family.

1:58:20 **“And he is tremendously respected by whoever is lifted up and carried away by him.”**

1:58:27 Again, it doesn't matter if he is capitalized or lowercase, whether Yahowah is offering credit to those working with Him or He is acknowledging that to those who are valuable to Him tremendously as He lifts them up and carries them away. He could also be saying that come the standing grain Harvest of Shabuw'ah, the olive Harvest of Taruw'ah, and of the homecoming of Yowm Kipurym that those that are lifted up and carried away on these days are not only respected by Yahowah, not only respect and revere Yahowah, but also have an appreciation for the contribution of the three Zarowa' that made it possible for them to be here. It took all three. Moseh explaining the Covenant and explaining the Mow'ed Miqra'ey providing God's teaching in the Towrah, Dowd for fulfilling it, for explaining it, for embodying it, for living it, and the third Zarowa' Yada for bringing this to the attention of the world and especially Yahuwdym and Yisra'el in advance of these harvests and of God's return.

I certainly don't have anything to add to that. We've gone well past the time that Blog Talk Radio would normally allow us to speak. I can only hope, expect; I guess I don't have to hope anymore. God has been quite clear - working together we prevail. God's family grows and matures such that we celebrate the Shabuw'ah and Taruw'ah Harvests and the homecoming on Yowm Kipurym so that we enjoy camping out together in an earth restored to the conditions of 'Eden and that our Father is proud of His sons and daughters just as we are proud of what He has done for us, and grateful.

So, I leave you tonight with a humbled heart to hear my Father speak of me this way but He's also speaking of all of His Covenant children this way. Knowing that this is God's intent there is nothing that pleases Him more than to enjoy His children doing as He wants done working at His side contributing to His family. So, I would encourage you to become part of it. He will say this same thing of you.

God uses words as a painter, and you are a painter, Kirk, uses His pigments and there are many shades and many colors to His words and they take on different hues in different contexts and so knowing what to bring out of a term and what not to convey is derived really from having a relationship with Him, coming to know Him, understanding what He is offering and expecting in return and trying to be both consistent and also fresh and so when you boil it all down and say you know you've translated this one word 500 times there will be differences and it is in making all of them available in this kind of a term that normally a translator would become more vulnerable, and yet that is something to celebrate. That's why we do this program the way we do it. We want to be vulnerable. We want our listeners to sense our vulnerability, our willingness to be transparent, to lay it all on the line, to lay all of our cards face up on the table for you to know what we know and for you to know what we don't know because that really is the essence of being trustworthy, dependable, and credible.

So, with that in mind we wish you a wonderful good evening. We wish both Kirk and Dee the conclusion of your project, and Dee on the many that you have and with Leah and the restoration of our books with Amazon, and Jacki and all the work her team has done. The editors are now working overtime as we're making such progress. We've actually had posted now *Twistianity* Volume One and within a week's time *Twistianity* Volume Two up. So, this is a wonderful time with the family operating together and I want to thank each and every one of you for working to awaken God's people to make them aware of His name and of His return, of what He is offering and what He is expecting of them. For the first time for them to consider not being religious or political and being open to the Covenant relationship.
